# I. Understanding country situation

- Dog registration in a centralised database
- Agency for Animal Identification responsibility for the management of the dog registration system
  - Veterinarians organizations responsibility for the data entry
  - Animal welfare state legislative and two entity ones



## II. Control measures

- Veterinary inspection overviews shelters
- Veterinary inspection is obliged to react on animal welfare law breach
- On municipality levels CNVR funded measures, and marking (microchipping) and rabies vaccination
- Different animal welfare organisation provide fund for measure such as CNVR, marking, rabies vaccination and dehelminthisation



## III. Monitoring and evaluation

- Monitoring is done veterinary inspection on different government levels
- Monitoring on animal abroad adoption done by State office



## IV. Rabies dimension

- Bosnia and Herzegovina is rabies free
- Rabies vaccination is mandatory for dogs by state law
- Currently finished oral rabies vaccination for foxes as one of the state measures

Working on making legislative better

Have more veterinary inspectors for monitoring of law implementation

- We have seen free roaming dog population reduces
- More action from local governemant levels
