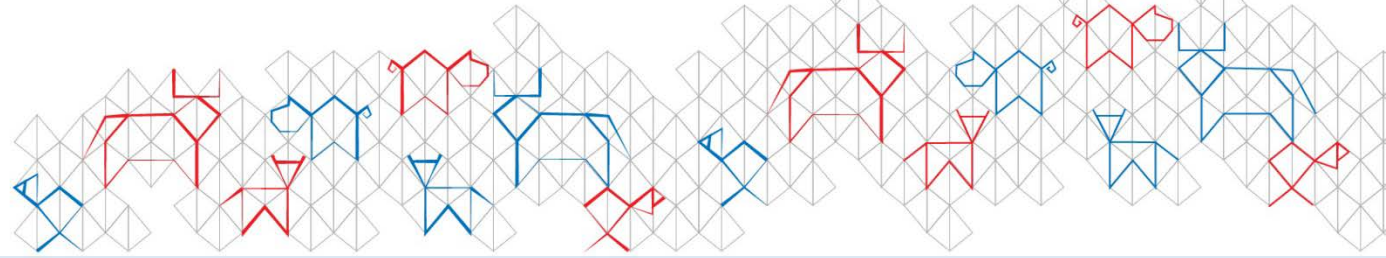
## GF-TADs Governance and priority diseases

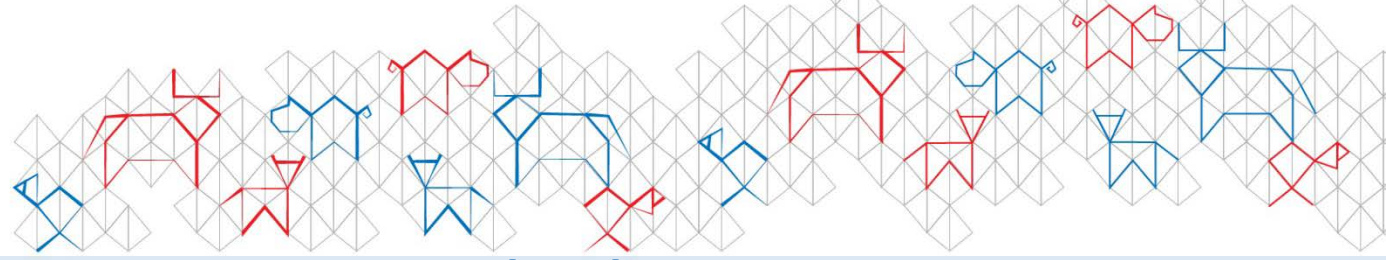

## GF-TADs Global Steering Committee (GSC)

- **May 24, 2004: FAO-OIE GF-TADs general agreement**
- **GSC is highest advisory body of GF-TADs**
- **GSC: high level management OIE and FAO, Presidents and Secretariats RSCs, MC, chairs Priority Disease WGs, CVO's, donors, technical partners, private sector partners**
- **10<sup>th</sup> GF-TADs GSC meeting November 2018**
- **11<sup>th</sup> GF-TADs GSC meeting (3, 4 November 2020) 3<sup>rd</sup> session taking place 17 December**

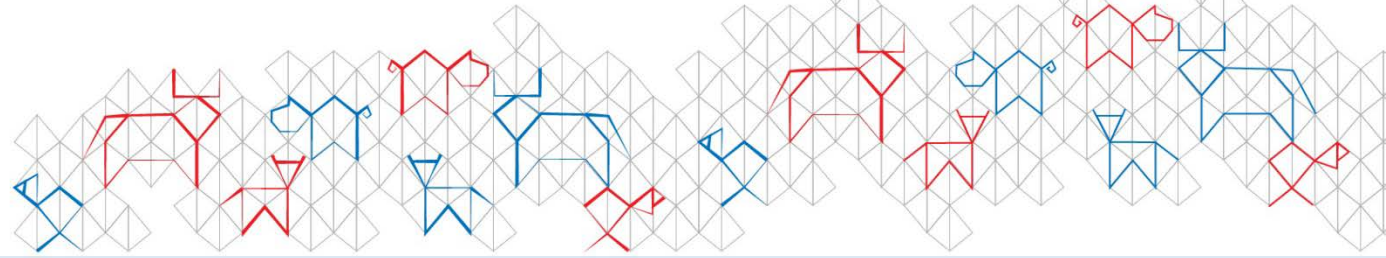
*The GSC provides guidance on technical activities of global scope and strategic directions to Regional Steering Committees*

*GF-TADs Management Committee makes all final decisions regarding the GF-TADs initiative at the global and regional levels and supervises the GF-TADs Global Secretariat*




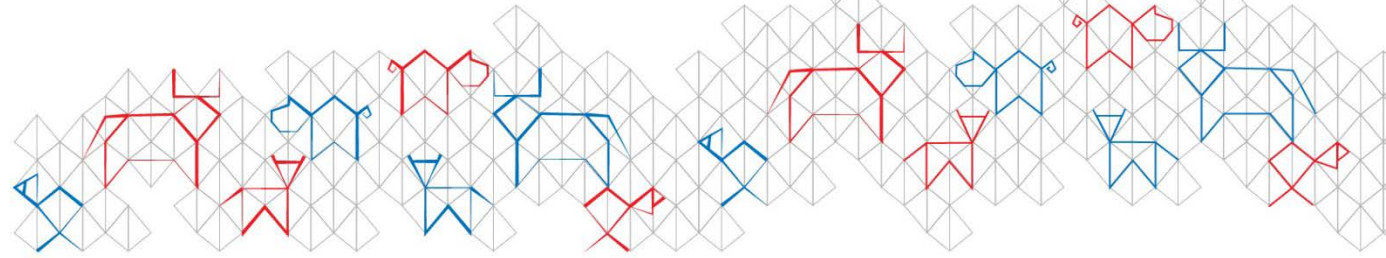
## GF-TADs Global Secretariat

*The Global Secretariat is the facilitating body and liaison between global and regional level.*

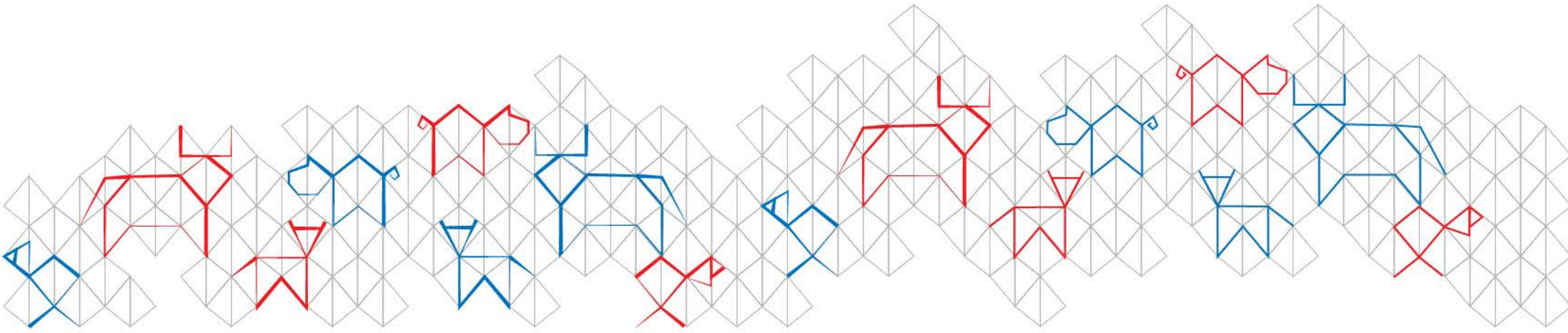
