ASF – Epidemiological situation from 26. 6. 2017 to 17. 9. 2018

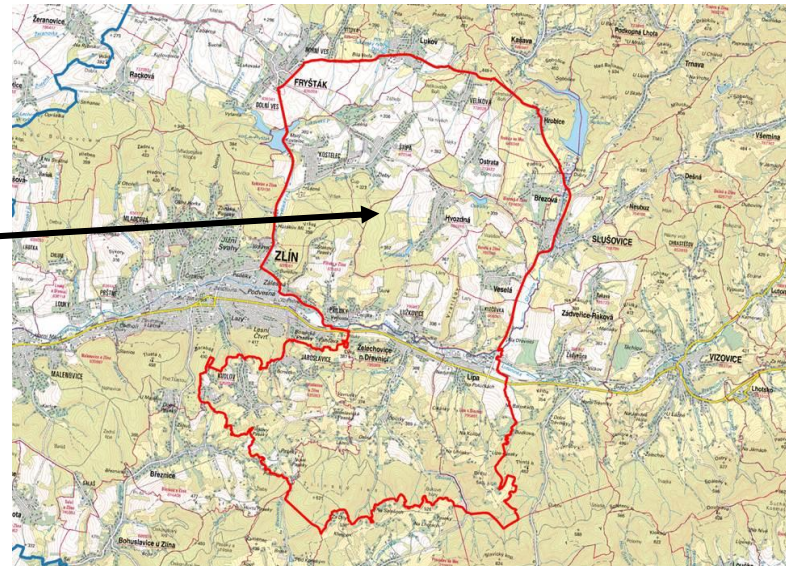
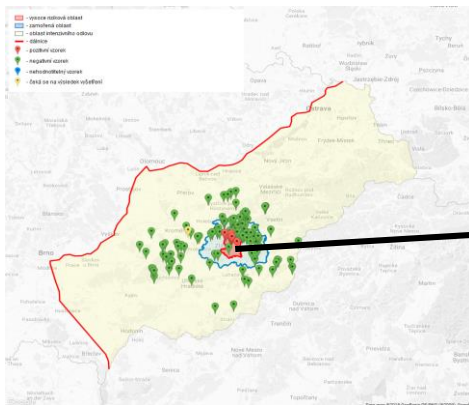
In total **230** cases of African swine fever in wild boar population

- The total number of positive cases found in dead wild boar: **212**
- The total number of positive cases in hunted wild boar: **18**

Last positive cases: 8. 2. 2018 in hunted wild boar

15. 4. 2018 in dead wild boar (about 5 – 6 months old cadaver)

All positive cases in high risk zone (only 89 km²).



NO OUTBREAK IN DOMESTIC PIGS

ASF - Total number of wild boars and domestic pigs ASF tested/positive (26. 6. 2017 – 17. 9. 2018)

WILD BOARS

1) Infected area (Part II according to the EU regionalisation)

- found dead 433 / **212 positive (48%)**
- hunted 3 537 / **18 positive (0,5%)**

2) Other areas of the Zlín region (Part I)

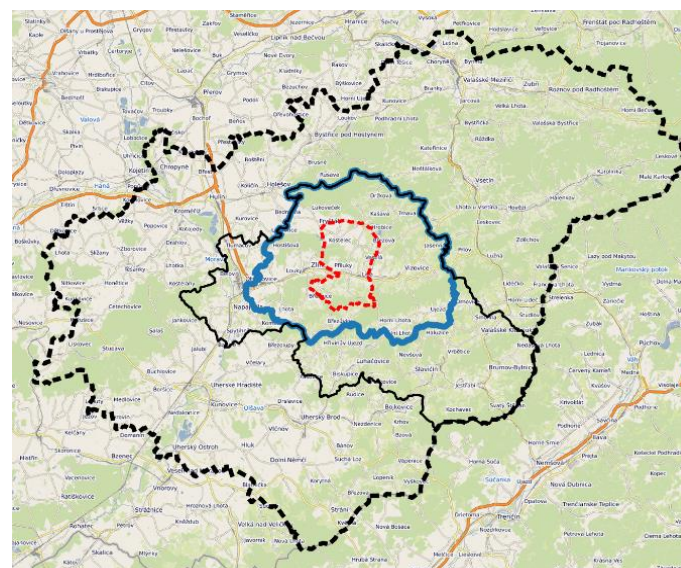
- found dead 137 / **0 positive**
- hunted 9 695 / **0 positive**

3 Area with intensive hunting (without Part I and II areas)

- hunted 9 599 / **0 positive**

4) The whole Czech Republic (without Part I and II areas)

