

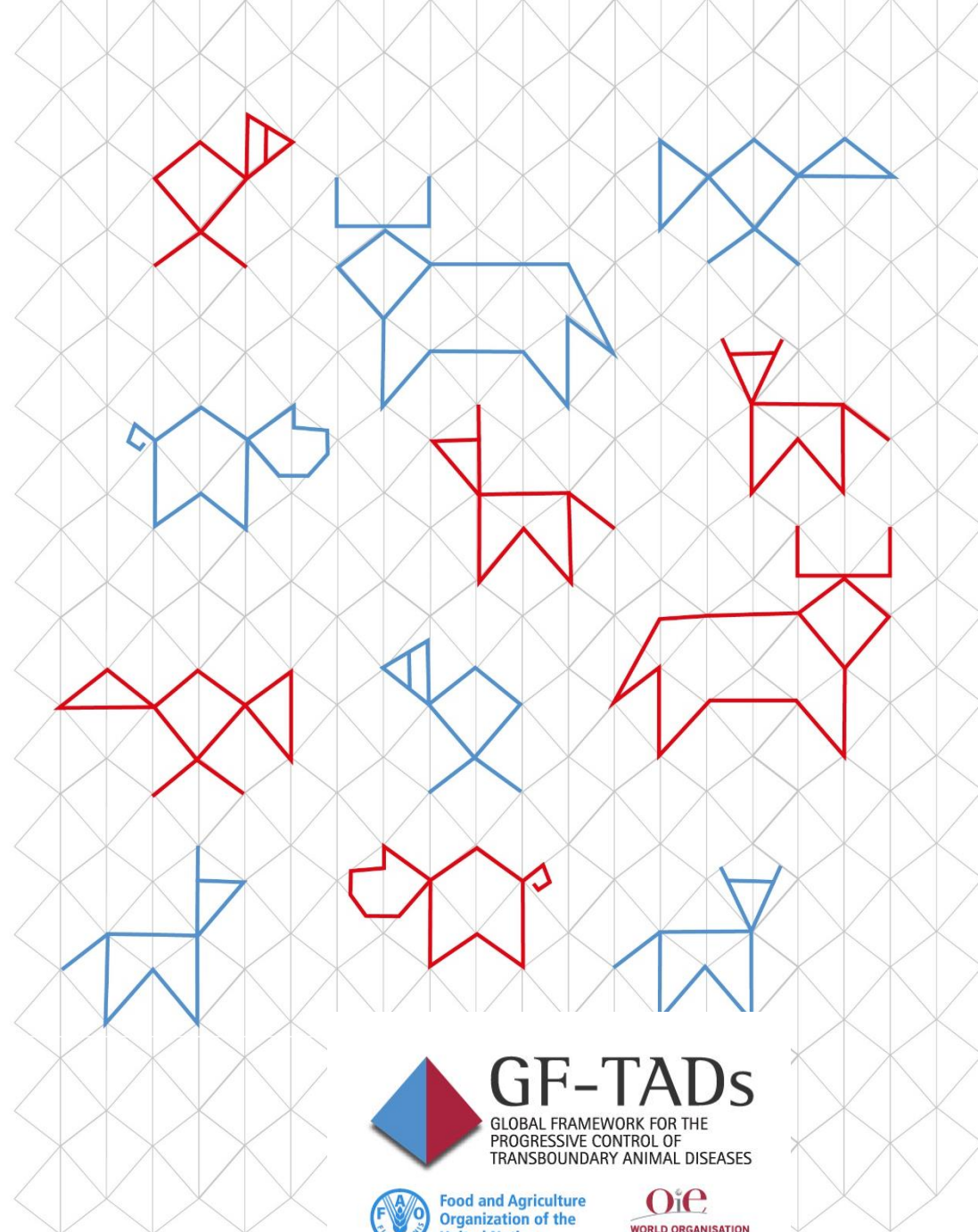

PCP-FMD Support Officer terms of reference

Background:

The Progressive Control Pathway for Foot-and-Mouth Disease (PCP-FMD) has been developed by the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and the European Commission for the Control of foot-and-mouth disease (EuFMD), and finalized together with the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE). In using the PCP-FMD, FMD endemic countries better manage to progressively increase their level of FMD control to reduce the impact of the disease. If successful, countries can aim at applying for OIE endorsement of an FMD Official Control Programme (in an advanced phase of PCP-FMD Stage 3) or for a sustainable official freedom recognition of FMD with or without vaccination. The PCP-FMD working tool forms the backbone of Component 1 of the FAO-OIE Global FMD Control Strategy "Improving global FMD control". The PCP-FMD tool is not only useful for guiding and structuring the policy and activities of a country regarding FMD control, but also for self-assessment, i.e. to assess where countries stand in terms of FMD control and evaluate the progress achieved.

