Lumpy Skin Disease surveillance

Type of surveillance implemented

- Within the Romanian territory it is applied a surveillance programme in bovine holdings.

This programme is approved by the National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority's President Order no. 17/2018.

- The surveillance programme has as goal maintaining the LSD free status of the country.
- The components of the surveillance programme are as follows:
 - passive surveillance
 - notification of any suspicion of infection in susceptible animals
 - laboratory testing – PCR and Real-Time PCR- at designated laboratory (5) and National Reference Laboratory (IDAH);
 - active surveillance - in case of epidemiological risk;
 - vaccination – at the confirmation of disease on Romanian territory.



Legal basis for management and control of disease

- Contingency Plan and Operational Manual – posted on NSVFSA's website
- COUNCIL DIRECTIVE 92/119/EEC transposed in national legislation by Order 133/2006
- COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION (EU) 2016/2008
