I. Understanding country situation

- Dog registration in a centralised database
- Agency for Animal Identification responsibility for the management of the dog registration system
 - Veterinarians organizations responsibility for the data entryy
 - Animal welfare state legislative and two entity ones



II. Control measures

- Vetrinary inspection overviews shelters
- Veterinary inspection is oblied to react on animal welfare law breach
- On municipality levels CNVR funded measures, and marking (michrochipping) and rabies vaccination
- Different animal welfare organisation provide fund for measure such as CNVR, marking, rabies vaccination and dehelminitisation



III. Monitoring and evaluation

- Monitoring is done veterinary inspection on different gouvernment levels
- Monitoring on animal abroad adoption done by State office



IV. Rabies dimension

- Bosnia and Herzegovina is rabies free
- Rabbies vaccination is mandatory for dogs by state law
- Currently finished oral rabies vaccination for foxex as one of the state measures



V. Country roadmap Key Actions

Working on making legislative better
Have more veterinary inspectors for monitoring of law implementation
