The <u>first</u> self-declaration of freedom from Avian Influenza

- > The draft self-declaration
 - Format and content based on Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).
 - DVFA began the work on the self-declaration in beginning of September 2018.
 - Draft send to <u>self-declaration@oie.int</u> on 14 September 2018 (two weeks before) for comments on content and prior approval.
- > OIE screening revealed that some information was required either for clarification or suggestions made for editorial. This was send to DVFA on 24 September 2018
- > The official self-declaration was sent to OIE on 27 September 2018.
- > The self-declaration was published on the website on 2 October 2018.

Estimated time taken for preparing the first self-declaration: Approximately 2-4 weeks

Subsequent self-declarations of freedom from Avian Influenza

- Update the previous self-declaration
- > Draft sometimes send to OIE approximately two weeks before for prior approval (18 September 2019, 15 April 2020, etc.).
- > The official self-declaration was sent to OIE on relevant dates (17 June 2019, 1 October 2019, 4 May 2020, etc.).
- > The self-declaration was published on the website few days later (21 June 2019, 2 October 2019, 4 May 2020, etc.).

Estimated time taken for preparing subsequent self-declarations: Approximately 2-4 days



Purpose and main benefits of the publication of a self-declaration: TRADE!

"If we can open one important marked one week earlier, then it is worth the effort to make the self-declaration"

The Danish experience: It is worth the effort!

The Danish poultry industry support the publications and are often impatient if not published the date the free-status is regaining according to the Terrestrial Code.



Challenges with the publication of a self-declaration

- 1. Export marked lack of acceptance
 - Could the Observatory evaluate how big the lack of acceptance is?
- 2. Delayed publication time is money!
 - Could the time for review of the <u>subsequent</u> self-declarations be reduced? (at present it formally is 2 weeks according to B-3 of the SOP)
