




- 3 commercial farms (in total 52, 52 and 24 pigs were kept)

Outbreaks in domestic pigs – country map

2019-29 May to 10 September 15 outbreaks:

- 12 back-yards, (41 pigs destroyed);
- 3-commercial farms (130 pigs destroyed)