The GF-TADs FMD Working Group (WG) has established the PCP-FMD Support Officer (PSO) system, to provide tailored support countries' Veterinary Authorities in developing and monitoring the impact of FMD control strategies. Initially aimed at countries assessed in PCP-FMD provisional stages, the scope of the PSO system is expanding to support countries requesting tailored individual support or positively responding to an offer of support from the GF-TADs FMD WG. The PSOs will assist the assigned country(ies) to advance in PCP-FMD stages 1, 2 and 3.

More specifically, a PSO will:

- Establish a regular and consistent dialogue and communication with the Veterinary Authorities of the assigned country(ies), including the FMD designated points of contact (and organize physical regular meetings or perform country missions according to specific needs, if deemed necessary and funds are available) to:
 - o provide tailored guidance to support and guide the Veterinary Authority to complete the PCP-FMD Stage and/or to develop and improve a Plan to progress along the PCP-FMD and during the acceptance process.
 - o ensure that the relevant Plan is technically and formally consistent with the latest guidelines and templates provided by the GF-TADs FMD WG and
 - o ensure that the feasibility of the Plan implementation is also clearly described including the resources mobilization and allocation processes
- Assist the assigned country(ies) in assessing its progress within the PCP-FMD through the interpretation of the PCP-FMD Self-Assessment Tool (SAT) and FAO and OIE evaluation tools outputs;
- Act as liaison between the assigned country(ies), the PSO network, the EuFMD team and the GF-TADs FMD WG;
- Assist the assigned country(ies) in identifying the training needs, accessing relevant training material or liaising with relevant experts, the EuFMD team and the GF-TADs FMD WG;
- Report his/her activities and the country's progress along the PCP-FMD to the PSO network. PSO is expected to work from his/her duty station; it is the PSO responsibility to make him/herself available for regular online meetings;
- Undertake the necessary training courses within the training development framework, keep oneself updated on the latest versions of PCP-FMD strategic documents and PCP-FMD related tools, and suggest improvements if needed;
- Advocate for the regional uptake of principles of the PCP-FMD and the PSO system when participating in FMD Regional Roadmaps meetings, PCP-FMD related training course, webinars, workshop and missions upon request.

Following PSO's commitment and performance, the GF-TADs FMD WG may assign additional countries to a PSO or may involve the PSO as an independent reviewer of PCP-FMD strategic documents (as part of the PCP-FMD Review Support Team).

Основные задачи для одного PSO:

- Установление контакта с назначенной страной и **поощрение диалога** об их политике борьбы с ящуром,
- **Обзор** RAP/RBSP/ОСР,
- Участие в онлайн-встречах **сети PSO**,
- **Группа поддержки по обзору ППБ**

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Сотрудник по поддержке ППБ (PSO) – Круг ведения (продолжение)

Требуется :

- Степень в области ветеринарии
- > 3 года практического опыта в надзоре за ТБЖ (в идеале ящуром), планировании стратегии борьбы, мониторинге и оценке ветеринарной службы на центральном уровне, в региональных сетях или в международных организациях
- Отличные коммуникативные навыки, говорение, чтение и письмо на **английском, русском, французском** или **арабском языках**.

