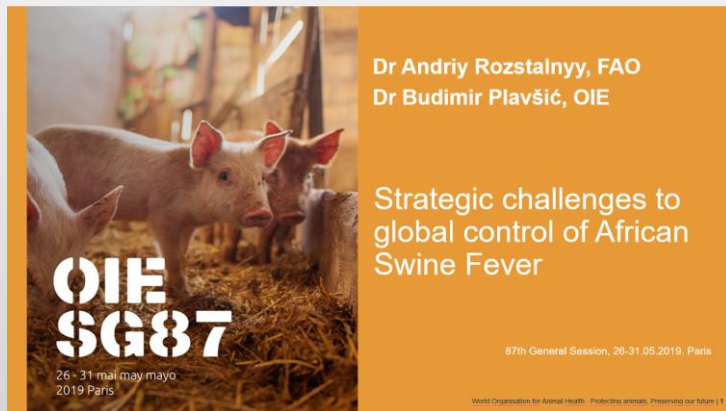
Update of GF-TADS Initiative for the Global Control of ASF (2020-2025)

87th General Session, Technical item 2

Resolution N.33

A **global initiative for the control of ASF** be launched using the GF-TADs mechanism to develop, improve and harmonise national, regional and global partnership and coordination [...] minimise adverse impacts on animal health and welfare, international trade, and social wellbeing.

