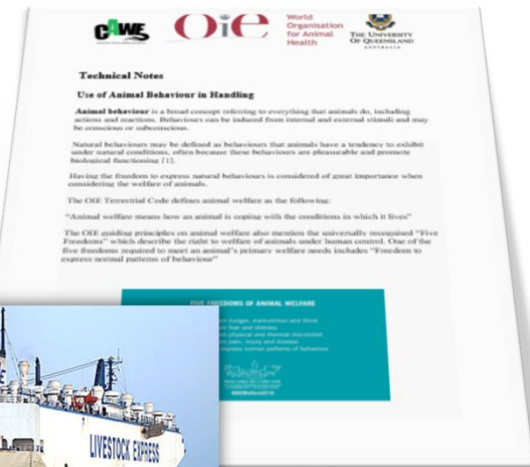

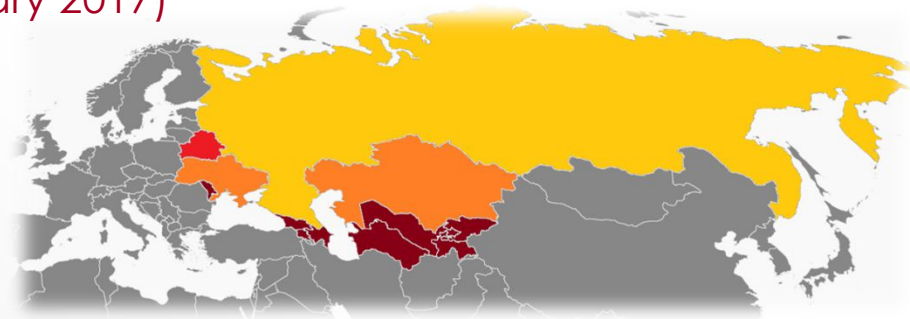

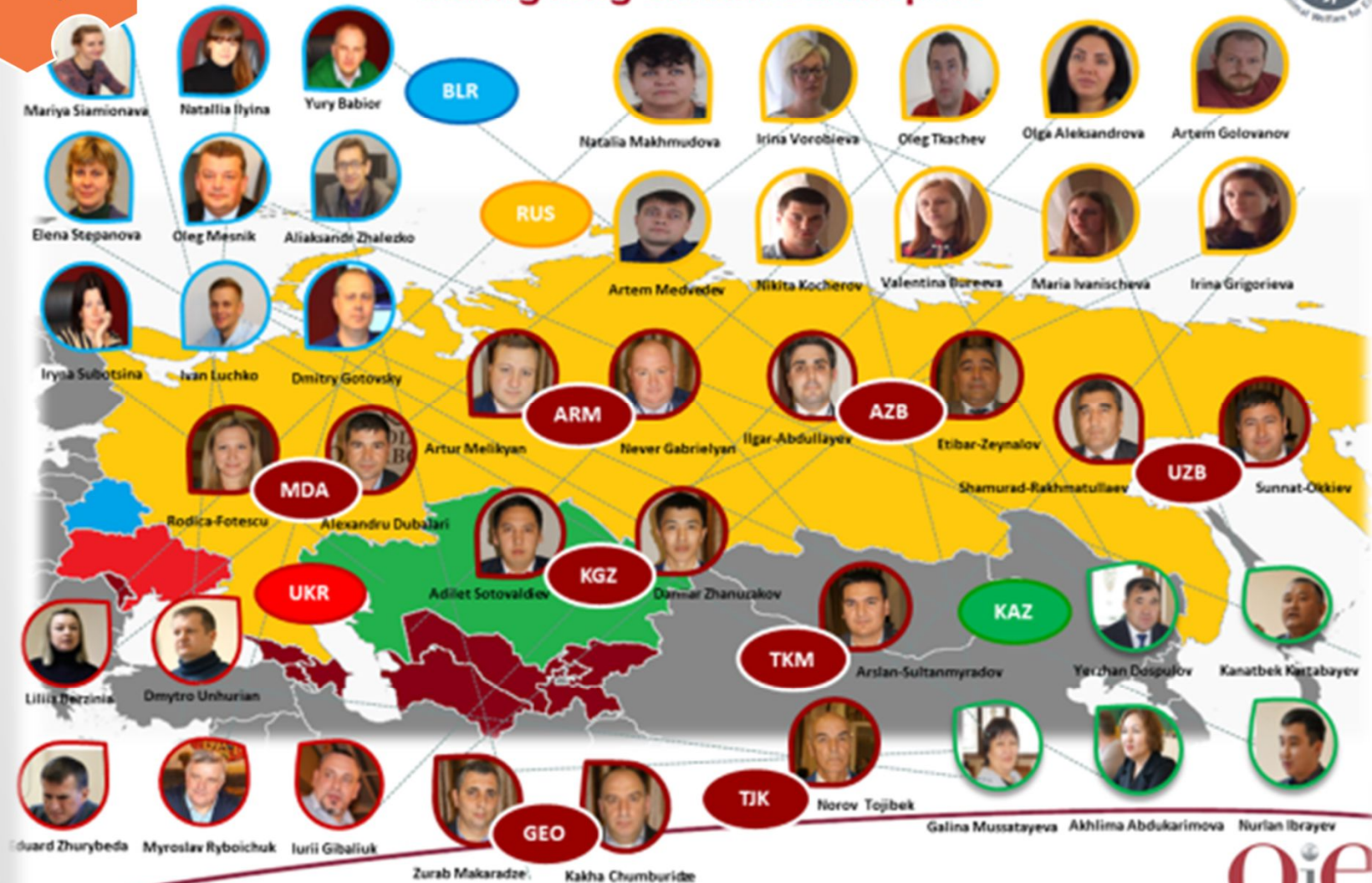

OIE 'Whole Journey Scenario' Workshops

- **Objective**

to help countries improve animal welfare during long distance and cross-border transport in compliance with OIE standards for the whole duration of the journey along the specific route

- **Focus**

on the responsibilities of the Competent Authorities regarding animal welfare over the entire journey

- **Opportunity**

to share best practices and strengthen collaboration between Competent Authorities, and other authorities (e.g. Customs Services)



Transport of animals

OIE 'Whole Journey Scenario' Workshops

