# ASF SITUATION from 29 May to 10 September 2019

**Czech Republic** 

### Wild boar surveillance

In the zones of the country considered free until at least the beginning of the period

#### Wild boar found dead

Period considered (ideally 29 May to 10 September)	N° wild boar found dead	% PCR positive	% seropositive
from 29 May to 6 September	303	0	0

#### Wild boar hunted

Period considered (ideally 29 May to 10 September)	N° wild boar hunted	% PCR positive	% seropositive
from 29 May to 6 September	unknown	0	0

In the zones of the country already considered affected at the beginning of the period

Since 14 March 2019 there are no such zones in the Czech Republic.

### Cases in wild boar – country map

Period considered (ideally 29 May to 10 September): from 29 May to 6 September

There were no positive ASF cases in wild boar in the Czech Republic during this period.



### Domestic pigs surveillance

In the zones of the country considered free until at least the beginning of the period

Period considered (ideally 29 May to 10 September)	N° suspicions <sup>*</sup> Commercial farms / backyards	N° confirmed outbreaks Commercial farms / backyards
from 29 May to 6 September	195/ 12	0/0

<sup>\*</sup> laboratory tests in cases: all sows which underwent abortion, mass mortality of pigs in the holding, sudden death of pigs after weaning without identified cause or in the event of an ASF suspicion

Since 14 March 2019 there are no such zones in the Czech Republic.



### Outbreaks in domestic pigs – country map

Period considered (ideally 29 May to 10 September): from 29 May to 6 September

There were no ASF outbreaks in domestic pigs in the Czech Republic during this period.
