
Never reported in Serbia

First case: June 2016 (confirmation 7 June 2016)

- Bujanovac municipallity
- Clinical suspicion
- Backyard holding (8/1/0 cattle/case/deaths)
- Quick notification and rapid response
- Depopulation
- Cleaning, disinfection, desinsection


Protection (whole municipality) and surveillance (whole district) zone

OIE: Immediate notification (08/06/2016) ADNS reporting (from 23/06/2016)




- Secondary outbreak:
 - > Izvor, Bosilegrad, Pcinjski
 - > Clinical suspicion
 - Backyard holding (8/1/0 cattle/case/deaths)
- ➤ In 7 days 16 outbreaks









Distribution of outbreaks/cases per district



- Legal base for control measures, expenditurs and possible procurement of vaccine
 - Financial program of Government for veterinary expeditures (Jan 2016)
 - Program of animal health measures (Feb 2016)
- Development of brochures for farmers and veterinarians (Apr 2016)
- Procurement of diagnostic tests (3 laboratories)
- Study visit Contingency planning TAIEX support (May, Bulgaria)
- Training of experts EUFMD support (May, Bulgaria)
- Communication with CA in Sofia and Skopje


- Veterinary national and regional (souteast region of RS) crisis management team (1.6.2016)

- National Task Force on prevention and control of LSD (13.6.2016.)
 - Prime minister office, managed by PM asisstant
 - All relevant authorities (incl. Police, Army, regional and local authorities, Veterinary chamber...
 - Strong support by the Government, MoF...

Control measures


- Control measures in accordance with the Verinary Law
 - equivalent to the Council Directive 92/119/EC, Decision 2016/645 and Decision 2015/1500
- General Contingency Plan
 - No specific Operational Manual for LSD
 - Adequate structure and command chain
- Notification of all cases
- Culing of all animals in affected holding
- Protection and surveillance zone (50 km)
- Clinical examination and control of cattle on all holdings
- Strong contol of movement of animals
- Control of insects (desinsection, repelents)
- Fast compenstation of costs (100% of market prices)


Vaccination

- Request to European Commission for supply of 200.000 doses for immediate vaccination (8.6.2916)
 - > 50.000 doses granted for two districts
- Adoption of Regulation for importation and use of LSD vaccine (13.6.2016)
- Urgent procurement of 400.000 vaccines (13-15.6.2016)
- Regular procurement of up to 600.000 doses (1.7.2016)
- South African Neethling strain, the Onderstepoort veterinary institute
- Vaccination plan adopted on 24.6.2016.
 - Zone A (EU vaccine) 24.6.2016.
 - Zone B + commercial farms from zone C (400.000 doses) - 27.6.2016.
 - Zone C (up to 600.000 doses) mid July



Challenges

- 1. Budgetary issues
- 2. Trade of vaccinated animals and products (meat)
 - Export difficulties
 - Business opportunities vs. animal health/welfare
- 3. Management of outbreaks after vaccination
 - Immunity of vaccinated animals
 - Partial stamping out

Recommandations

- 1. Regional cooperation and communication
- 2. Harmonisation on control measures
- 3. Modernisation on legislative
- Redesign of relevant chapters in TAHC (regional or subregional approach)
- 5. Support to affected countries
 - Long terms condequences
 - Impact on other control programs (budgetary, capacity...)
 - Barier for sreading of disease
 - Acces to EU bank of vaccines
 - Possible development of sustainable regional bank of vaccine (EU, OIE, FAO, member countries)
