FMD is endemic in Turkey  
(types A and O and new type O  
variant).

No outbreak in Thrace since  
September 2007.

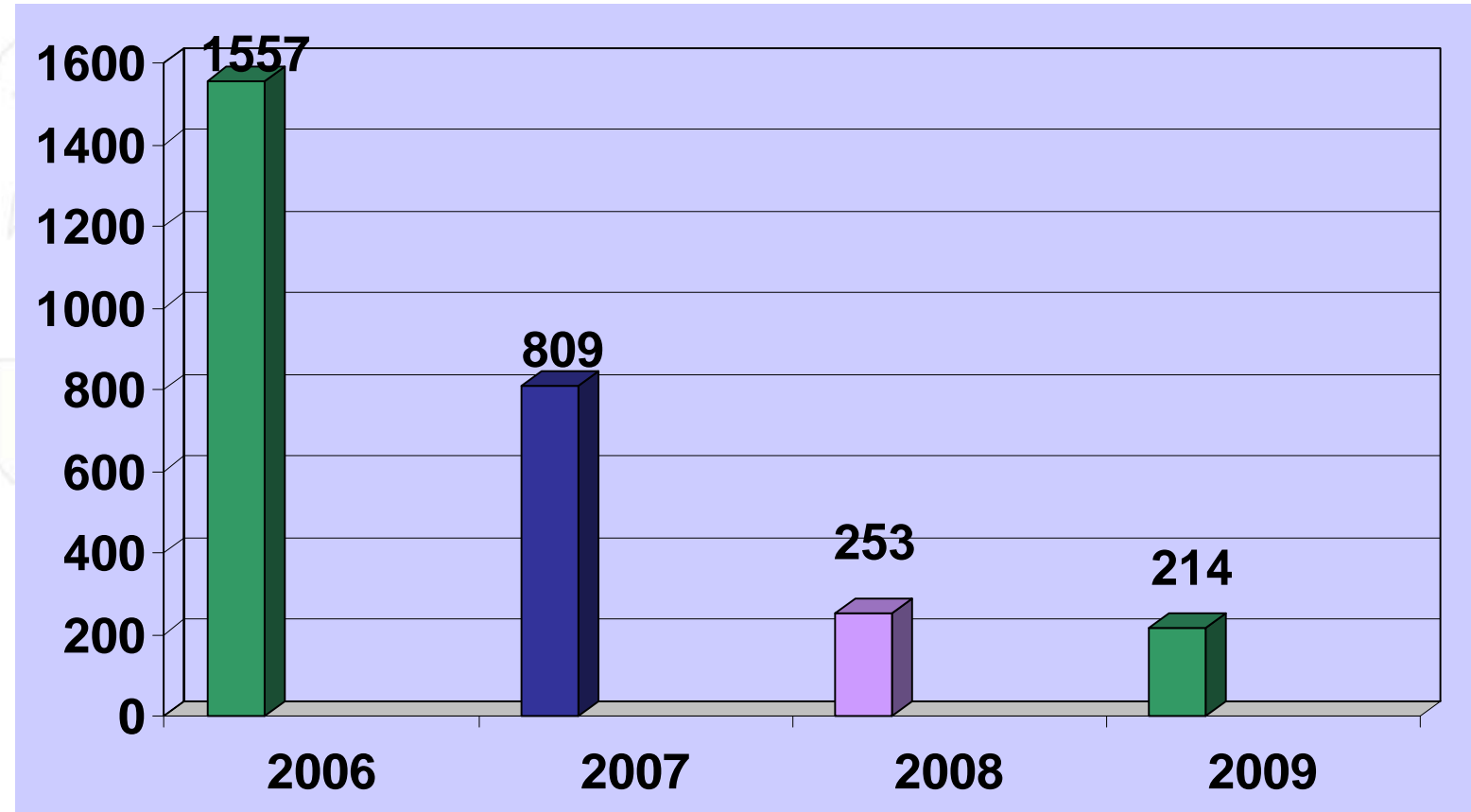
2001: 88 outbreaks in 29  
provinces

2002: 48 outbreaks in 21

2003: 51 outbreaks in 23

2004: 75 outbreaks in 30

## Principles:

- \* mass vaccination of bovines (ca. 10.5 million heads) twice a year and small ruminants (ca. 30 million heads) once a year
- \* sero-surveillance
- \* control measures
- \* cleaning and disinfecting



**3 year programme ending

follow up project is  
currently being discussed).**

contribution + € 16.359.450  
national co-financing = total €  
65.437.800**



**Aim varies for the different regions: eradication in Thrace with Thrace recognised officially free with vaccination by the OIE by 2011, and decrease incidence in Anatolia.**