Specific objectives:

- remind the provisions of the OIE Chapters 7.2 and 7.3 and national regulations, with a focus on the responsibilities of the Competent Authorities
- identify the key weaknesses/constraints/challenges in the implementation of those responsibilities
- encourage the development of procedures for routine and emergency scenarios among Competent Authorities in targeted OIE Member Countries
- identify communication channels
- share best practices which will ensure implantation OIE animal welfare standards during transport

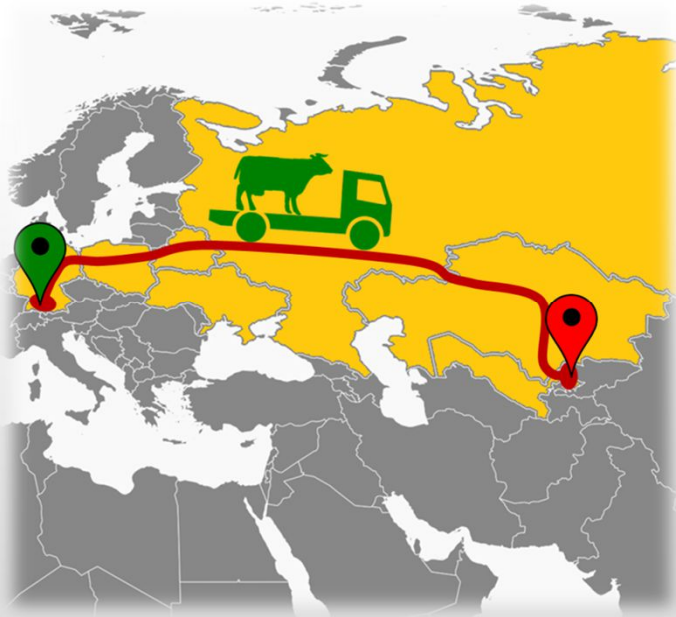
- OIE National **Focal Point for Animal Welfare / OIE trained transport expert** working at central level

