Wild boar surveillance

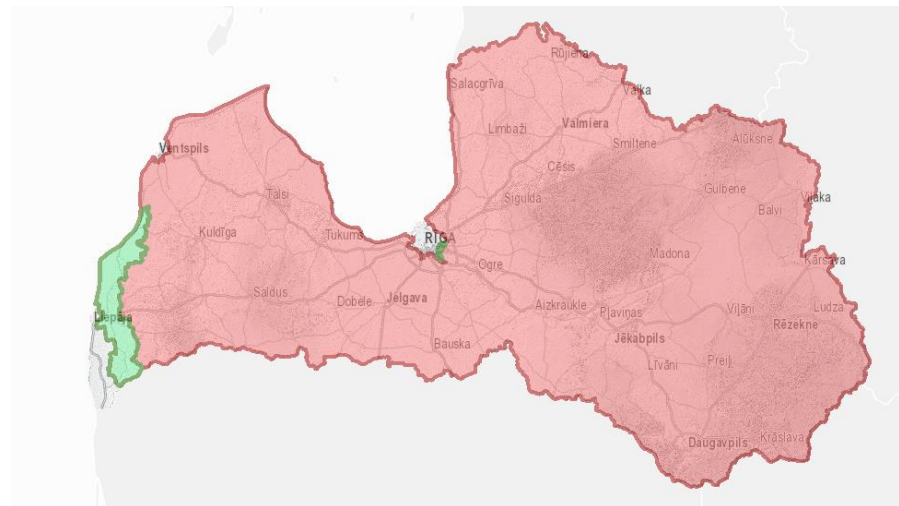
Wild boar found dead

Period considered	N° wild boar found dead	% PCR positive	% seropositive
September 2019 – April 2020	83	52 (62.6%)	0

Wild boar hunted

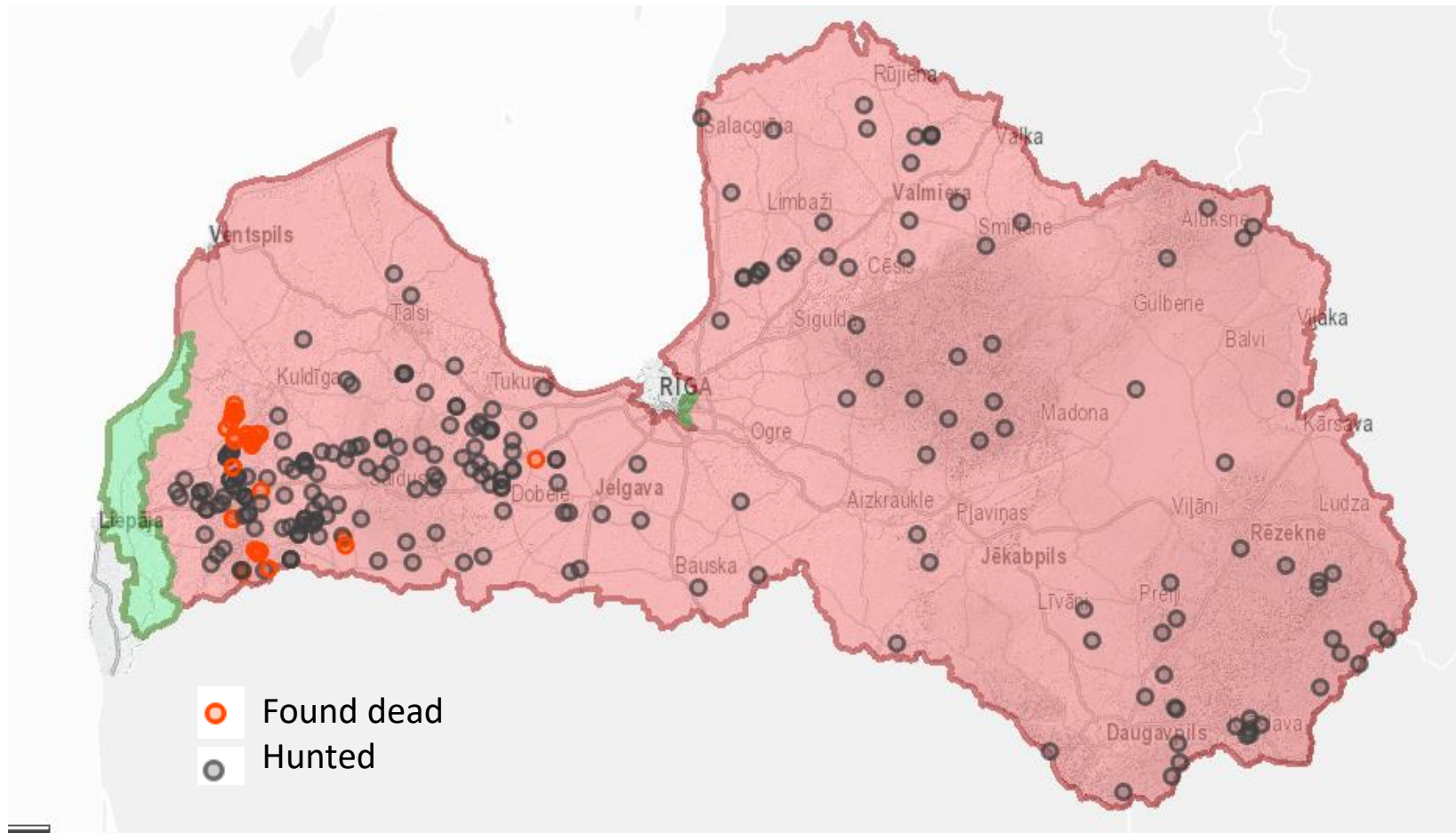
Period considered	N° wild boar hunted	% PCR positive	% seropositive
September 2019 – April 2020	9079	47 (0.5%)	188 (2.0%)

Domestic pigs surveillance

Period considered	N° suspicions	N° confirmed outbreaks
September 2019 – April 2020	4	0



ASF surveillance during COVID 19 period

Wild boar active and passive surveillance – 100%

Domestic pig surveillance:

- Passive surveillance - 100%
- Biosecurity checks – on site inspections are replaced by a remote national database checks
