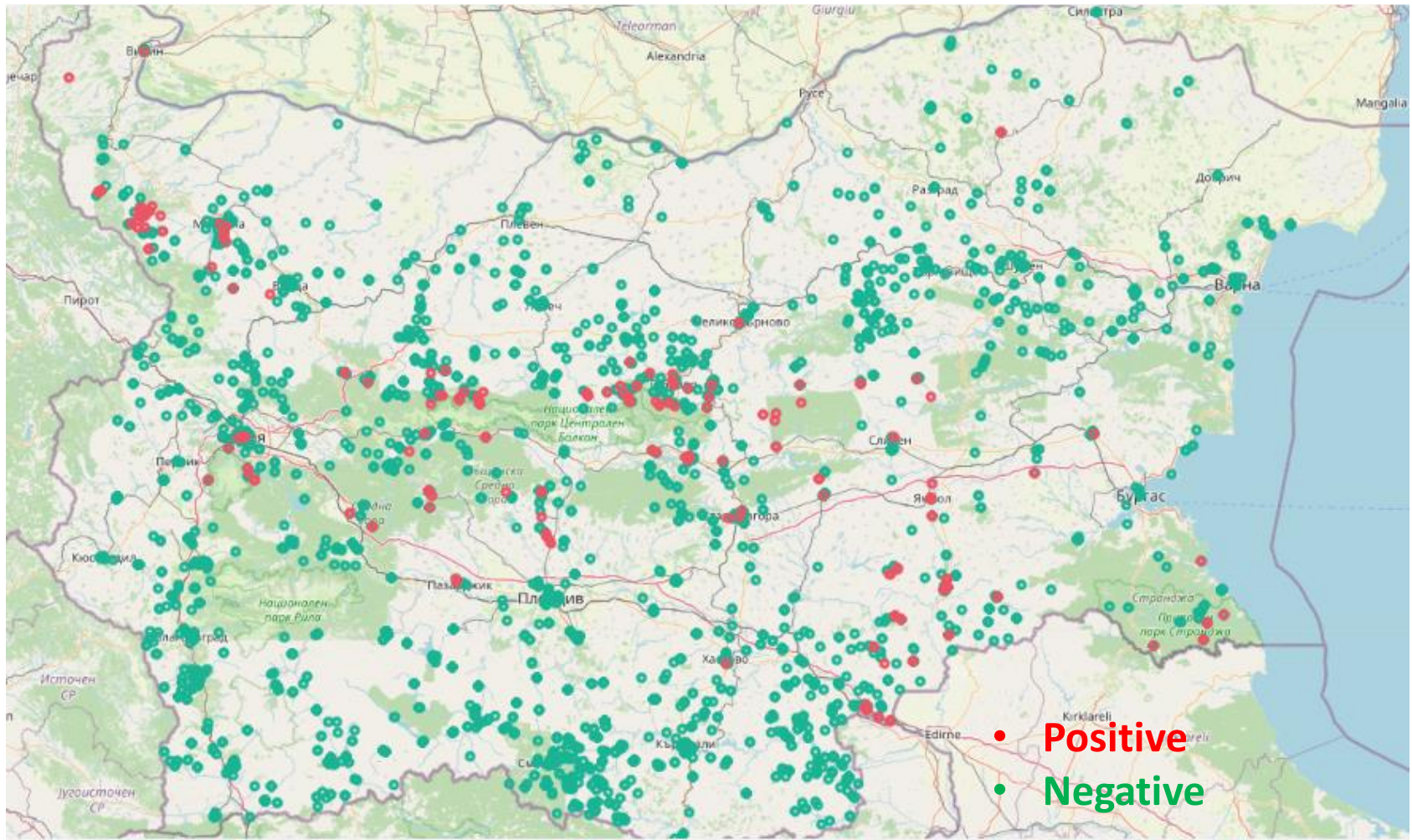

Period considered (*November 2020-june 2021*):

