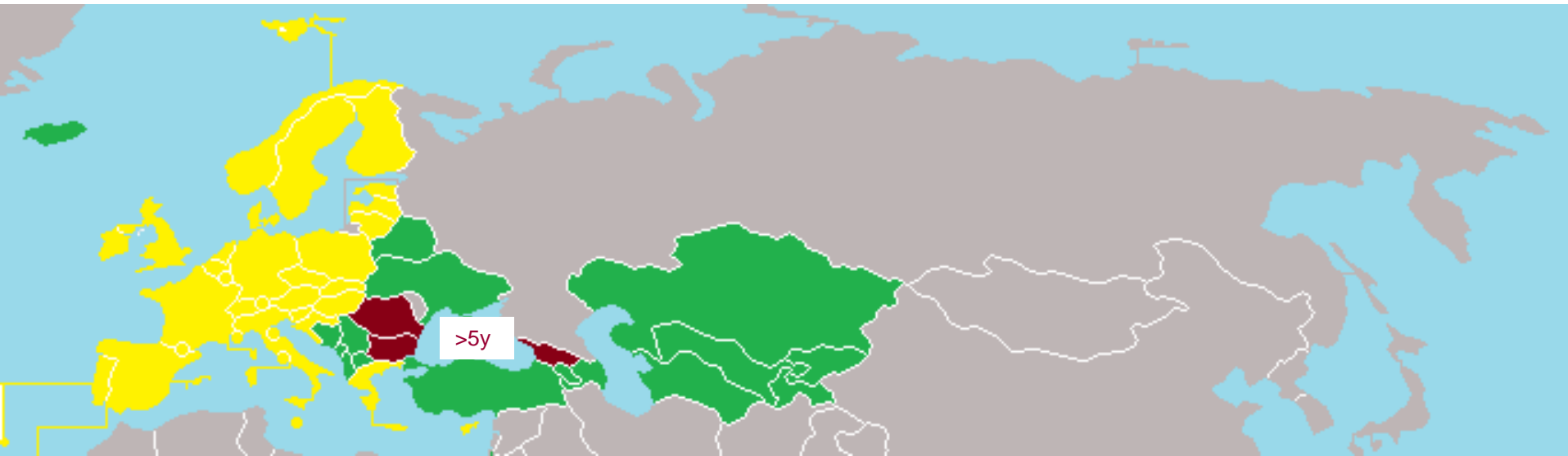

- Just **one aqua PVS mission** in Europe
- **Specific content** so far proposed for **PPR**
- Still **no self-evaluation** in Europe

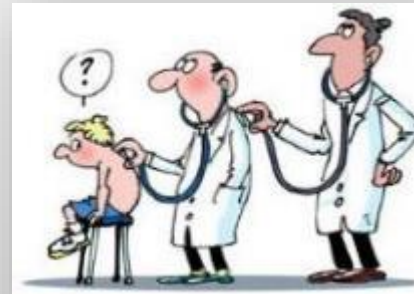

National Bridging workshops between International Health Regulation (IHR) and the PVS

- Analyse areas of common activities to establish, as often as necessary, bridges to facilitate coordination within sectors in the « One Health » vision
- Based on the results of the PVS and evaluation of the IHR



A- Integration of the « One Health » concept

National Bridging workshops between International Health Regulation (IHR) and the PVS

In collaboration with WHO EURO :

- Kyrgyzstan : 2-4 October 2018
 - Kazakhstan : 21-23 November 2018
 - Albania : 05-07 December 2018
 - Other planned in 2019 (Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Serbia, Armenia)
- Need for a real active participation of Veterinary Services and access to the PVS reports

C- Sustainability of laboratories

- **PVS for the laboratories**
- Missions (2 countries)
- Evaluate the needed resources for the national laboratory network meets the needs of the VS
- Evaluate relevance of the structure and its sustainability in the national context
- **Twinning projects between veterinary laboratories**

D- Training of veterinarians and para-veterinarians

- Twinning projects for veterinary education
- Collaboration with veterinary statutory bodies
- Specific actions for para-veterinarians