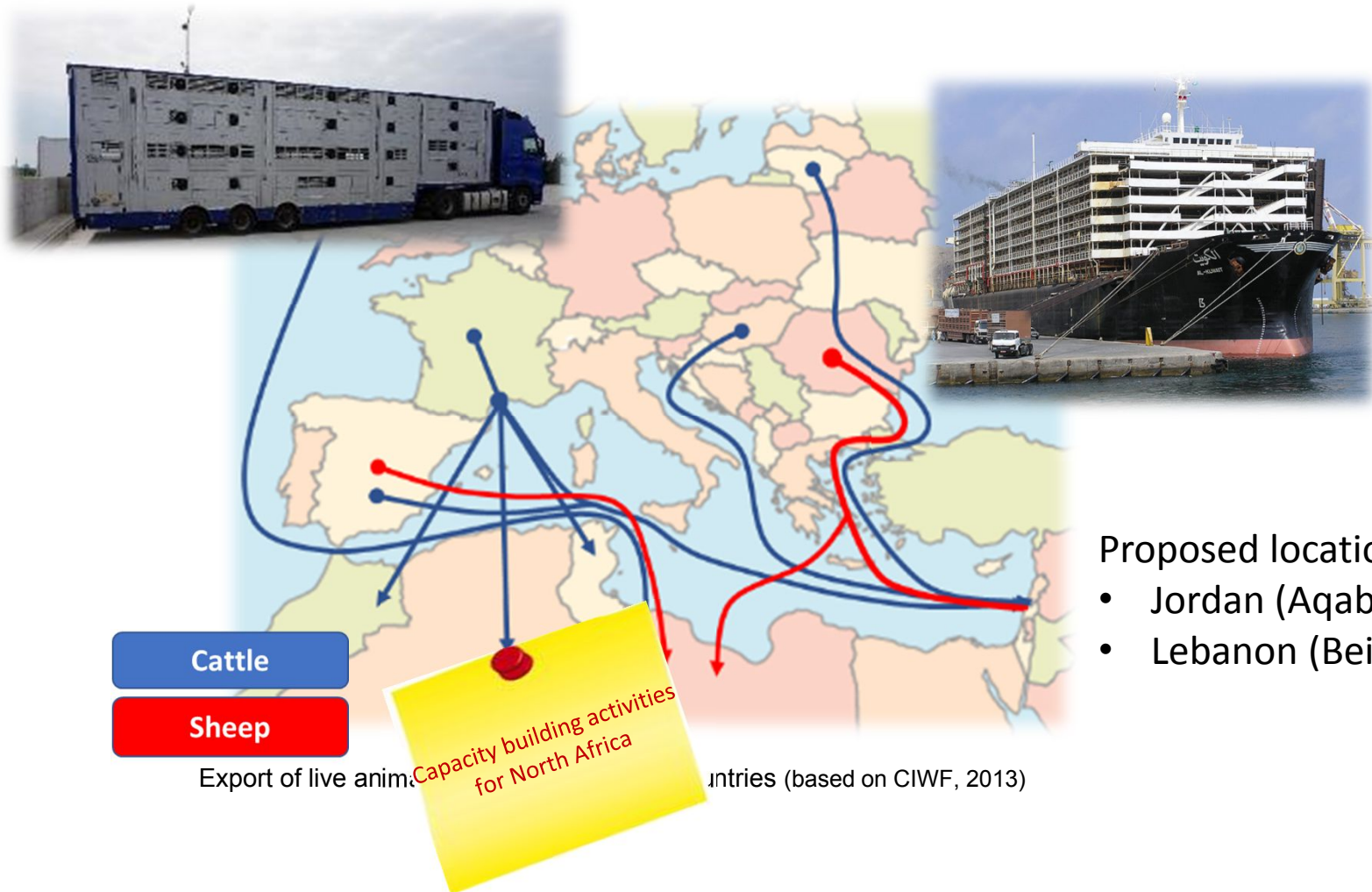
