Wild boar found dead

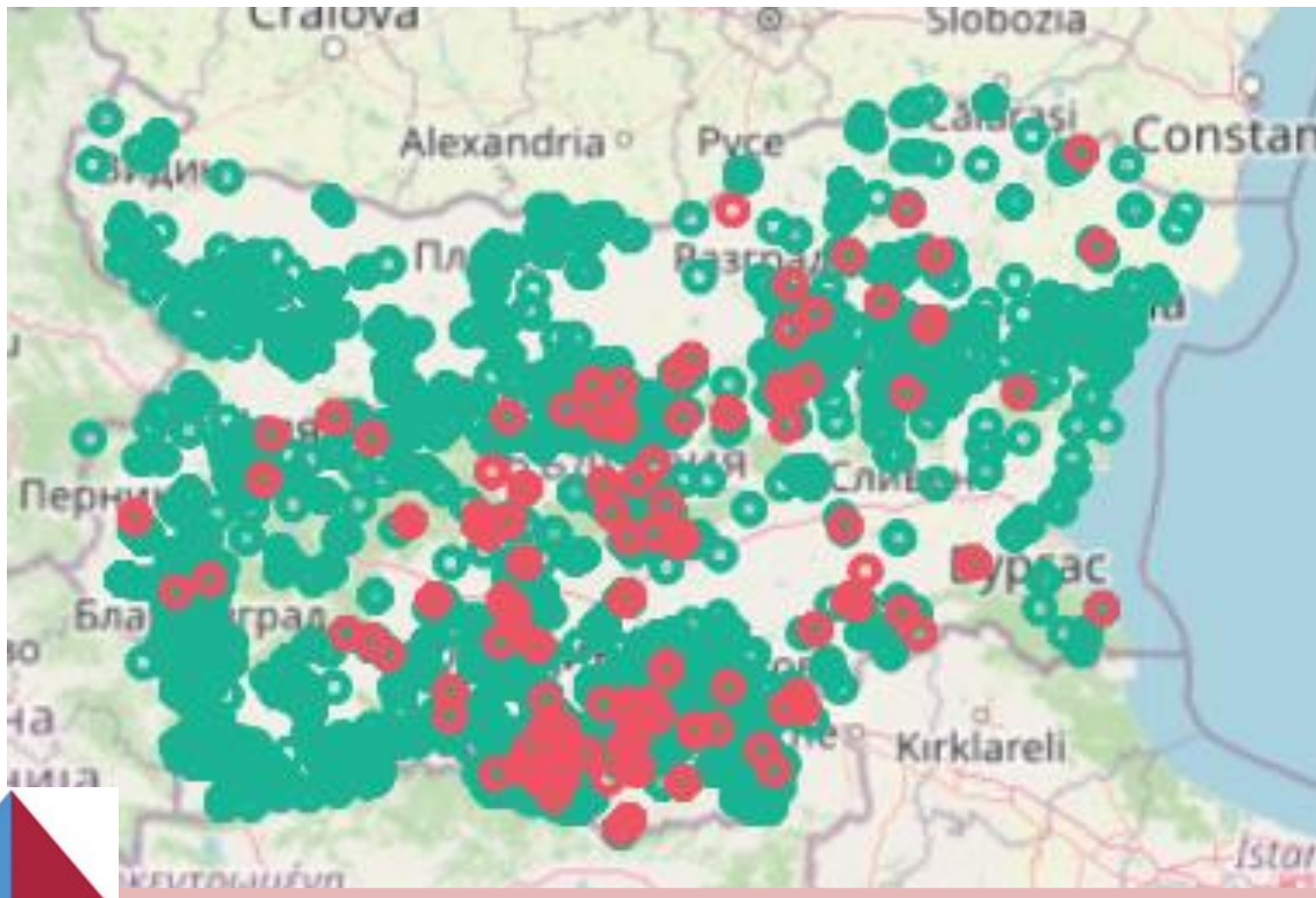

Bulgaria	11364	262 (2,31%)	337 (2,97%)

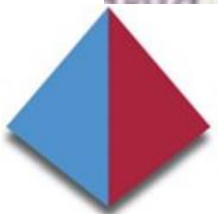
Cases in wild boar – country map

In the zones of the country already considered affected at the beginning of the period

