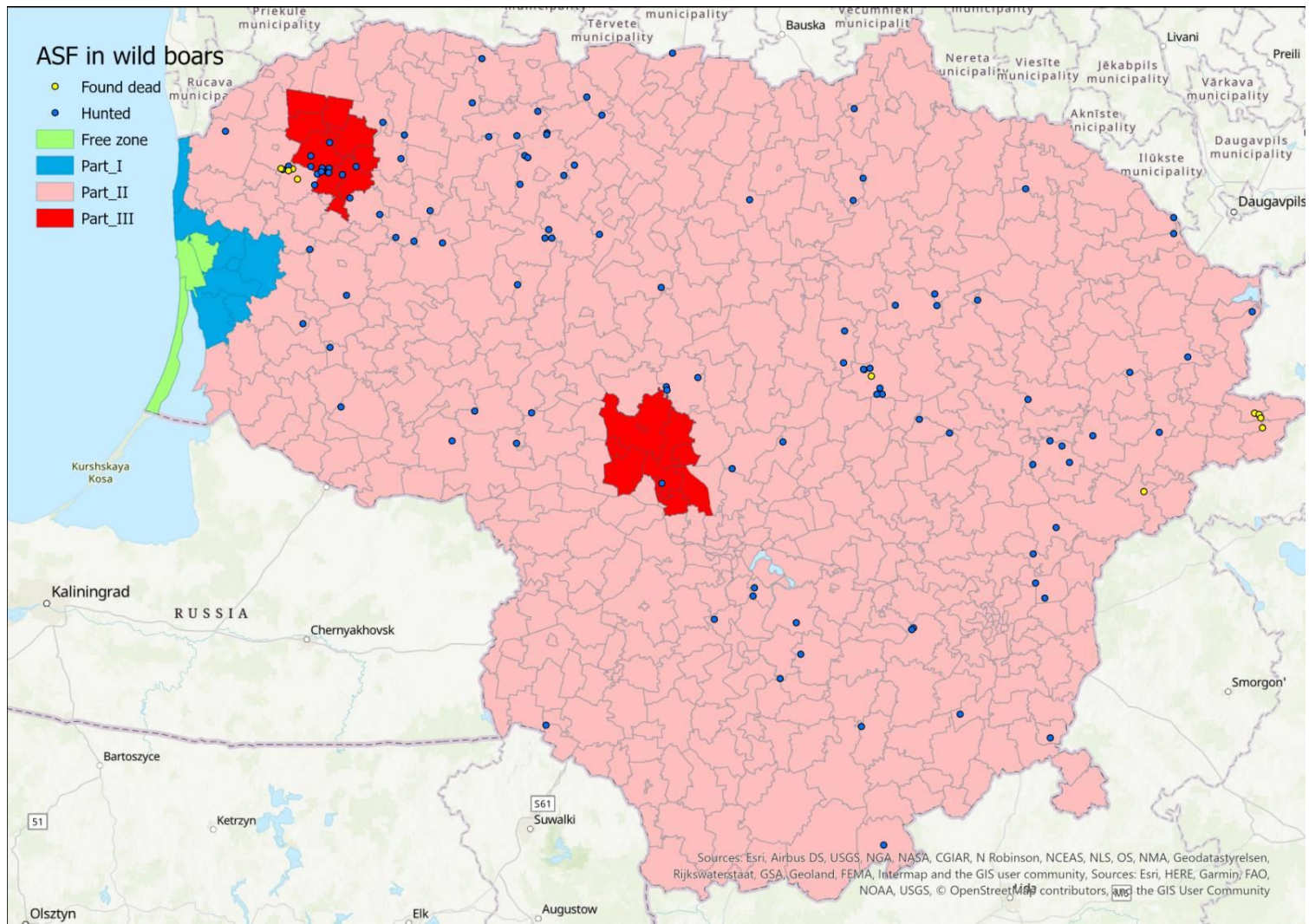

# How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

**There was no huge impact on the ASF control measures:**

- **Recurrent awareness campaign ongoing;**
- **Passive surveillance in place:**
- from the commercial pig holding at least 2 last dead pigs were sampled each week and tested by PCR for ASF virus detection;
- sick or dead pig in the non-commercial holding were sampled and tested by PCR;
- when ante or post-mortem signs raise suspicion at home slaughtering – samples were taken by the private veterinarians.
- **Inspection and investigation** were performed by official veterinarians at least once a year in the non-commercial holding and at least twice a year in commercial holdings.
