## Wild boar found dead

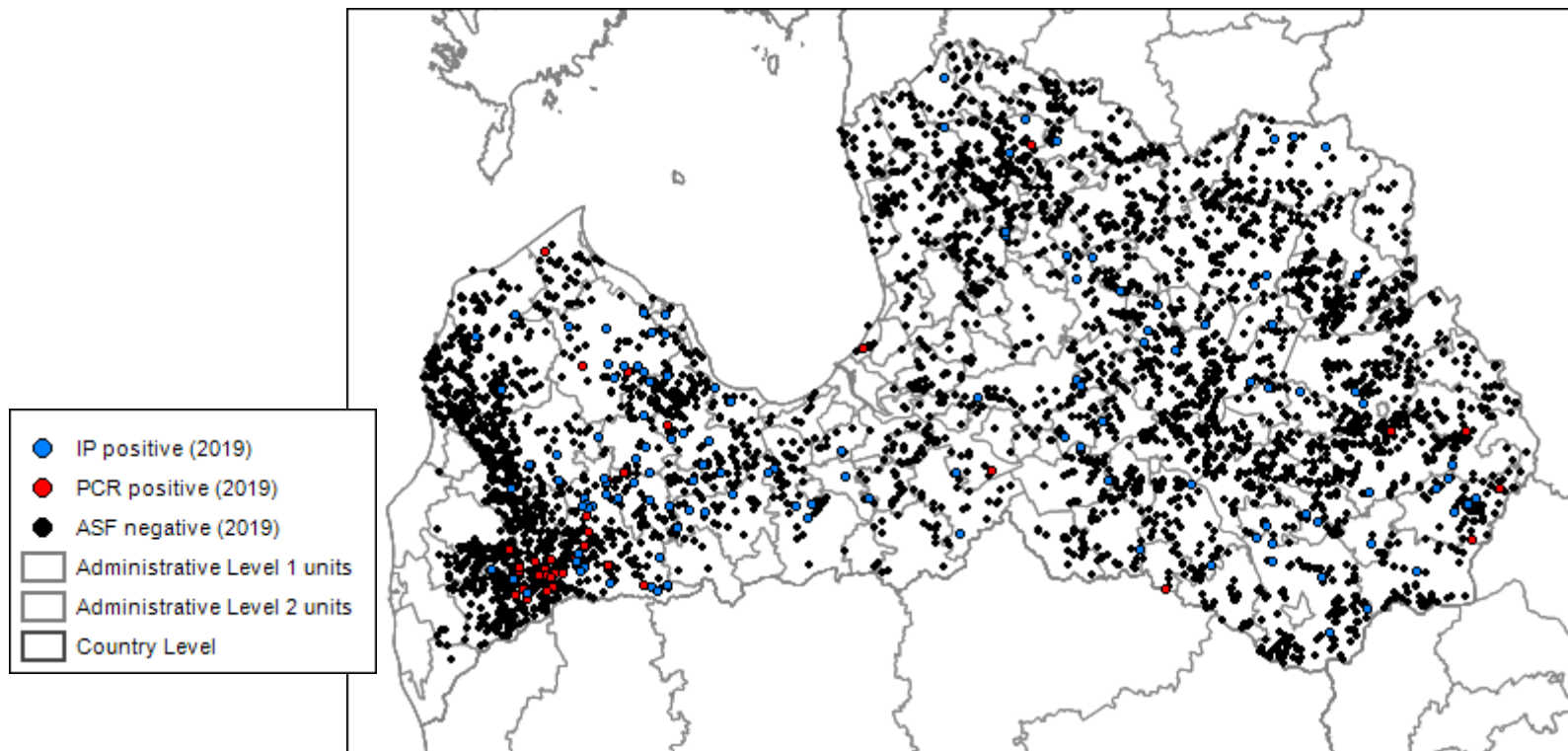
Period considered	N° wild boar found dead	Positive (% PCR positive)	% seropositive
2019	60	21 (35%)	0

## Wild boar hunted

Period considered	N° wild boar hunted	Positive ( % PCR positive)	Positive (% seropositive)
2019	7752	50 (0.64%)	191 (2.46%)

# Domestic pigs surveillance

2019

Period considered	N° suspicions	N° confirmed outbreaks
2019 (up to September)	6	1 (52 pigs)

Suspicious were detected in back yards or small farms.

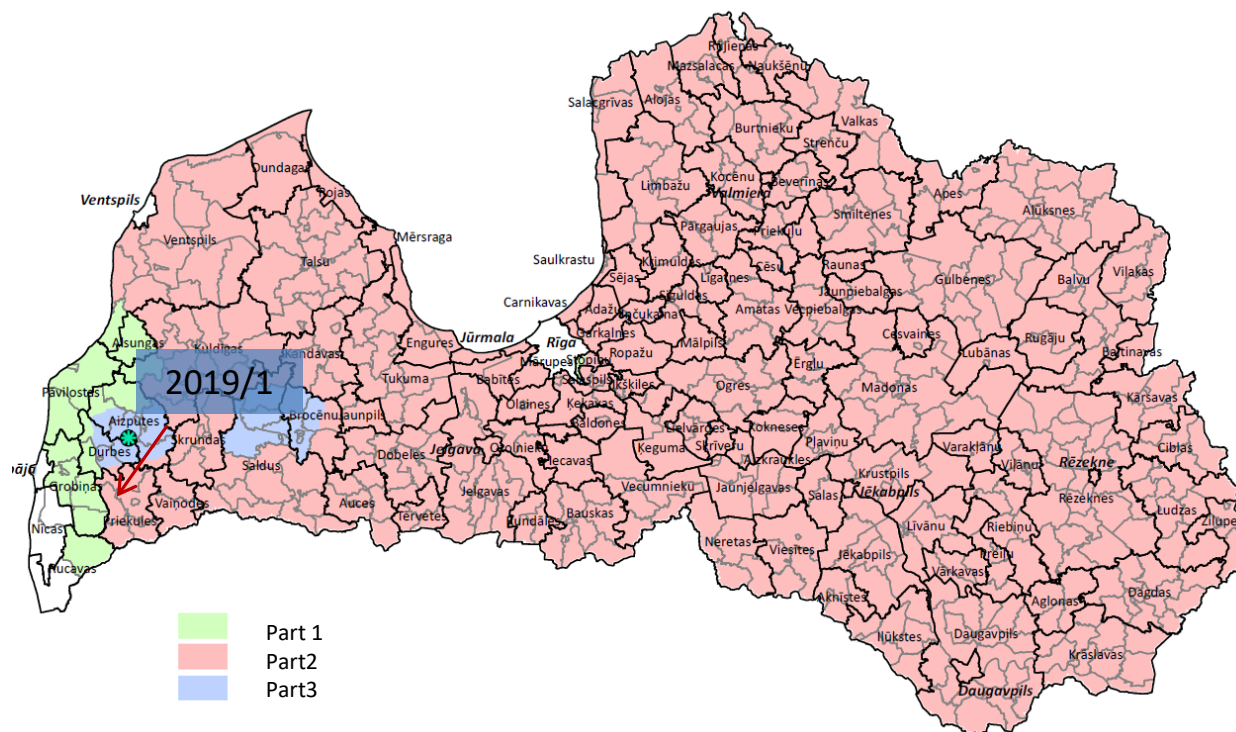
Enhanced passive surveillance are stipulated in legislation and performed in all commercial farms (EU ASF strategy -SANTE/7113/2015 - Rev 10)

« b) Each week, in the form of virological testing of at least the first two death (post weaning pigs or pigs older than 2 months) in each production unit»
