

Country report on the situation in the country from 2018 to 2022

## I. Understanding the situation in the country

- Pogolovya sobak:-223 100 goals.
- In 2022, 65 cases of rabies among animals were registered (from 107 pat. materials);
- From 2010 to 2022. Out of 1969 pathological materials submitted to the National Center for the diagnosis of food security, 895 cases were suspected and confirmed . From them:
  - 603 cases of dogs;
  - 221 cases of large cattle;
  - 71 cases and other types of animals.
- From 2012 to 2022. 111 cases of human diseases with lethal outcome were recorded . From them:
  - 65 cases among children up to 14 years old;



## II. Mayor of the fight

- Prophylactic vaccination of dogs against rabies (for 2022, 37,716 dogs in the republic)
- For every case of rabies disease, veterinary specialists are guided by the "Instructions on measures to combat rabies";
- Animals suspected of rabies are immediately isolated and kept under strict veterinary supervision for 10 days. If during this period they do not show signs of dementia, they are considered healthy. In the case of the appearance of clinical symptoms and the occurrence of death, the pat material is sent to the nearest Veterinary Diagnostic Center (now the National Food Safety Diagnostic Center). \* After confirming the diagnosis, forced vaccination is carried out in unfavorable places. In Russia, the most widely used anti-rabies vaccine is "TS-80". " Rabivac "
- And in the case of the appearance of clinical signs of rabies, there are no effective treatment methods.



#### III. Monitoring and evaluation

The veterinary service of the Food Safety Committee of the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan together with scientists and staff of the Tajik Academic Agricultural Sciences Institute developed "Guidelines for the diagnosis, prevention and control of rabies in farm animals". и оценка вспышки на основе рисков.

In the country, the strategy and road map for the fight against rabies has not been developed:


Within the framework of the cooperation of the CIS member states, the Comprehensive Action Plans for the fight against rabies for the period up to 2025 have been adopted, which include:

- Monitoring, assessment and analysis of disease status;

- Development of a plan of measures for public participation in the areas of disease control and prevention;
- > Improvement of legislative acts;
- Resource mobilization;
- Vaccination company in hot spots and danger zones;
- Conducting seminars and trainings for vet specialists and medical workers

Analyzing the data of cases of rabies, it is possible to conclude that the measures carried out to prevent the spread of the disease, monitoring and evaluation are considered successful and have a decreasing character.
