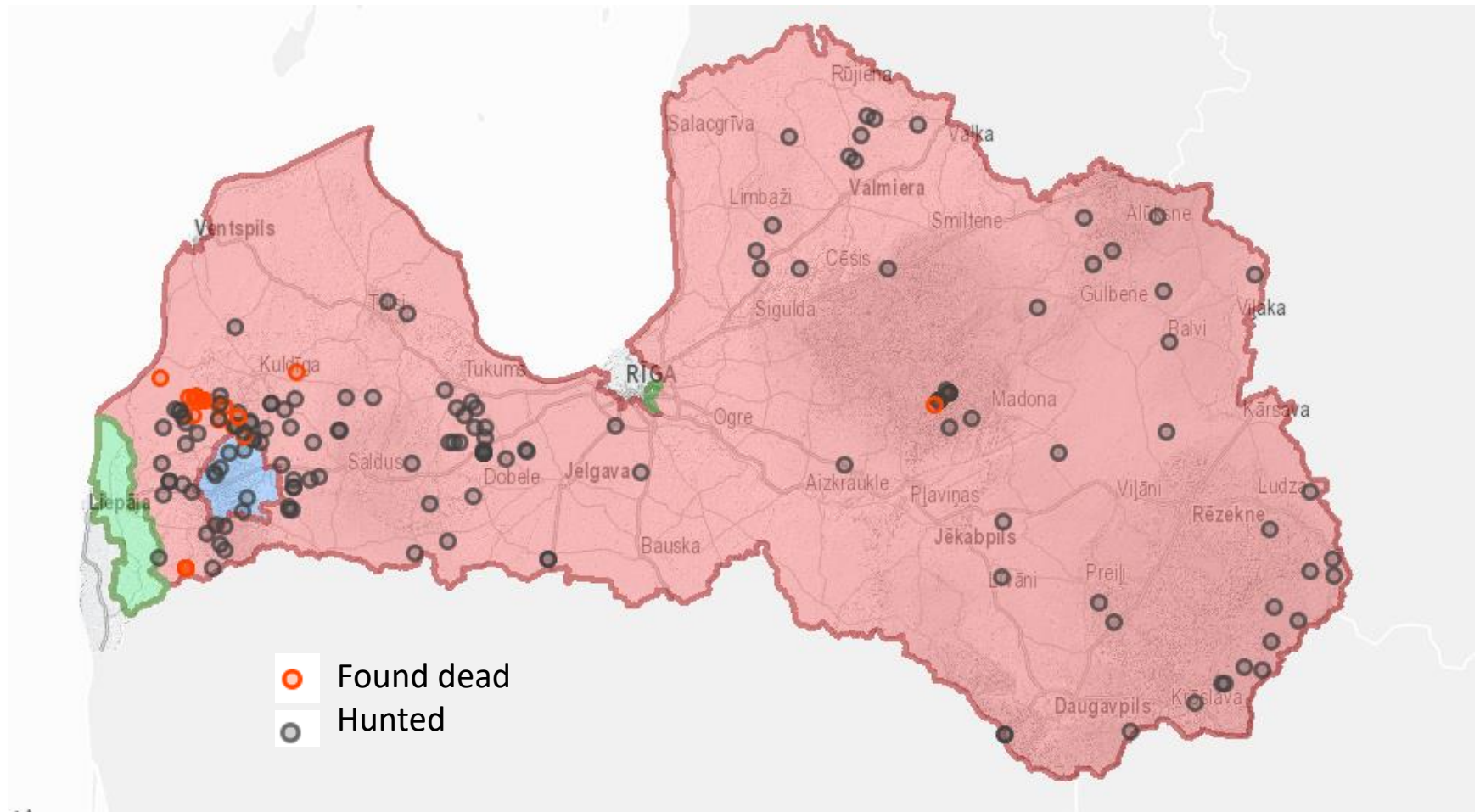