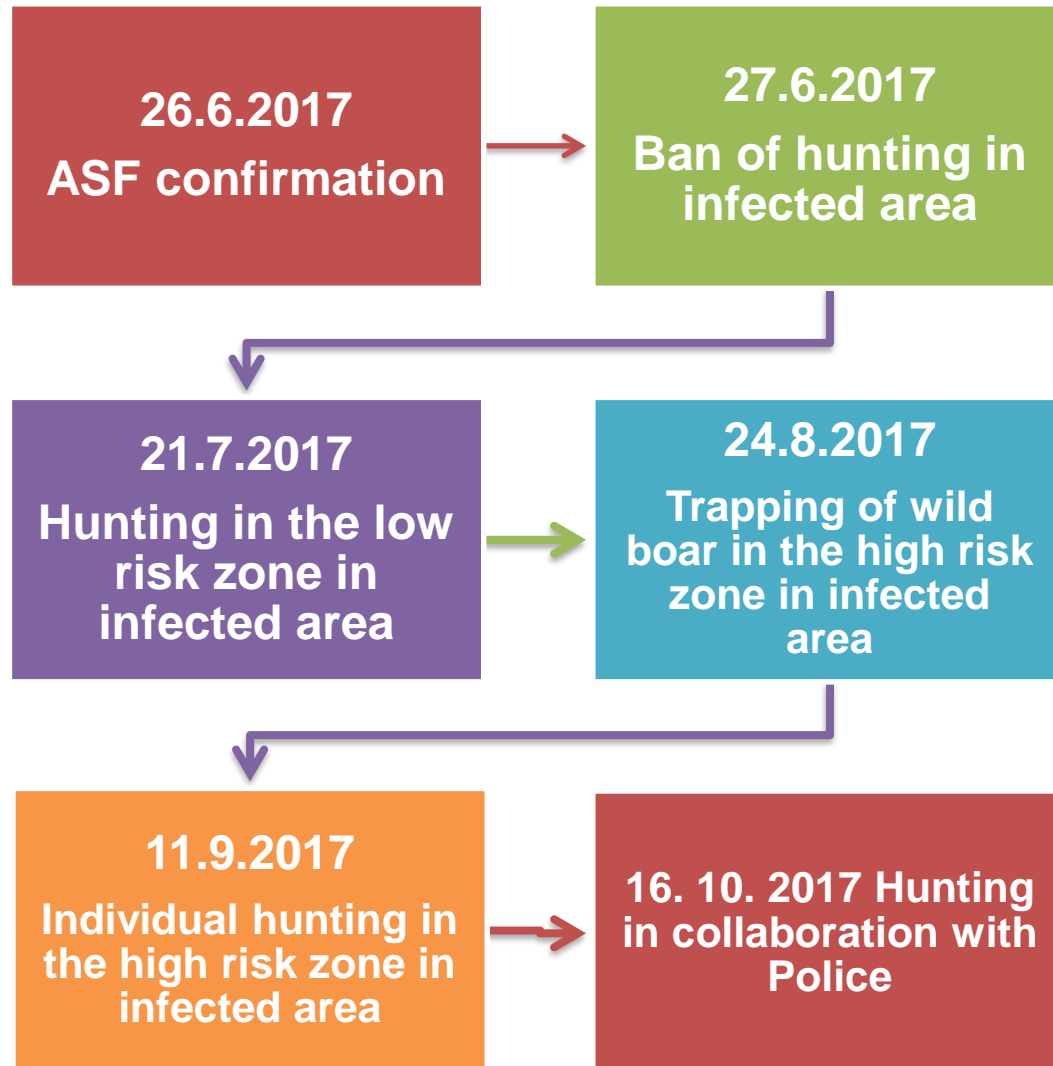
- found dead 2 049 / **0 positive**



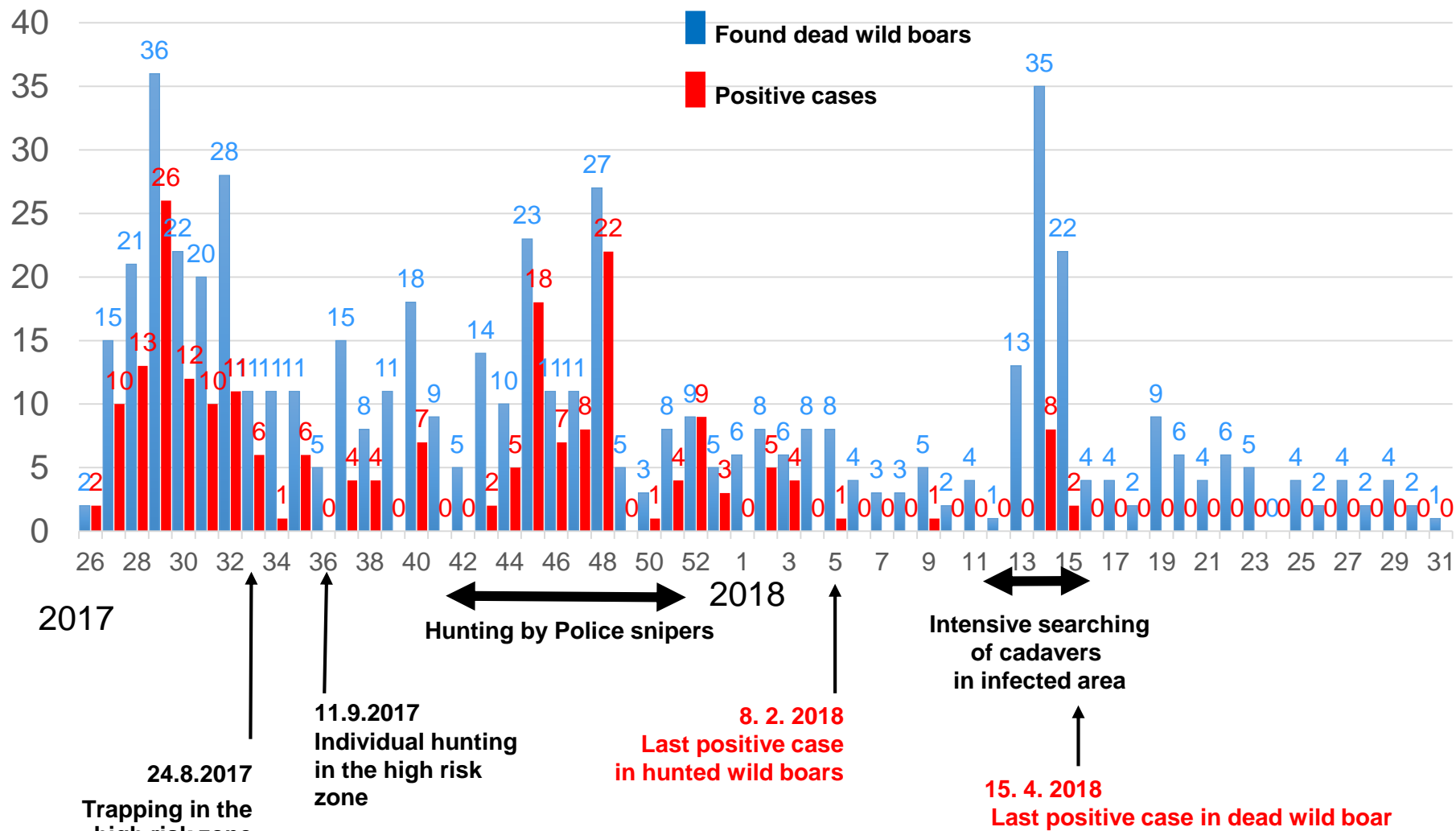

ASF - Estimates of the number of wild boars in the highest-risk area (fenced area) and current situation

- Original estimate (July 2017) was 150 – 200 (250 max) wild boars only
- Total number of hunted or found dead wild boars is **582** to 17. 9. 2018 (299 hunted; 283 found dead)
- New estimates were made in July - August 2018 using trail cameras (game cameras), thermovisions and watching by hunters. The total estimated number of pigs was **15-20** (August 2018), only individual wild boars were observed.

The current situation confirms that the process of reducing the number of wild boars has been correct and effective.



ASF – Currently measures in force in infected area (Part II)

- Official control in domestic pig farms continue in accordance with Commission Implementing Decision 2014/709/EU.
- Farmers must report all dead pigs in the breed in the infected area, ASF laboratory tests are performed.
- Movement of pigs only with authorization issued by the RVA for Region Zlín.
- Ban on keeping of pigs in backyard farms in the infected area from 12. 3. 2018.
- Ban of entering in the highest risk area - entrance only with the permission of the municipal office.
- Smell (odor) and electric fences remain functional.
- Active search of wild boar cadavers continue.
- Intensive hunting of wild boar continue – only individual hunting by trained hunters with compliance the rules of biosecurity.
- All found dead and hunted wild boars are ASF tested and safely disposed in rendering plant.

ASF – information to the public

In accordance with the ASF strategy for Eastern Part of the EU and the draft information obligations of the Member States, the Czech Republic distribute information on the risk of the transmission of ASF and on the control measures on all international airports, all international communications roads, and related road networks.
