

Data collected for LSD through WAHIS since 2005

• Every semester: Situation in each country, preventive and control measures applied & quantitative data


 When exceptional epidemiological events occur: immediate notifications within 24h and weekly followup reports

Background: Global situation of LSD - 2005-2019


Asia: stable in some Middle-East countries, spread to new countries in the Middle East in 2013, 2014 & 2015, spread to new countries in Southern Asia in 2019

countries






 No data collected through six-monthly reports (transition to OIE-WAHIS)


 Data only collected for exceptional epidemiological events through immediate notifications & follow-up reports





Djibouti (continuing since October)

1 outbreak (village)












Vietnam (continuing since October)

9 outbreaks (one to five animals/household)




LSD notification in Europe in 2020



Russia (August to November) Recurrence in Altayskiy Kray 2 outbreaks (farm and backyard)

OIE active search activity and LSD

- EIOS system for epidemic intelligence
- Daily screening of the web for all OIE-listed diseases (100,000 news screened in 2020)
- LSD: Around 500 news detected and verified during 2020
- Constant communication between OIE and Members
