

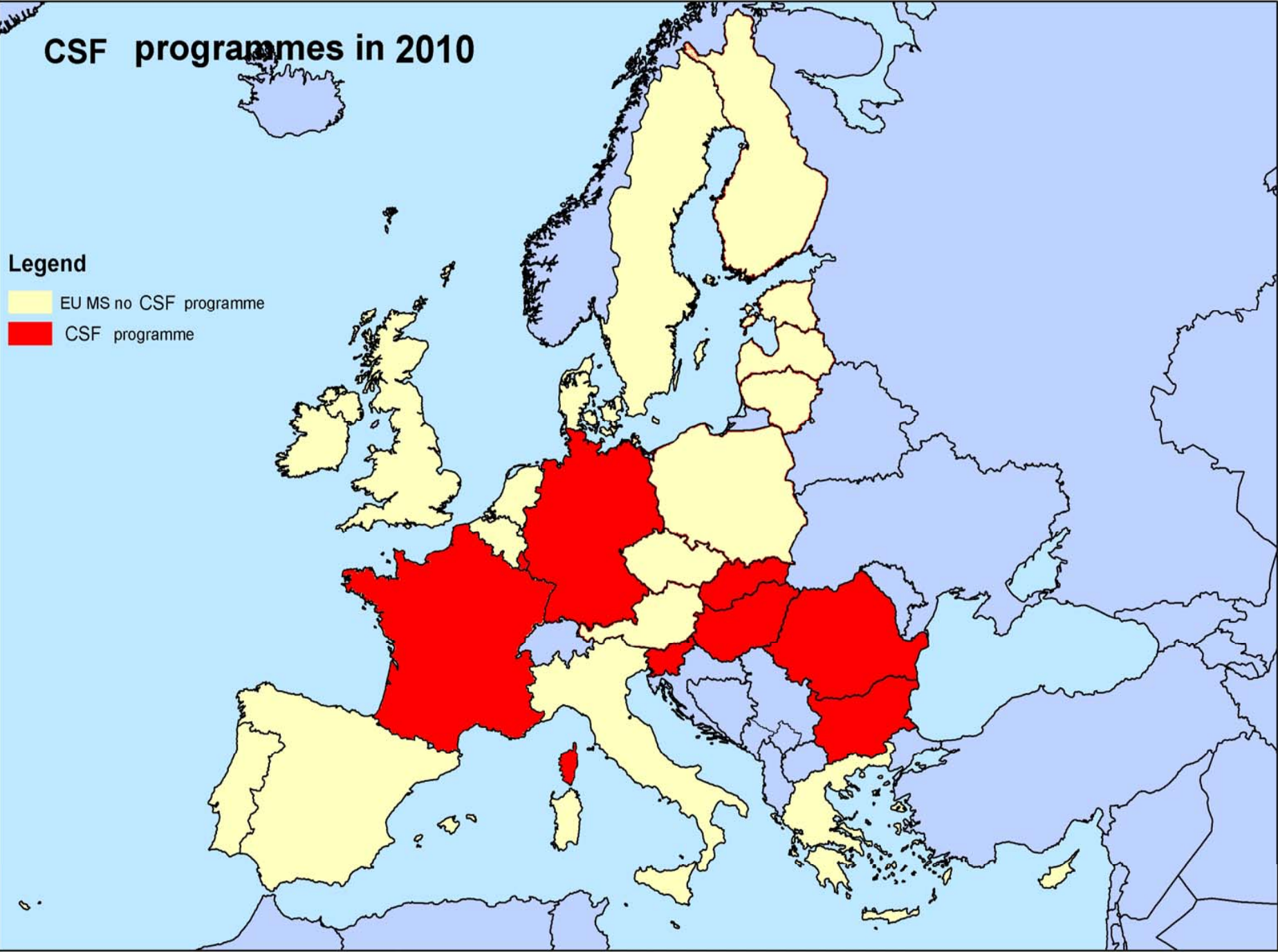

- CSF programme



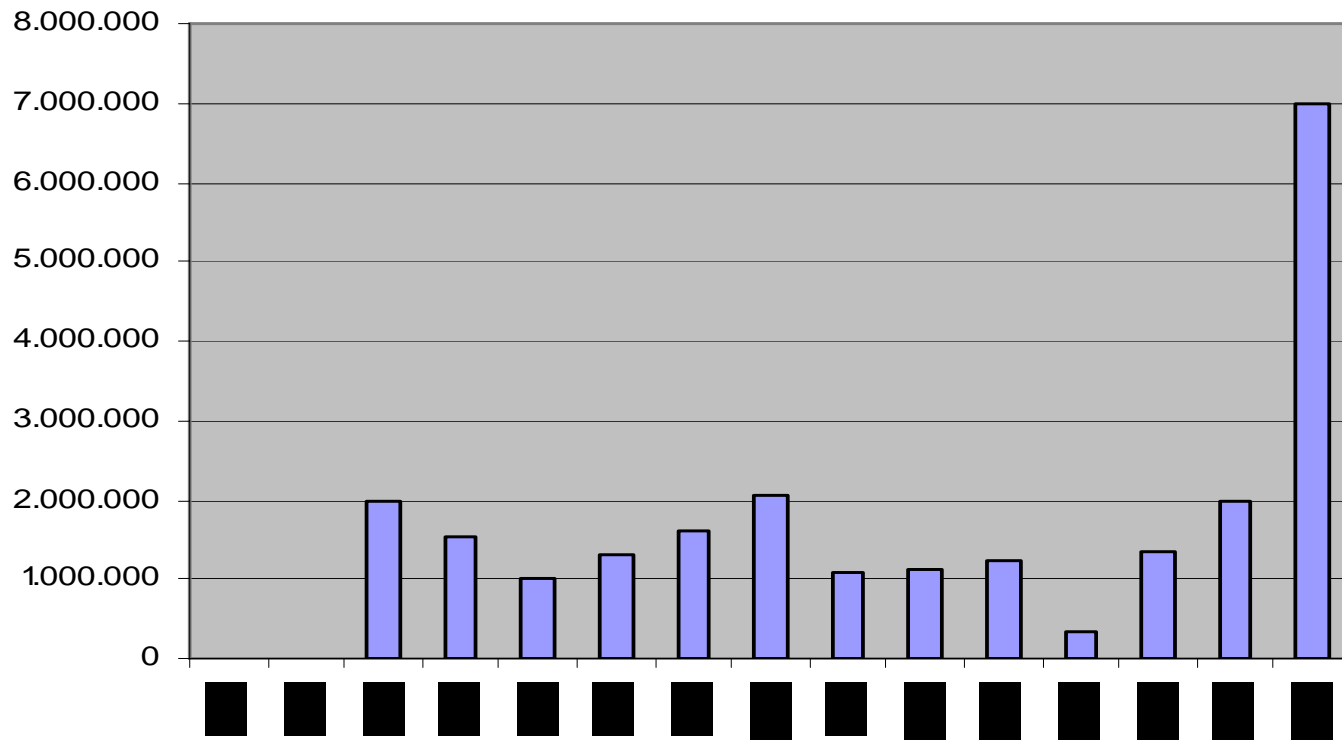

  1. Component I - **national** with 7 country projects for 5 years
  2. Component II – **regional**- overall co-ordination

# Component I

## ■ National projects (7)

- evaluation of the situation
- purchase of vaccine baits,
- storage and distribution of vaccines
- costs for examination of samples
- follow up costs



# Component II

## ■ Regional project

### Co-ordination of 7 national projects

- To follow up the performance
- Assist with expertise
- Organisation of regional meetings and conferences
- Simulation exercises

# Budget for 5 years

- Component I: € 94.8 m
- Component II: € 2 m

# CSF Situation in Western Balkan

## ■ Croatia

- Domestic pigs: last outbreak in March 08
- Wild boar: 2 seropositive in two regions (Vukovar county, Sisak county) surveillance in place.

## ■ Bosnia and Herzegovina

- Domestic pigs: number, identification of pigs and registration of holdings ?
- Wild boar: number and epidemiological status not clear- further assessment needed

# CSF Situation in Western Balkan

## ■ Albania

- Domestic pigs: 150 000 approximate number, vaccination in place in “old infected areas”
- Wild boar: very low number is estimated, no surveillance

## ■ Kosovo (under UNSCR 1244)

- Estimated number of wild boar 10 000, no surveillance in place, laboratory performs only AG ELISA, no information on domestic pigs

# CSF Situation in Western Balkan

## ■ Montenegro

- Domestic pigs are vaccinated
- Wild boar: number 3848, surveillance is performed – low number of samples- all negative

## ■ Serbia

- Domestic pigs: number 5 million , vaccination in place, cessation planned for 2011
- Wild boar: number 15480 active surveillance in place, low number of samples

# CSF Situation in Western Balkan

## ■ FYROM

- Domestic pigs: 7 big farms and 50000 backyard farms. Vaccination in place, 3 outbreaks in 2008
- Wild boar: number approximate, no surveillance
