





 - Support to Member states in the case of a FMD outbreak





- Reduce risk to members from the European Neighbourhood
 - South East Europe promote better management in Turkey and neigbours
 - South East Mediterranean: support better management in the neigbourhood of Cyprus and Israel
 - North Africa: technical support to REMESA actions
 - Support surveillance networks to provide information needed by risk managers in the European neighbourhood





- Promote the Global Strategy of progressive control of FMD
 - Support FA FMD Unit in collating information for revie of progress of regional programmes on FMD control.
 - Technical support to develop the OIE/FAO FMD progressive control pathway (PCP) methods and guidlines
 - Support the global system for improved FMD reference lab services.
