# Wild boar surveillance

**In the zones of the country considered free until at least the beginning of the period**

## Wild boar hunted

# Cases in wild boar – country map

Period considered (*ideally 05 May 2020 to 23 November 2020*):

**05 May 2020 - 13 November 2020**

**No cases of ASF among wild boars were detected in Ukraine during this period**



# Domestic pigs surveillance

**In the zones of the country considered free until at least the beginning of the period**

# How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

**Period considered : 05 May 2020 - 17 November 2020**

During this period, only one case of ASF was registered in Ukraine among domestic pigs with a relatively significant number of animals (3.8 thousand heads). In another case, there were up to 200 heads of pigs and in 12 cases - up to 100 heads.

Given that even without the registered cases of COVID-19, all measures to eliminate ASF are carried out with the use of personal protective equipment and safety. The presence of COVID-19 among human did not significantly affect the measures to combat ASF.
