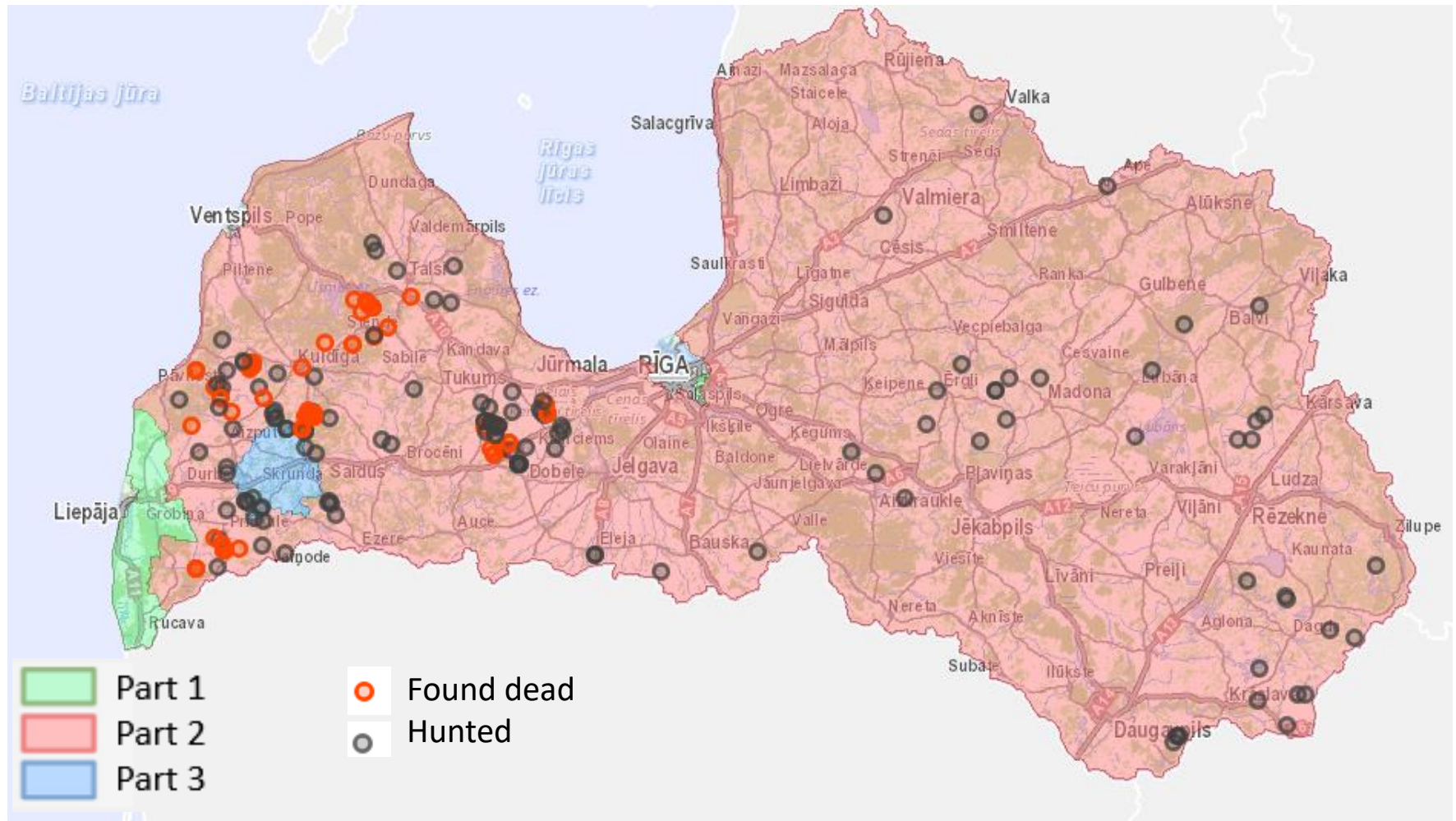

Last ASF outbreak was confirmed in July 2020.



How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

COVID 19 restrictions (gatherings restrictions and commandant hour) impact the decrease the hunting activity since 19th December.

Wild boar active and passive surveillance – according surveillance strategy.

Domestic pig surveillance – according to risk-based surveillance strategy.

Biosecurity inspections were performed - according to approved inspection plan.
