- Animal welfare in disaster management contingency planning is a new topic for most of us

- How to address this new topic led to a lot of discussions on the different components:
 - Technical
 - Legislation and administrative
 - Communication...



Positive points

- Interest for the topic and active participation of the delegations
- A lot of experience already with past events
- There is solid knowledge in Veterinary services competent authorities **and private veterinarians** on contingency planning
- Veterinary services are responsive in case of emergency situations, including natural disasters
- plans already exist in animal health sector.
- OIE guidelines are out there and can help



- Topics where further reflection appears to be needed
 - Articulation / coordination with Civil Protection in order to better define the role of veterinary services
 - Role and place in the system of private veterinarians and paraprofessionals, farmers, business operators and other stakeholders including NGOs
 - Specific education, training, simulation exercises
 - Communication
 - Possible mutual assistance agreements within country and with neighbouring countries
