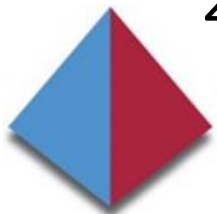
Report by Republic of Moldova

Map of the vaccination area

On the territory of the Republic of Moldova in 2014, two vaccination campaigns were conducted (autumn and spring). The vaccine in the amount of 110 thousand doses was distributed throughout the country, in the bait pills 20 doses for each burrow.

After that, in 2017, a single vaccination campaign (autumn) was conducted, as well as the same dose distribution.

In 2019 the Government approved a Decision establishing the strategy for combating this disease, and its main objective is the total elimination of rabies by 2023.



According to the Government Decision no.185 of 2019 on the approval of the Measure Plan for the surveillance, control and eradication of rabies in the foxes of the Republic of Moldova for the years 2019-2023, the National Agency for Food Safety: will ensure the implementation of the actions of the Plan of supervision, control measures and eradication of rabies in foxes in the Republic of Moldova for 2019-2023. This project was supported by the Government of Romania and 50% co-financed by the European Union.

According to the Government Decision no. 185 of 2019, an objective besides the basic ones is the accreditation of the laboratory according to the Standard SM EN ISO / IEC 17025: 2018 in the serological methods for the detection of post-vaccine antibodies.

Subsequently, ANSA initiated the procurement procedures for air vaccination services. But this failed because the only bidder offered a double price for the vaccine. We are already preparing the procedure for next year, the spring campaign and the autumn campaign.

- According to the annual strategic plan, the vaccination of pet animals is carried out free of charge every year, from 500 to 700 thousand heads throughout the territory of the republic.
