# The IZSAM role as OIE Collaboration Centre

- To **provide services to the OIE**, in particular within the region, in the designated specialty, in support of the implementation of OIE policies and, where required, seek for collaboration with OIE Reference Laboratories
- To propose or develop methods and procedures that facilitate harmonisation of international standards and guidelines applicable to the designated specialty;
- To carry out and/or coordinate scientific and technical studies in collaboration with other centres, laboratories or organisations
- To collect, process, analyse, publish and disseminate data and information relevant to the designated specialty;
- To provide, within the designated specialty, scientific and technical training to personnel from OIE Member Countries;
- To organise and participate in scientific meetings and other activities on behalf of the OLE
- To identify and maintain existing expertise, in particular within its region
- To <u>establish and maintain a network with other OIE CC</u> designated for the same specialty, and should the need arise, with Collaborating Centres in other disciplines
- To place expert consultants at the disposal of the OIE

## The global network of OIE Collaborating Centres

- The First International Conference of OIE Reference Laboratories and Collaborating Centres (2006) recommended to develop a network with the objective of harmonising and exchanging data, information and reference material to improve disease surveillance and control worldwide
- The Second Global Conference of OIE Reference Laboratories and Collaborating Centres (2010) encouraged the networks of OIE Reference Laboratories and Collaborating Centres to continue working together to strengthen multilateral cooperation
- Networking will improve the credibility and increase the visibility of OIE CC worldwide, and it will attract the participation of other centres of excellence