Приветствуется :

- Степень магистра по ветеринарной эпидемиологии, лабораторной диагностике, социально-экономической политике и политике здравоохранения.
- Иметь уже налаженную сеть контактов в назначенной стране или быть в состоянии установить ее в короткие сроки
- Иметь опыт работы с принципами ППБЯ по борьбе с ящуром и работать с национальными ветеринарными службами.
- Иметь хорошую координацию и/или навыки управления командой, высокую работоспособность и навыки дипломатии.
- Опыт профилактики и борьбы с ТБЖ на региональном и международном уровнях

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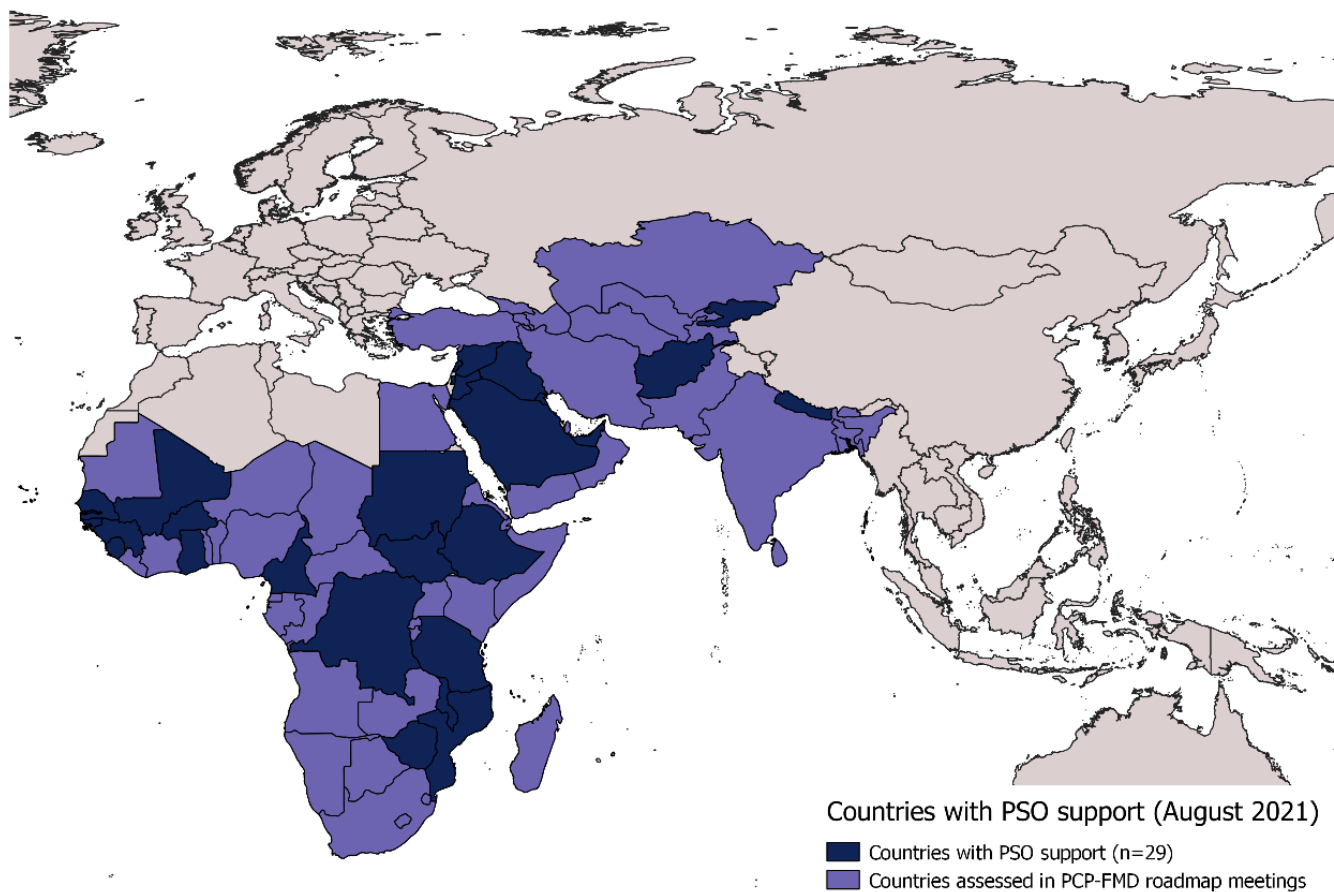
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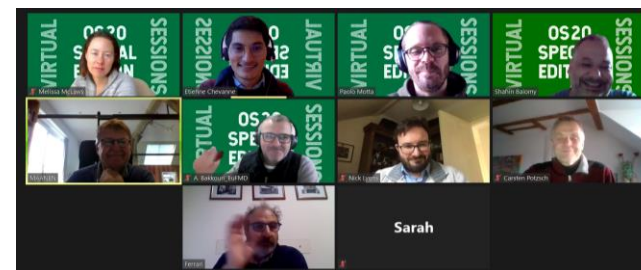
Глобальная сеть PSO



