

Recommendations of 8th RMM meeting for West Eurasia 2019 (summarized)

General

- To hold sub-regional meetings to ensure i) harmonization of objectives of vaccination strategies ii) information sharing
- Share an update information of FMD virus circulating an threatening the region and the vaccines used
- Establish timeframe to submit doc and receive feedback from the FMD WG

Countries

- To make use the support available through **PSO system**
- Collect and deliver samples to FAO/OIE Reference laboratories
- Promote implementation of **immunogenicity studies** and **share results**

Epinet-Welnet

- Facilitate **sharing of best practices** and operational procedures
- Use reference sera to calibrate laboratory assays used to assess heterologous Ab responses (to assist PVM)
- Encouraging sharing of information on outbreaks, disease control measures and risk hotspots



Recommendations of 8th RMM meeting for West Eurasia 2019

International organization

- To provide technical backstopping
- To assist regional studies on animal mobility and socio economic analysis
- Develop tools to facilitate the selection of vaccine strains
- Promote training material available in e-format
- Conduct trainings on international standards, guidelines and PCP tools
- Promote PPP concept and support establishment of PPP

Reference laboratories

- Continue provide diagnostic support, facilitate shipment, participation in PTs, vaccine matching
- Continue working on development and evaluation of rapid tests and their potential use for samples shipment
- **Publish information** about circulating strains



Overall objectives of the networks:

- Information sharing of FMD situation and challenges of control options;
- Regular update on vaccines and diagnostics available in the region;
- Capacity building programmes in support to the FMD control strategies;
- Networks in support to national and regional objectives for FMD control;
- Monitoring progress and national capacities on FMD control strategy implementation

Common issues or support requested (2019)

- Lack of communication within network members
- Mapping of migration routes of animals
- Sample shipment to reference laboratories
- Lack of Laboratory Information Management System in most countries
- Lack of NRL in some countries






Workplan 2021-2023 - Epi/Welnet network