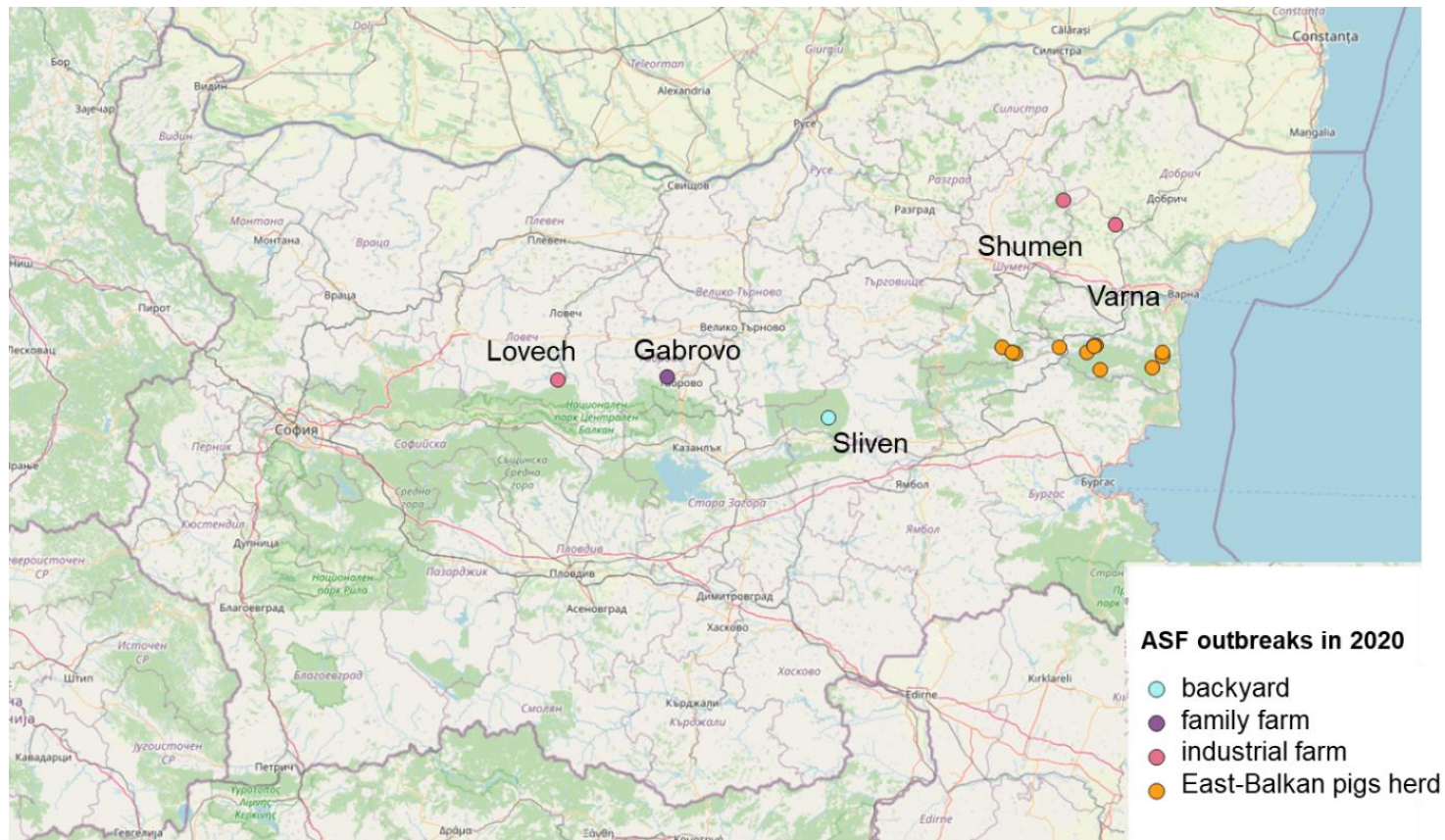
Despite the hard times during the COVID-19 pandemic and the lack of human resources the BFSA manage to continue with the implementation of the national plan and keep on going on the following actions:

- Gradual repopulation of the ASF affected industrial holdings and restoration of the production;
- Significant efforts put into biosecurity improvement – concept, procedures and infrastructure investments;
- Enhanced official controls system in place;
- Passive surveillance system in place;
- Backyard holding action plan in operation;

The last outbreak of domestic pigs on the territory of Republic of Bulgaria was on 1 October 2020 in the region of Lovech ADNS 2020/19.
