


ASF is a social and economic phenomenon and it is a challenge not only for the Veterinary Service!

- wild boar





Forecasts for ASF spreading

Spreading of ASF in Baltic and East European region (accorging to OIE)




legend:

- domestic pigs




Density of ASF outbreaks in wild boars







Seasonal prevalence of ASF in wild boars in the RF

- зона III (ЕС)







Wide spread of ASF in Baltic countries

Conclusions:

- Negligence of real risk and delay in taking operative decisions and measures for containment of disease outbreaks and prevention of its further spread aid to the disease establishment in other regions and countries.
- High density of the susceptible wild animal population, social and economic situation and special characteristics of farm pig production in East European countries facilitate the disease spread.
- Emergence of the southern route will aggravate the complicated epidemic situation in the region.
