


Pig livestock population in Ukraine

There are **7,6 mln. heads** of pigs in Ukraine including: **3,75 mln. heads** in the agricultural farms and **3,85 mln. heads** – in the small backyard farms of citizens








Density of pig population in the backyard farms of citizens













ASF outbreak sites where quarantine is still in place

Depopulation of wild boars:

By the Decree of the State Antiepizootic Commission under the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated of 31.07 2015 № 3 it has been decided to carry out the depopulation of wild boars in the ASF regions and threatening regions including territory of natural reserve and The exclusion zone.

According to the Resolution of the State Veterinary Inspector dated of 12.08.2015 № 88, carcasses of all killed boars in the ASF regions must be destroyed without laboratory tests.

In ASF free regions carcasses of killed boars can be only used after negative ASF lab results are obtained.

There were shot almost 12 thsd wild boars in 2015 in Ukraine, among 65 thsd available (18%), herewith 90 % were shot in ASF regions.





There is a permanent monitoring on virus presence in order to control ASF in wild fauna




Annually 3 thsd samples from wild boars are tested




Active and passive monitoring are carried out (basic rule goes for passive monitoring)

Active and passive monitoring are carried out (basic rule goes for passive monitoring). Testing of all hunted and dead wild boars




Reduce the number of wild boars
