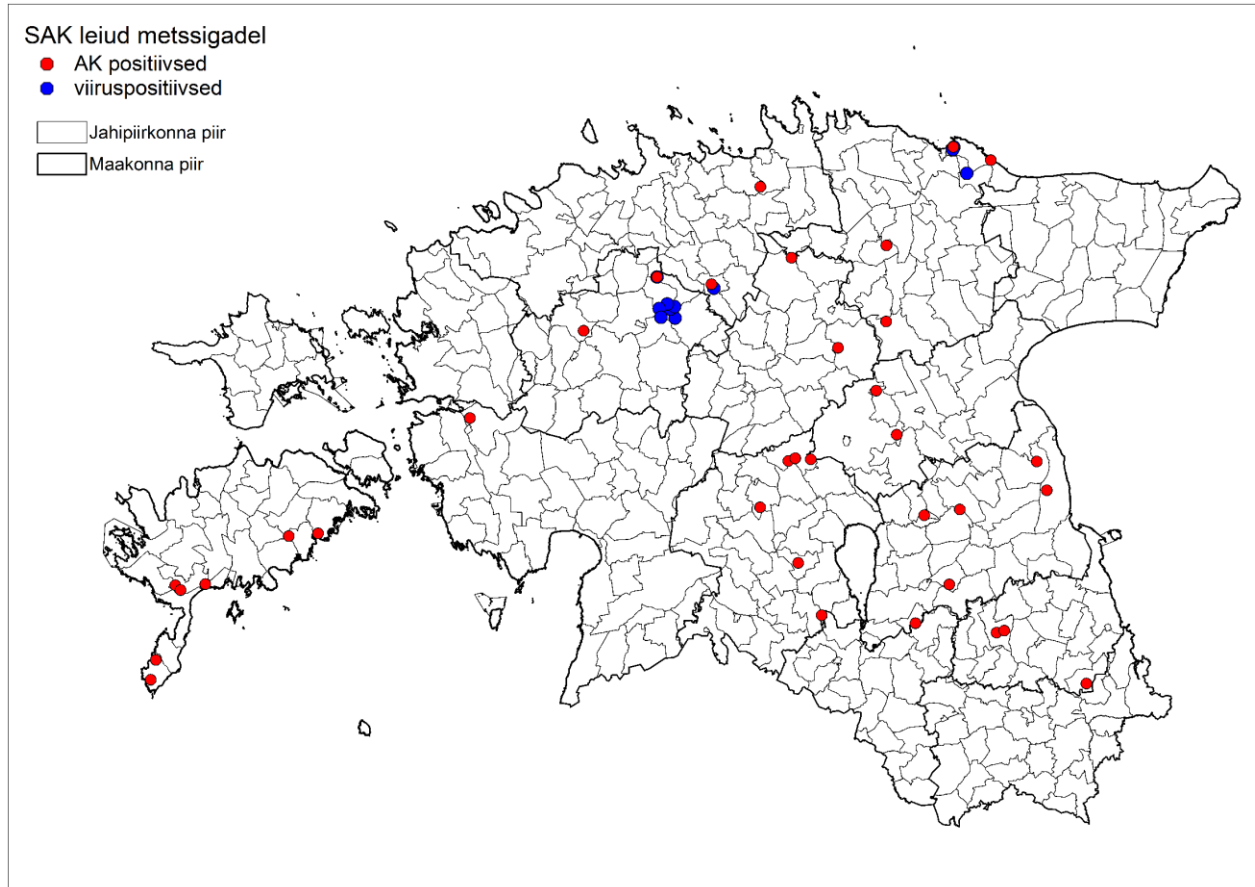

# Outbreaks in domestic pigs – country map

Period considered (01 November 2020 to 30 April 2021):

- During the period 01.11.2020 – 30.04.2021 we have tested totally 2994 domestic pigs, including 1519 dead domestic pigs.
- All results have been ASF negative.
- The last domestic pig outbreak was in September 2017.



# How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

Period considered (01 November 2020 to 30 April 2021):

- The active and passive surveillance of wild boars are maintained,
- surveillance of domestic pig is maintained,
- domestic pig farms biosecurity checks – on-site inspections are remained.
