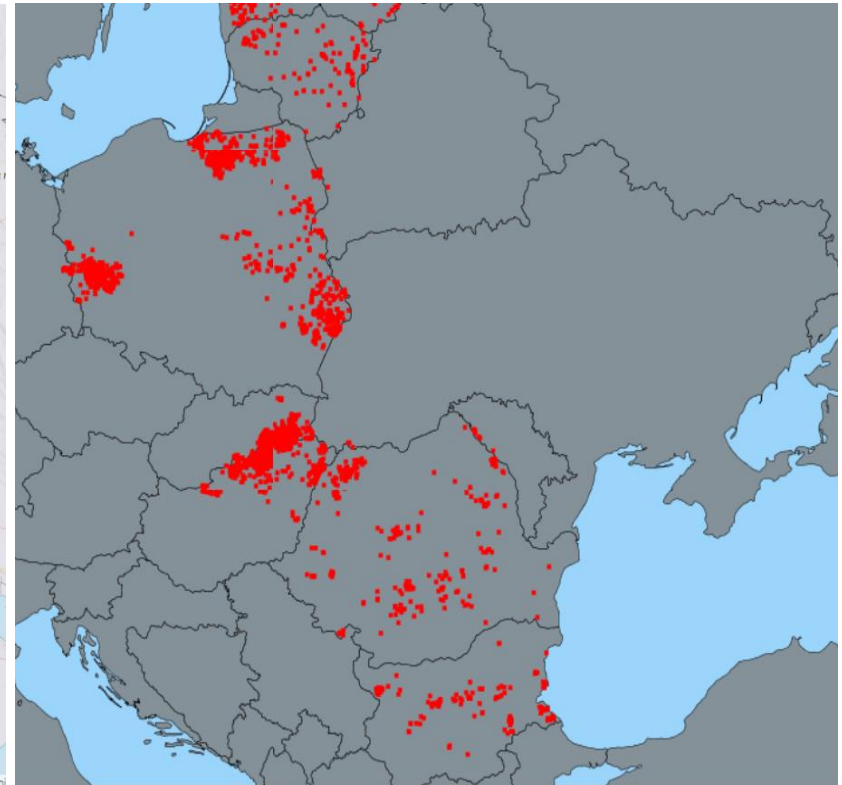
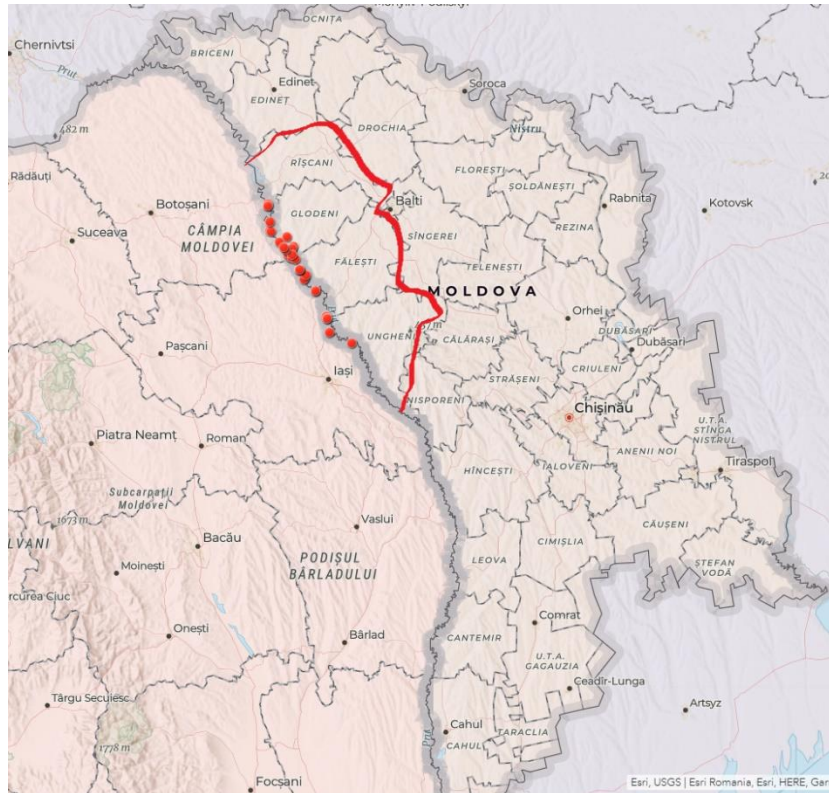

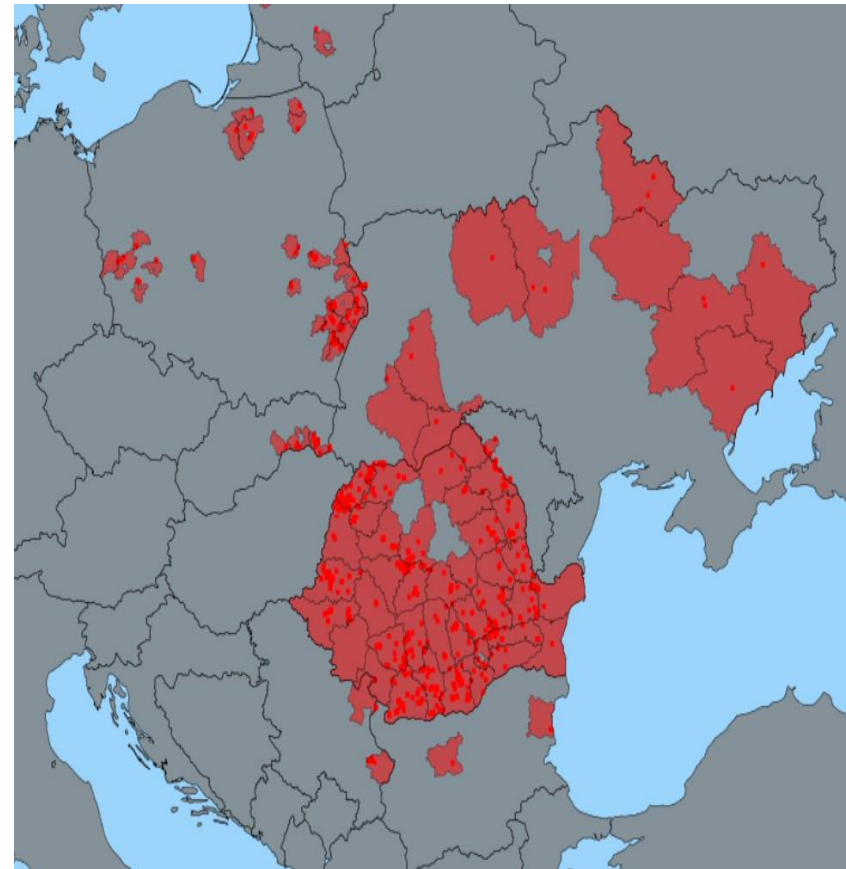
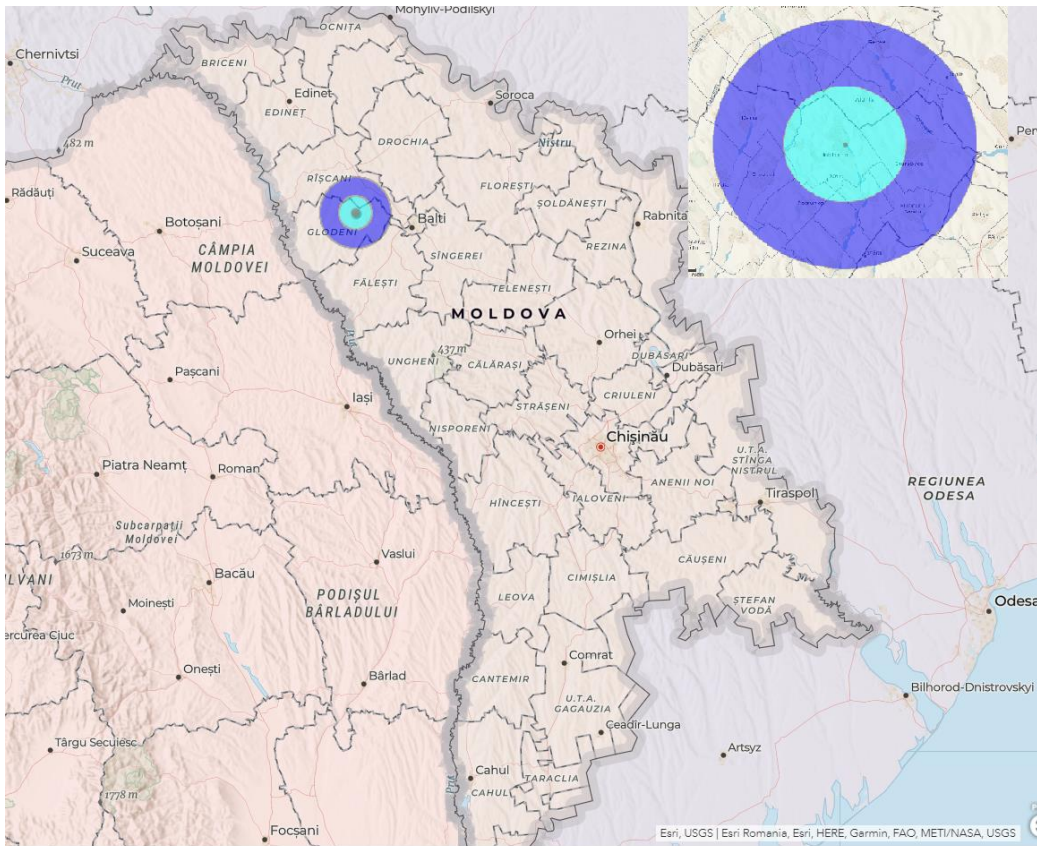
How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

The evolution of COVID-19 in the Republic of Moldova determined the authorities to apply restrictive measures such as population movement, organization of local fairs, conducting events, including trips abroad. Therefore, these restrictions have led to the removal of predisposing factors and determinants of the ASF spread (so the illegal introduction into the country of animal products has decreased up to 0). We can also mention that the population has become much more aware and receptive to the calls of the authorities.