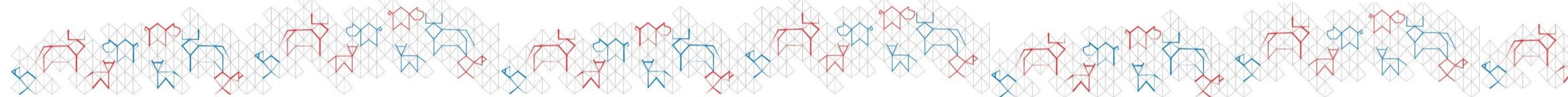
**Note: Countries engaged in the SEACFMD campaign are not colored on this map*

- 18 из 31 стран, находящихся на промежуточном этапе, был назначен PSO



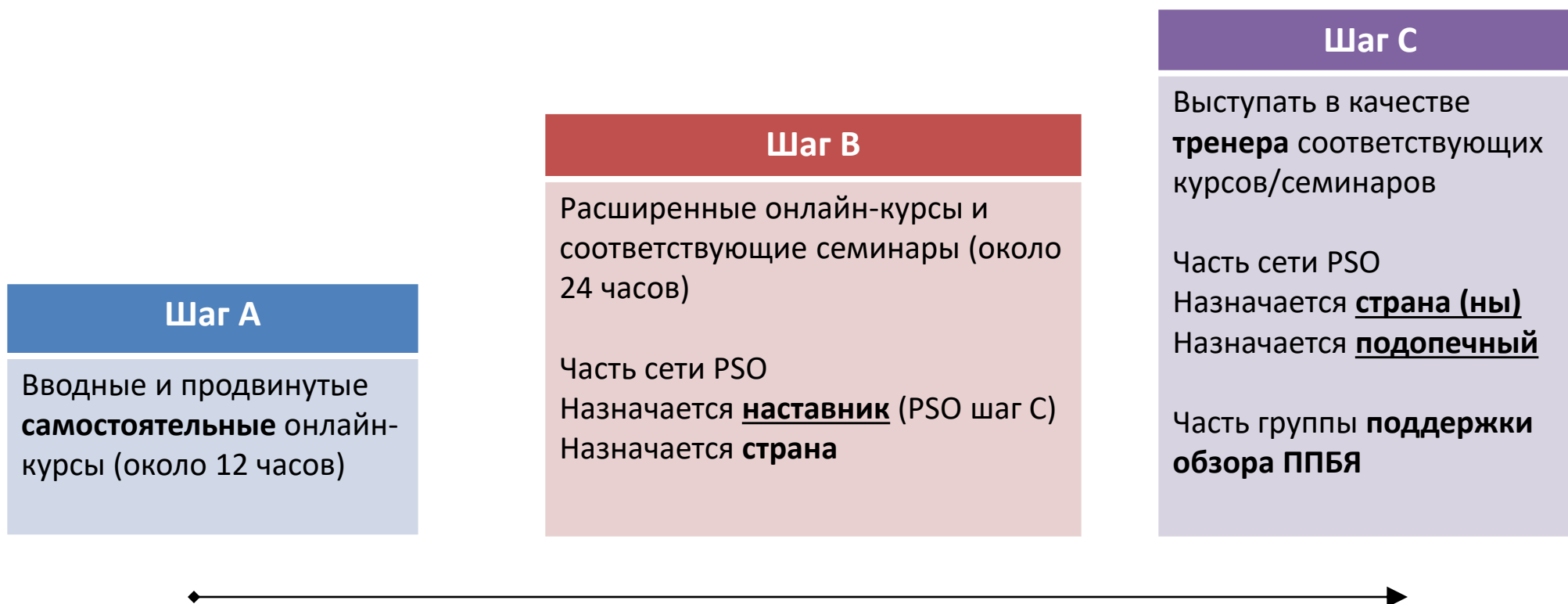
Как стать PSO

- через семинары PSO, организованные совместно региональными офисами ФАО/МЭБ и EuFMD