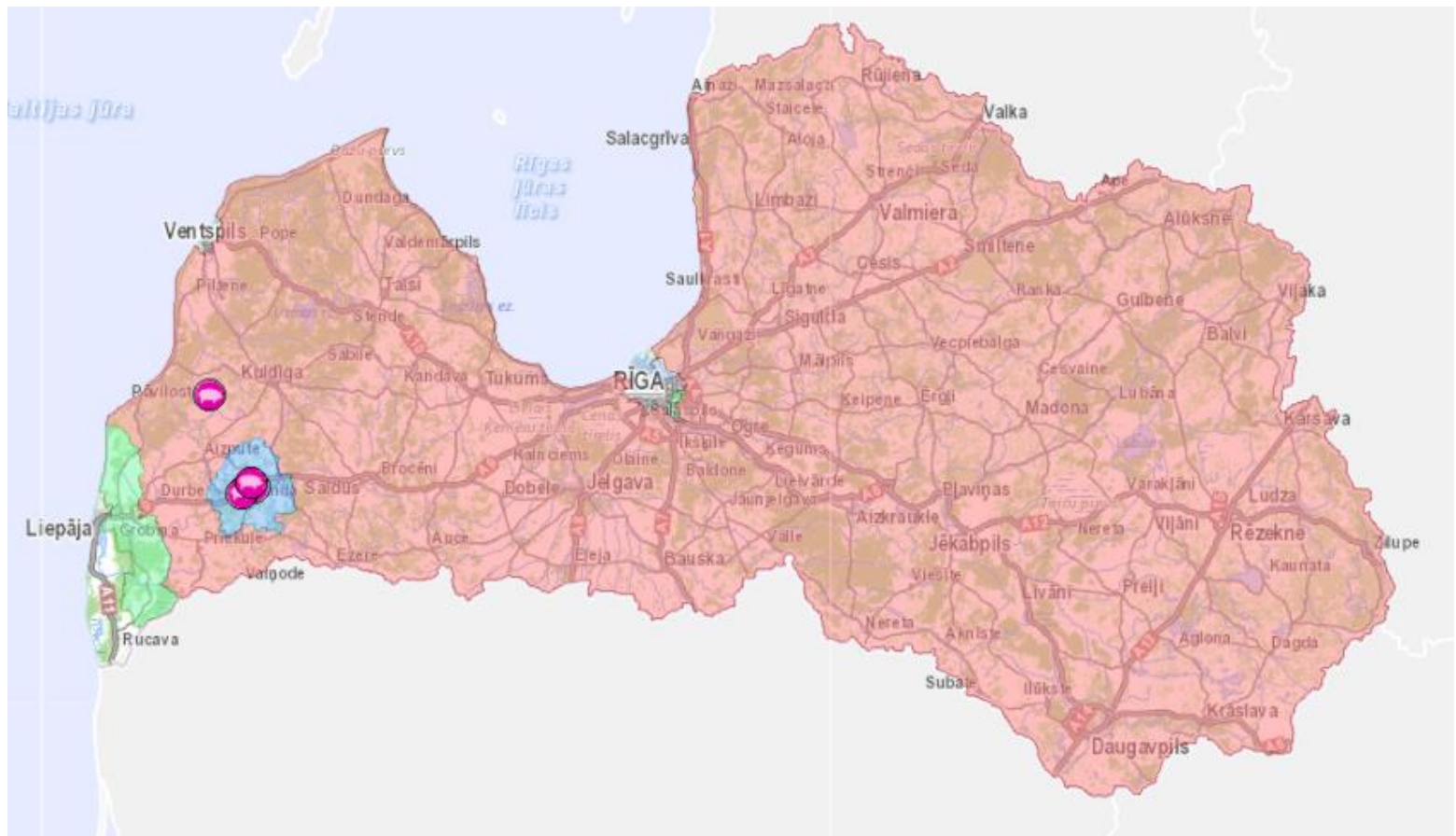
Wild boar hunted