- Associated to M&E

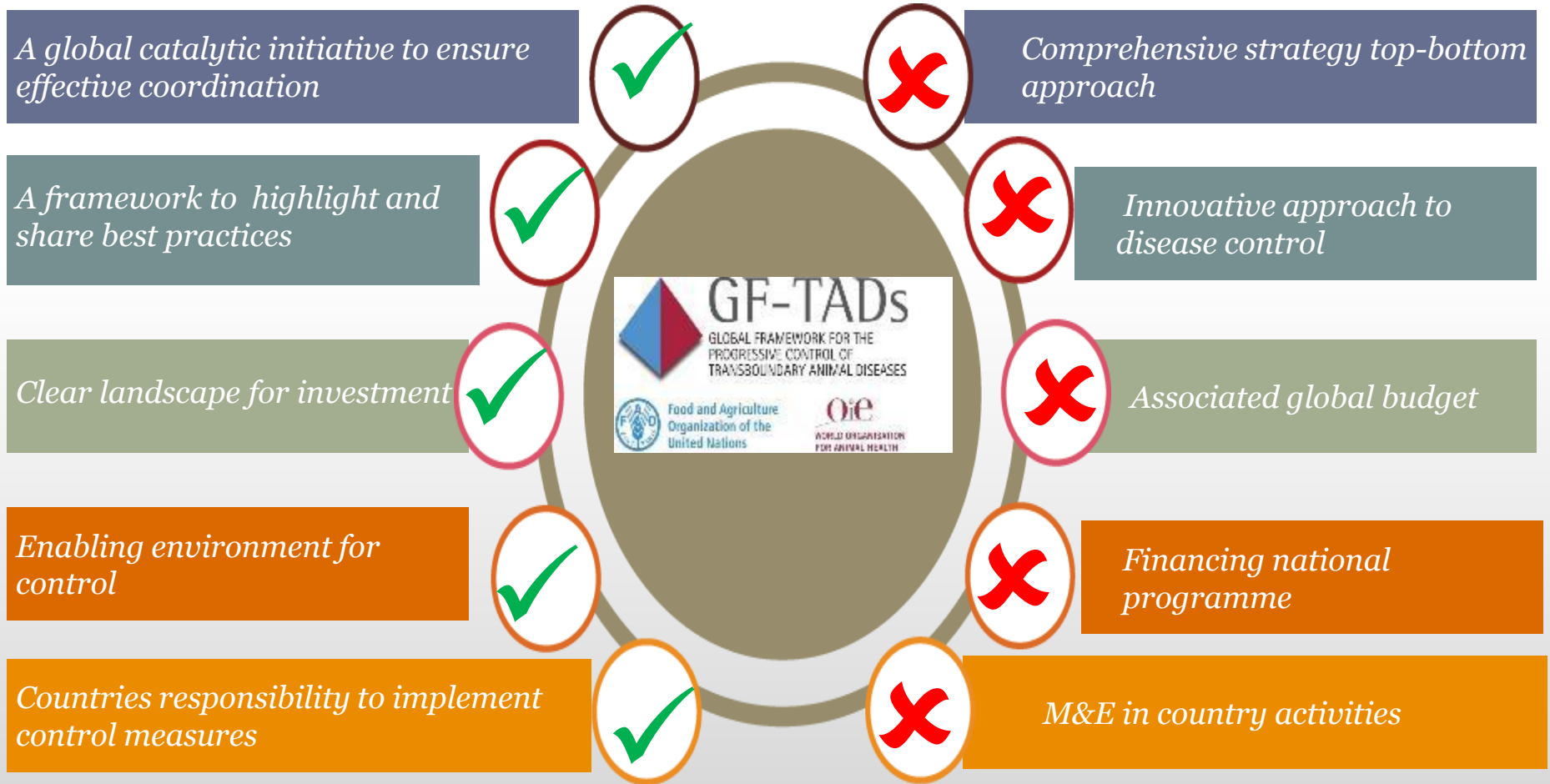
Governance

The elements of the Initiative

Narrative

- Defines the call for action, strategic challenges, governance and the theory of change

Theory of Change

- Schematic representation of chain of events required to achieve the goal
- Consists of problem statement, and links the objectives, outputs and outcomes to achieve the overall goal

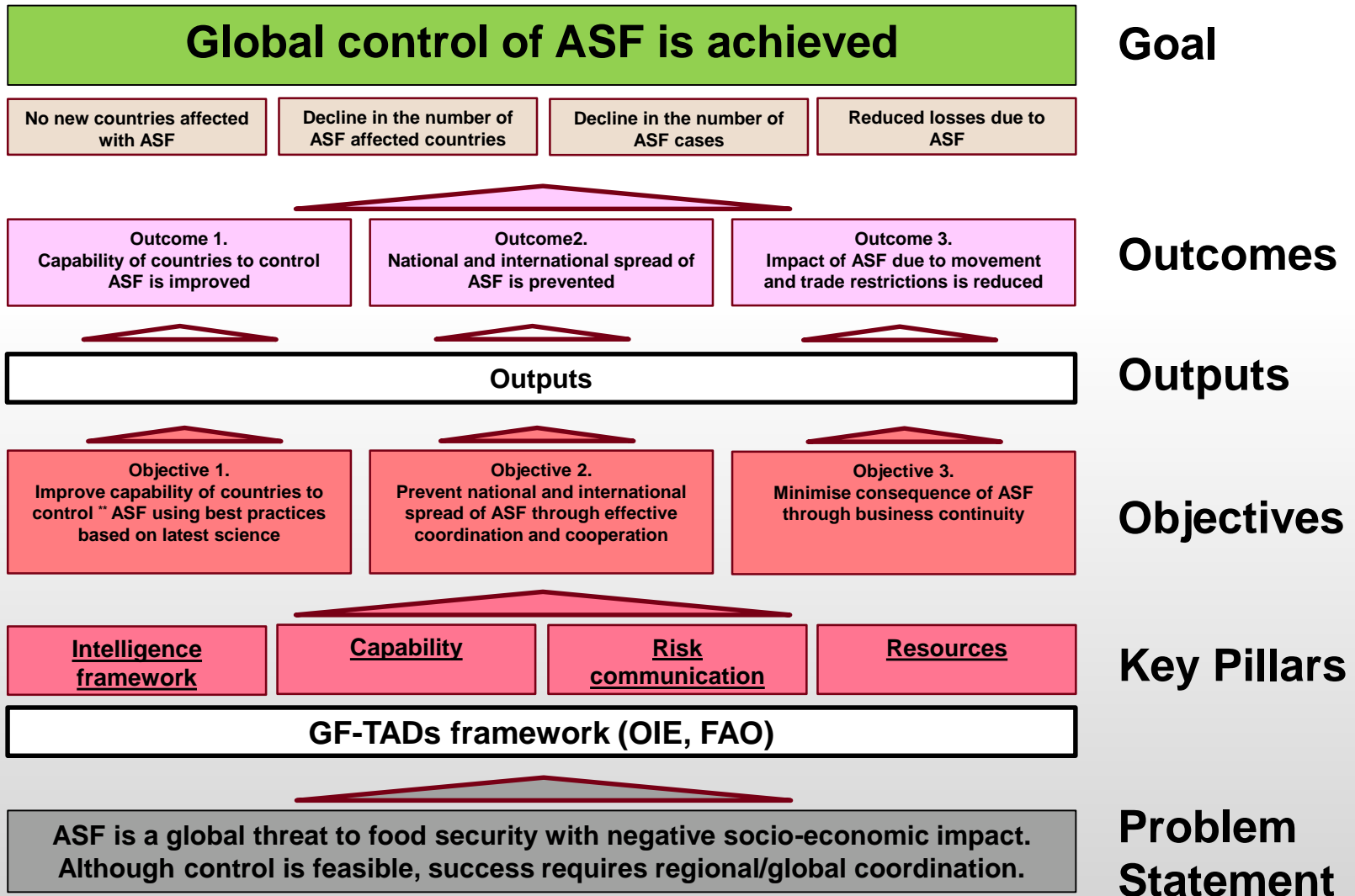
Logic framework

- Heart of initiative
- Defines the problem, objectives, outputs, outcomes and the overall goal
- Indicators for evaluation and monitoring of progress

