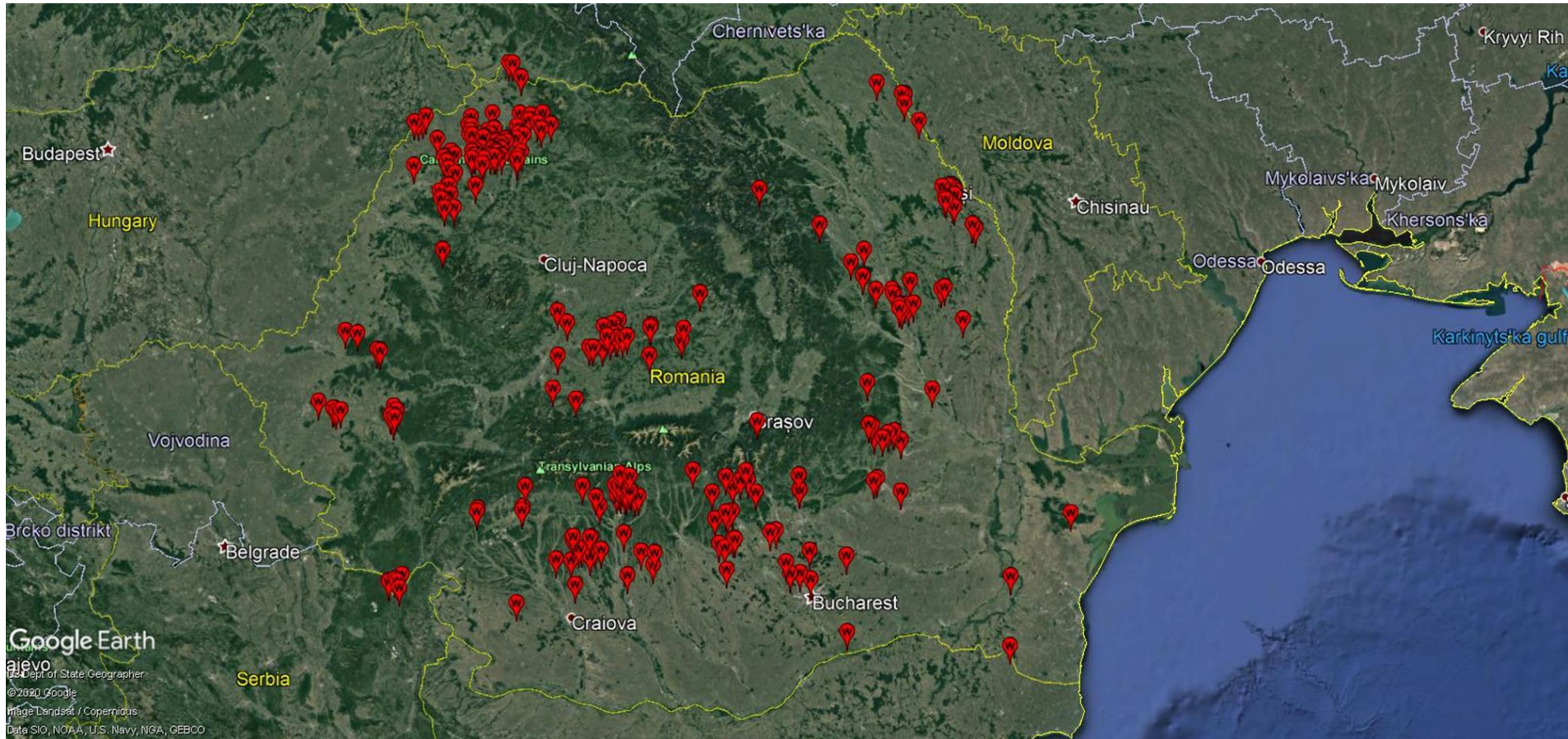

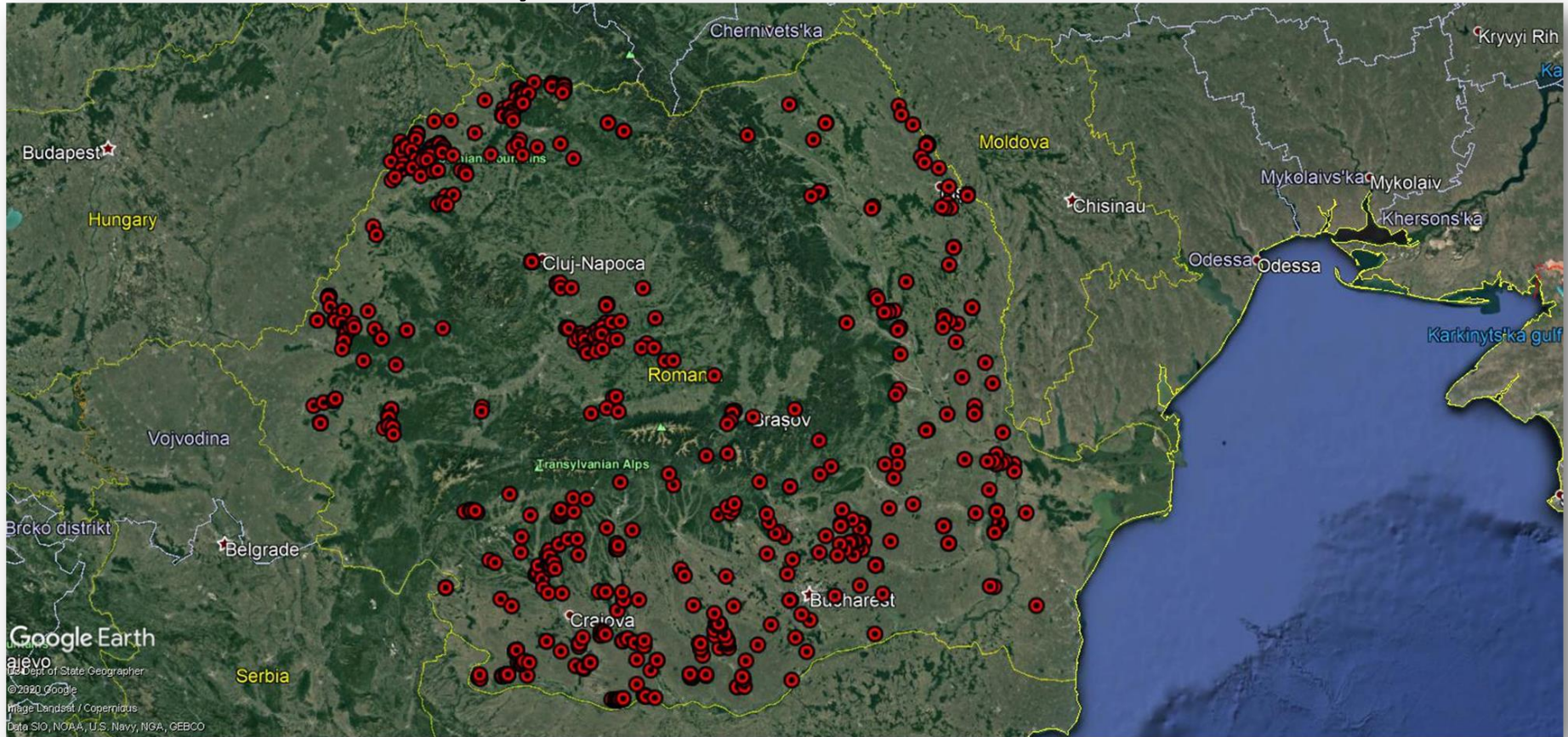

# How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

Control measures (such as clinical and laboratory examinations) are difficult to carry on, on account of:

- In protection and surveillance zones there are numerous backyards with pigs in which there are quarantined people,
- Backyard owners are reluctant to allow veterinary inspectors, even if all precautions and measures are foreseen,
- Insufficient on field staff due to *work from home* protocol during COVID-19 state of emergency,
- Veterinary laboratories are involved in the COVID-19 crisis through specialized personnel and PCR equipment.

Romanian stakeholders are demanding the adoption of exceptional measures to contribute to the security of the national pork production and food safety.
