

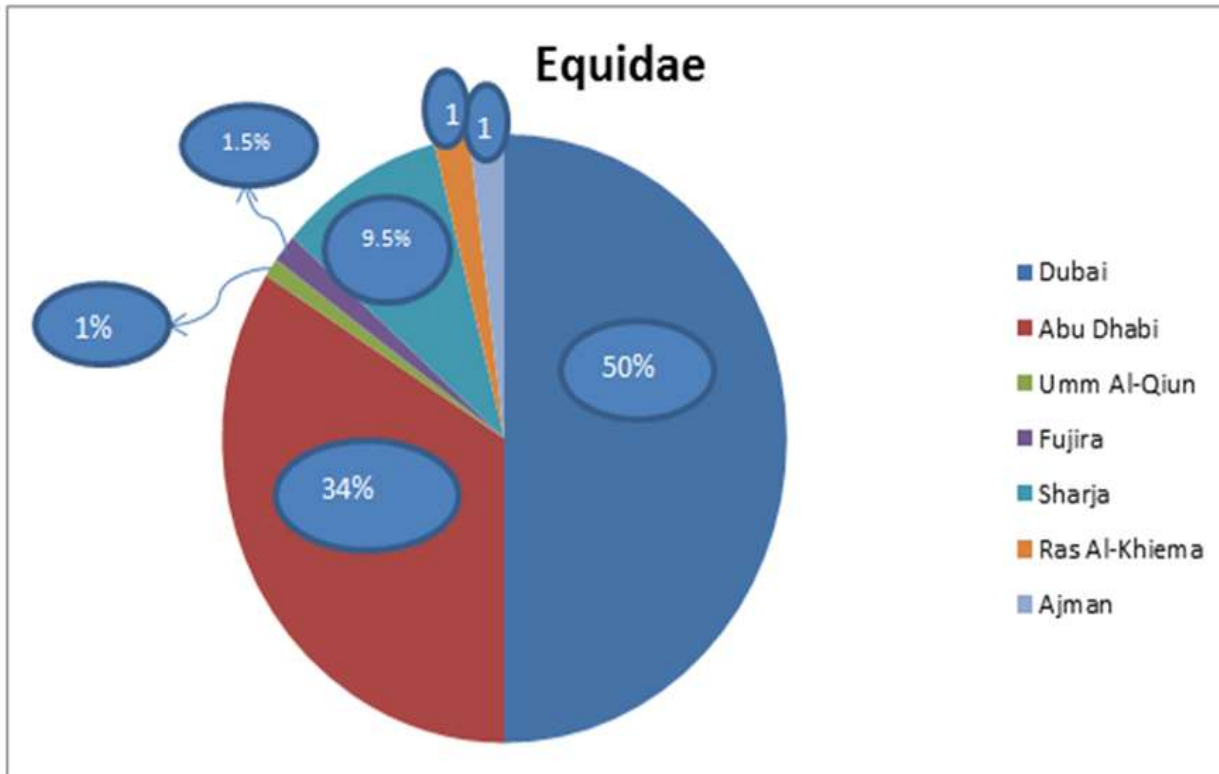

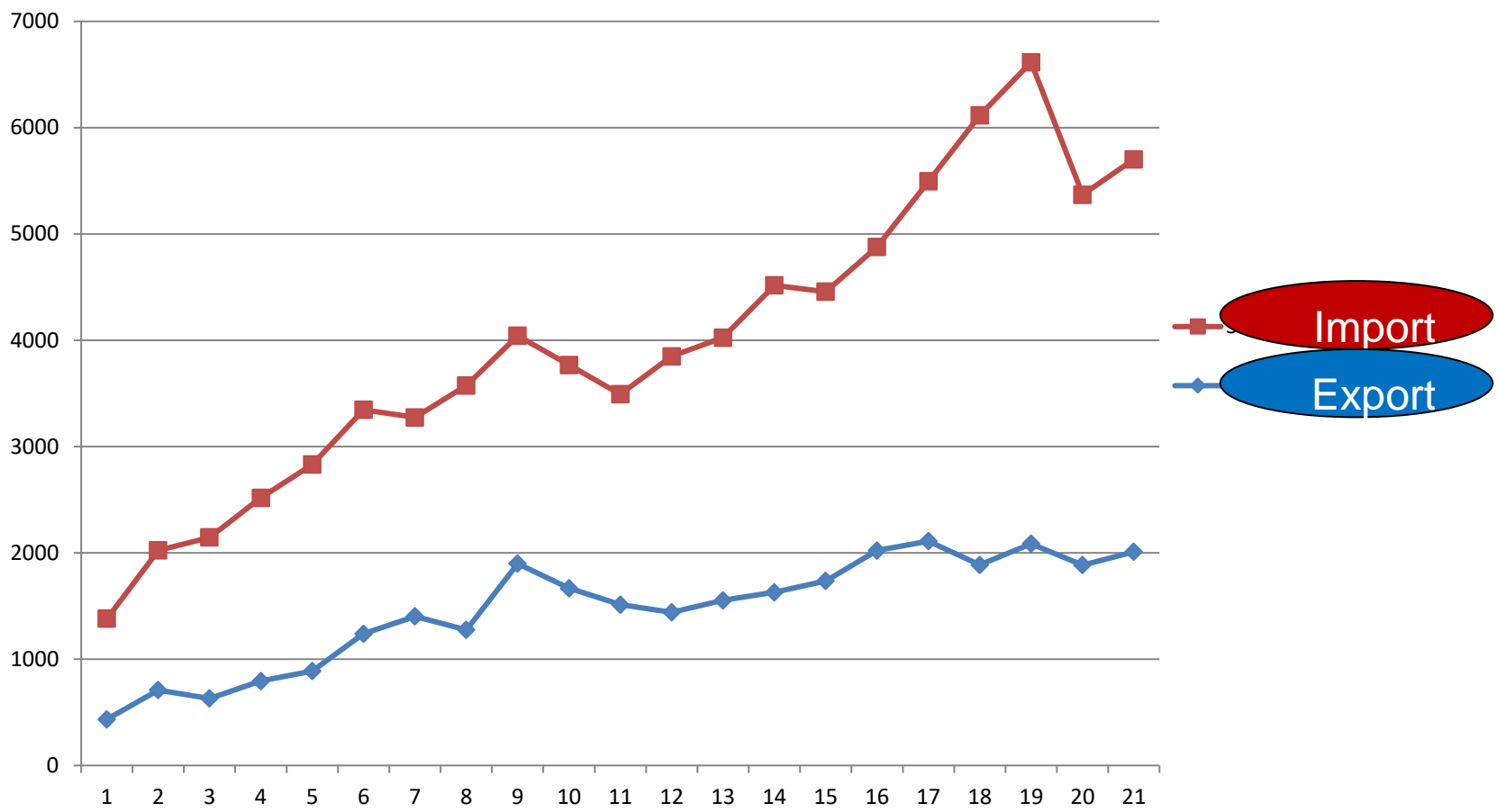

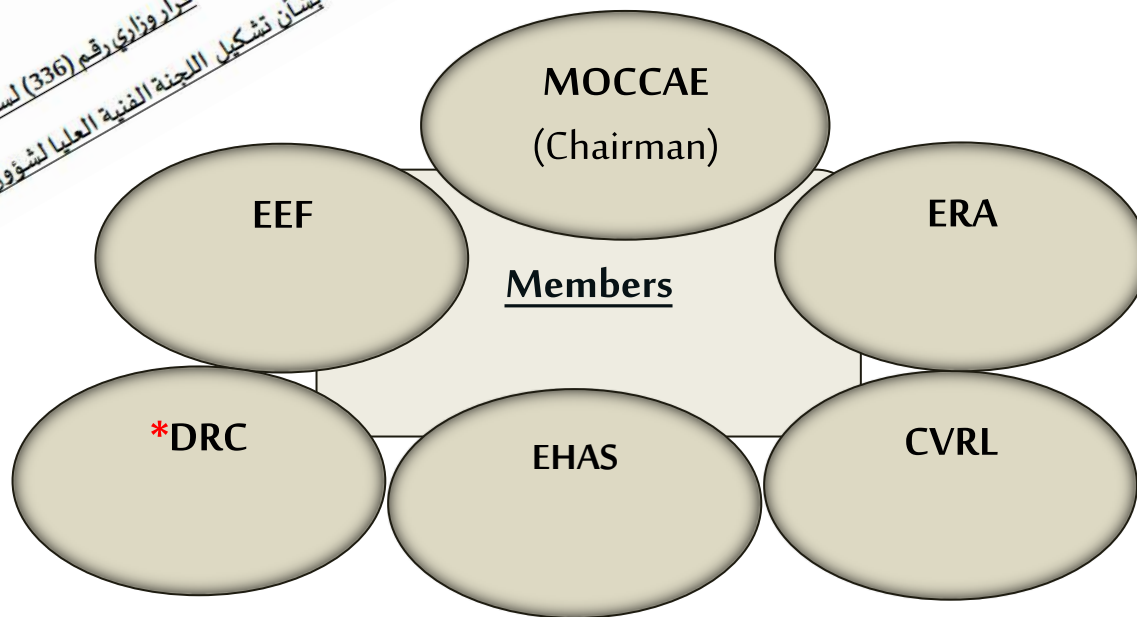

Tasks of the Committee

- Develop and review policies and initiatives related to the equine file
- Follow-up and review of issues related to the equine family, including import and export procedures and requirements
- Supervising the implementation of development initiatives and projects related to the equine family file

Notifiable Equine diseases

Biosecurity measures applied in case of an equine disease outbreak

- Notification
- Reporting
- Epidemiological survey
- Movement restrictions
- Disinfection
- Treatment
- Culling

Surveillance for specific equine diseases

- Large proportion of Horses moved in and out of country regularly and be tested for EIA, AHS, Glanders, Dourine and EVA.
- In accordance to the federal law, any suspicion of notifiable diseases should be notified to the responsible authorities.

Temporary and Permanent import of horses?

PRE-EXPORT quarantine	POST-ARRIVAL quarantine
Residence : For Permanent : 30 days for EU / 90 days for the rest of the world For Temporary: 40 days	Quarantine : 10 days for Permanent importation
Quarantine : 30 days for permanent importation except for EU	Isolation : for Temporary importation (Maximum of 30 days except for Show jumping or The World Cup)
Testing	Testing