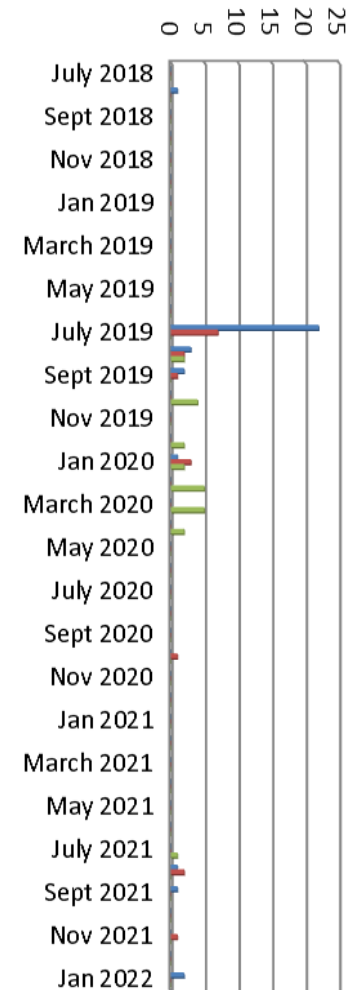
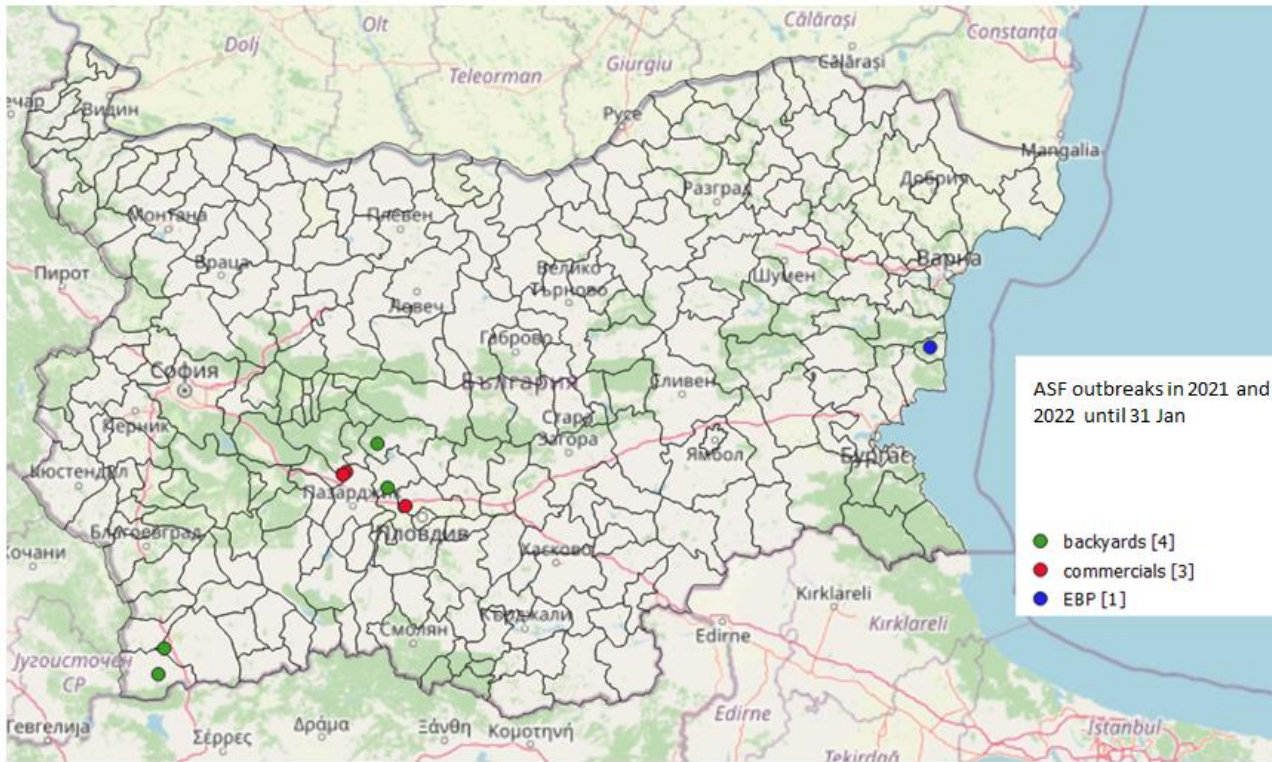
