




## Outbreaks in domestic pigs – country map

Geographical distribution of samples submited for ASFV investigation in domestic swine in Slovakia during 2021 (January - 10 May)



# How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

Period considered: October 2020-May 2021

- 2 national lockdowns ordered by SK government
- Limited possibilities for performing the checks (biosecurity) of the PIG FARMS AND HUNTING GROUNDS
- Activities related to searching of dead WBs / hunting of WB in certain areas and laboratory investigation of samples taken maintained
- The trinigns of hunters postponed
- Experts group related to the analysis of the ASF development by reflecting the situation in the regions affected – the participation of all parties (vets, pig breeders, hunters) postponed or carried out via web in the narrowed format



# Summary 2021

- Period 1.10.2020-30.4.2021: 2241 posit. WB tested in 14 districts
- Year 2021: 747 ADNS + 266 ADIS reports 266 ADIS localisation of regions affected – south /northeast part of Slovakia – only by WB
- Epizootolgical enquiry done- naturally spread of infection (trans-border, within SK from infected to previosly free regions)
- New methodological guidelines adopted by State Veterinary and Food Administration – topic: movement od pigs – it corresponds with the EU legislation 2021/605/EC
- A lot of ADNS messages reported by the end of 2020 and at the beginning of the year 2021 – in the infected area a lot of findings of dead WB reported, hunters are active in searching of dead WB
- Active and passive surveillance of WB in place- depending the localisation of hunting ground, its inclusion into the zones according the european legislation
- In new infected zones- measures newly ordered
- COVID 19 influense- lockdown- performing of checks pig farms / hunting grounds (biosecurity checks + implementation of measures ordered)