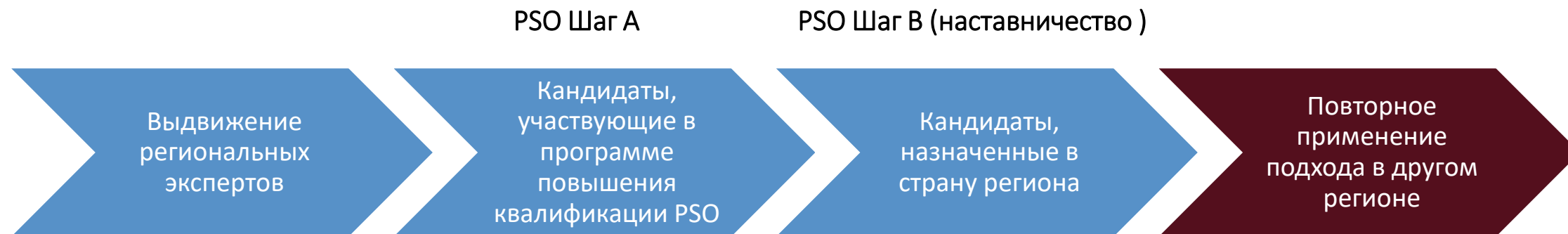
Как стать PSO (продолжение)

Схема развития обучения PSO описывает 3 этапа, на которых кандидаты PSO выполняют различные задачи для развития своих знаний и опыта в применении ППБЯ:



Как стать PSO (продолжение)

ФАО и МЭБ пригласят экспертов из референтных лабораторий для включения в пул PSO, пилотируемый в регионе САДК.



Обзор системы PSO через 3 года внедрения

В начале (2017/18):

- Для перехода от промежуточного этапа к полному этапу ППБЯ (в основном на этапе 2)
- PSO были в основном европейскими консультантами EuFMD, работавшие над разработкой и/или реализацией плана/программы ППБЯ,
- Система продвигается Рабочей группой по ящуру GF-TADs и EuFMD

С 2019:

- **Национальные сотрудники ФАО ECTAD** из Западной и Центральной Африки выдвинуты в качестве кандидатов в PSO в регионе и участвуют в учебной программе
- Референтные центры и лаборатории ФАО/МЭБ по ящуру как **потенциальные источники** для PSO (отрабатывается в регионе САДК)

Заседание в рамках ДК по ящуру в Ширазе (2019)

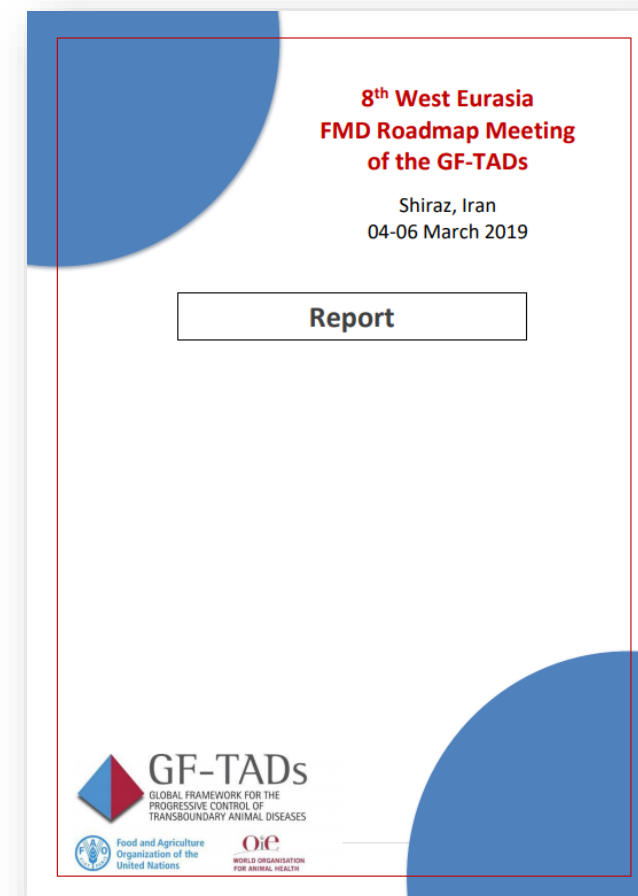
- Система PSO для оказания конкретной поддержки странам, находящимся на этапе 1 ППБЯ, в разработке их стратегического плана, основанного на оценке рисков (RBSP), для достижения как минимум этапа 2 к 2022 году;
- Рекомендации для **Таджикистана**, **Туркменистана** и **Узбекистана**: *«Работа над разработкой RBSP при поддержке PSO».*

