



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


Maintenance of an officially recognised FMD status: Scope



- Maintain the compliance with the requirements of the Terrestrial Code for FMD
- Annual reconfirmation mandatory for Members having an officially recognised FMD status or
 a validated official control programme



Importan Notice

In accordance with Resolution No. 15 adopted at the 83rd General Session and other relevant Resolutions previously adopted,

- Member Countries having an officially recognised disease status or BSE risk status should reconfirm every year, during the month of November that remained unchanged.
- Member Countries having an officially endorsed control programme should inform the OIE during the month of November on the progress on the in the control programme.

Please find below a list of diseases for which your country has an officially recognised status or an endorsed official control programme. You will be directed to the relevant annual reconfirmation form to be completed by clicking the link.
