Lumpy Skin Disease - Background information

- LSD occurrence : Never
- LSD Vaccination: 2016 2017; two vaccination campaigns
- LSD surveillance (active): Implemented in period 2018 2021



Lumpy Skin Disease – 2021 - Surveillance

- Description of the active surveillance undertaken
 - √ 482 randomly selected bovine animals out of 359 herds serologically tested by ELISA test
 - ✓ surveillance was conducted in period Sept-Dec 2021
 - ✓ whole country covered
 - ✓ 4 animals revealed positive ELISA result (0.83%), all animals clinically examined and retested by QPCR with negative result



Lumpy Skin Disease – 2021 - Surveillance

- Official investigation conducted
 - ✓ One animal was sampled without checking the vaccination status
 - ✓ Two animals were VNT negative
 - ✓ Only one animal was tested ELISA and VNT positive (born in May 2020, delivered to the farm in June 2021, originating from Slovakia)
 - ✓ LSD virus circulation excluded



Lumpy Skin Disease – 2021 - Surveillance

- Immunity study
 - ✓ bovine animals tested seropositive in previous years
 - √ 76 animals tested
 - 44 animals still seropositive (last vaccination in 2017)
- Description of the passive surveillance undertaken
 - ✓ No suspicion in 2021



Lumpy Skin Disease – 2022 plans

• LSD Vaccination: Not Applicable

- LSD surveillance (active): Not applicable
 - Only passive surveillance in 2022
 - Further activities focused on raising awareness on LSD