Operational plan

- Specific activities implemented under **GF-TADS** responding to the objectives

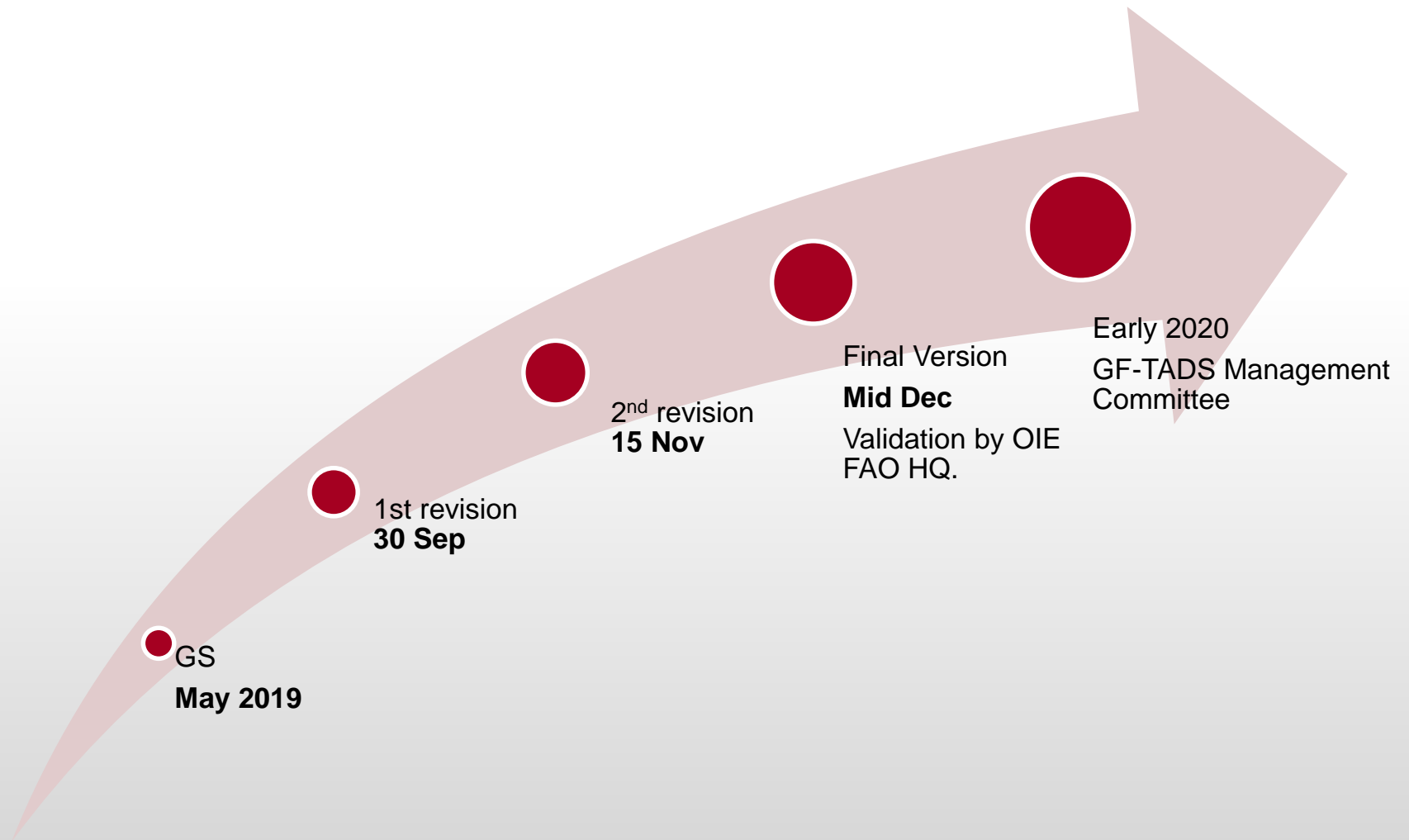
