



10th Regional Steering Committee for Europe

- First face to face meeting in four years
- Presentation of Global strategy of GF-TADs
- Progress in the region between Nov 2020 Oct 2022
- Updated list of priority diseases for Europe (FMD, ASF, PPR, LSD, rabies and avian influenza)
- Endorsement of **new Action plan for Europe** (2023-2027)
- New composition of RSC (Delegate of Uzbekistan joined)
- Followed by initiative of Permanent Regional Secretariat to improve overall management, coordination and introduction of SOP's

Rabies: 5th meeting of the Standing Groups of Experts on Rabies for Europe

- Rabies eradication is a priority for Europe
- More than 10 years programme on ORV in the Western Balkans (EU funding)
- To maintain vaccination efforts and ensure sustainable funding of future ORV
- To emphasize importance of **passive surveillance programmes** to have a clear view of the epidemiological situation and take informed decision on vaccination
- Effects of the war in Ukraine: displaced kept (pets) and wild animals could lead to dispersal of rabies across the region
- Liaison with One Health Regional Mechanism in Europe and among national authorities
- Cross border and Regional coordination is particularly important and this is our mandate