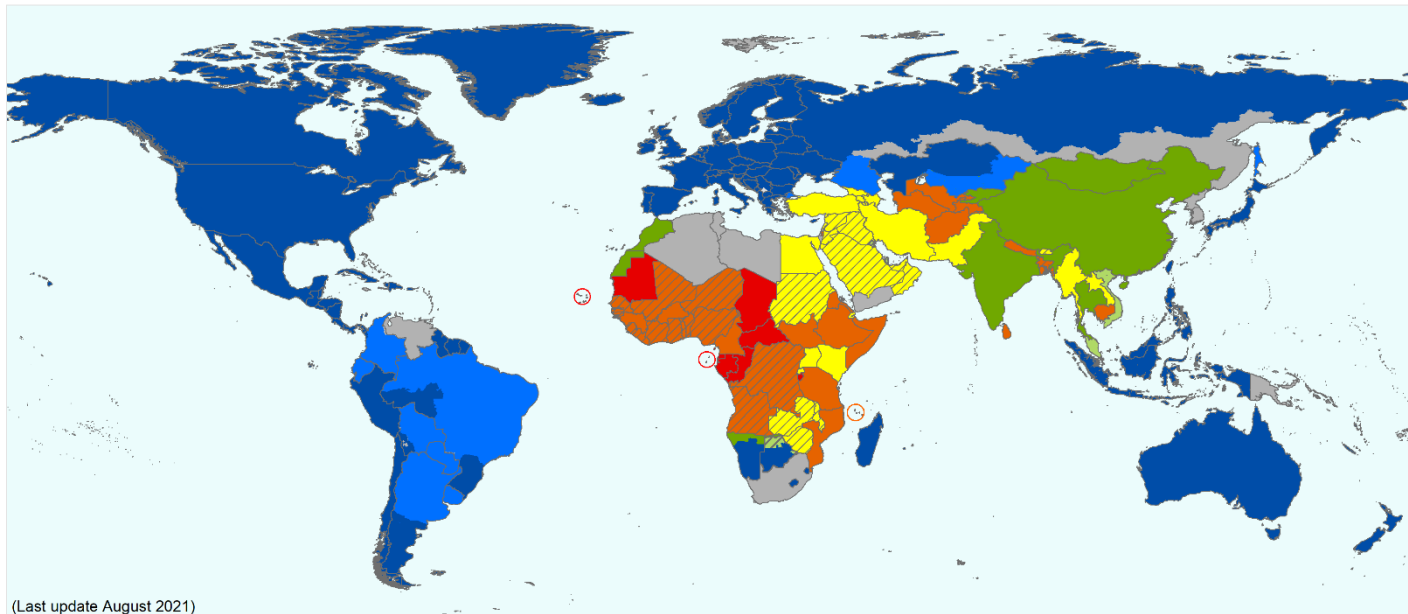
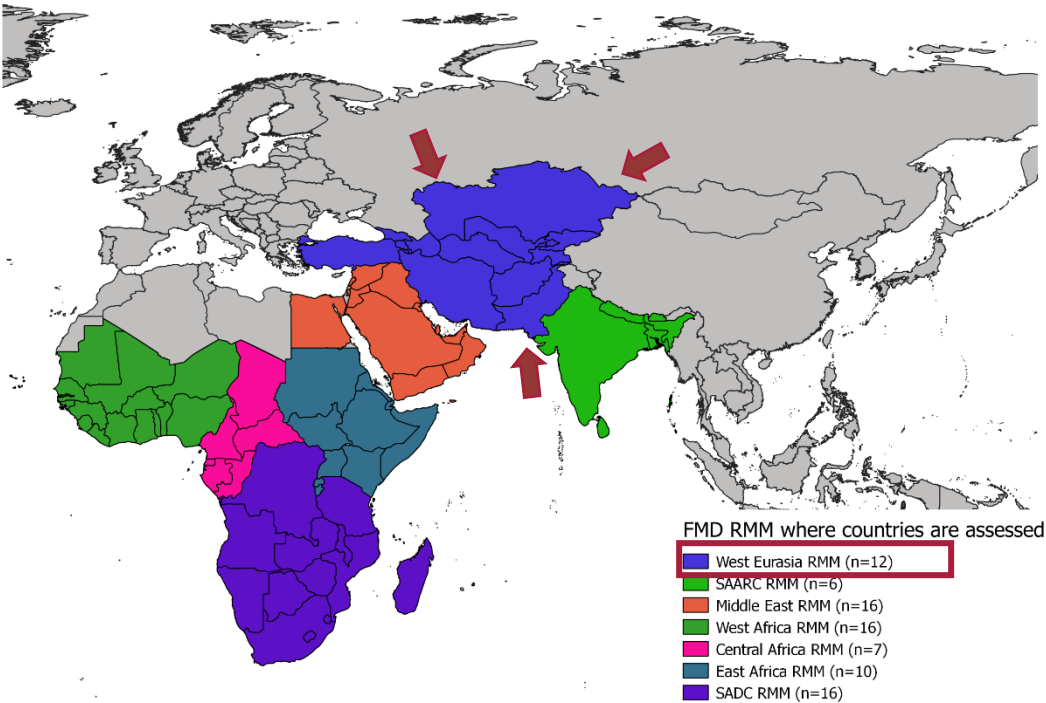

