- We have problem with stray dog in territory of Kosovo, number of stray dog from 2014 are going down. Some municipality have project for sterilisation and vaccination of stray dog.

II. Control measures



- What progress have been achieved since June 2014 to control stray dogs?
- DRAFT REGULATION (GRK) No. XX/2015 FOR ANIMAL SHELTER
- (This regulation defines technical conditions to be met for shelters, animal welfare conditions in shelters, procedures of euthanasia, record keeping methods, monitoring methods form and content of the record as well as registering method for information required for registration.)
- We draft regulation for identification and registration of dogs
- This two draft can we implement after come in force new veterinary law.
- We meet the responsibility persons in municipality and we discus about OIE campaign .
- What are the remaining challenges to control stray dogs?
 - Identification and registration
 - Shelter dogs
 - legislation
- What are the proposed next steps to control stray dogs? (and the management of dog population in general)
 - To improve the control program
 - Assistance for stray dog, castration and sterilisation
 - Training of private veterinarian
