

How COVID 19 effects on ASF control and eradication measures

There was no huge impact on the ASF control measures:

- Recurrent awareness campaign ongoing;
- Passive surveillance in place:
- from the commercial pig holding at least 2 last dead pigs were sampled each week and tested by PCR for ASF virus detection;
- sick or dead pig in the non-commercial holding were sampled and tested by PCR;
- when ante or post-mortem signs raise suspicion at home slaughtering samples were taken by the private veterinarians.
- Inspection and investigation were performed by official veterinarians <u>at</u> least once a year in the non-commercial holding and <u>at least twice a year</u> in commercial holdings.

No outbreaks in domestic pigs were confirmed.