- **Структура системы PSO**


Более активное участие национальных координаторов (= первичных PSO) при поддержке старших PSO Таким образом, старшие PSO могут поддерживать несколько стран

Виртуальные и очные встречи для обзора и планирования мероприятий



PSO - перспектива (продолжение)

- **Приступить к реализации национальной поддержки**
Практическое руководство для национального координатора о том, как начать разработку или обновление национального плана/программы, в т.ч. создание многопрофильной группы национальных экспертов и определение источников финансирования
- **Официальное представление PSO национальным органам власти и координаторам по ящуре**
Уточните роли, рассмотрите режимы работы и установите ожидания

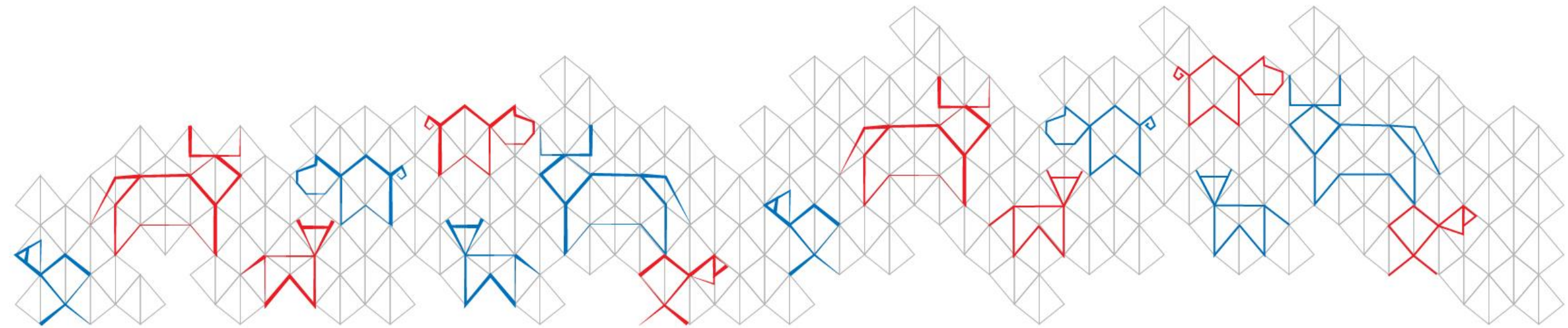
