





# Outbreaks management data

- In total 20.801 pigs euthanised on 1.059 establishments
- 18.067 pigs euthanised on 876 positive establishments
- 2.734 pigs euthanised on 183 establishments due to low biosecurity conditions



## Control and additional measures in restricted zones

- Control measures according to Delegated Reg. (EU) 2020/687
- Veterinary visit and census of all pig establishments is ongoing
- All pigs found at unregistered establishments to be immediately killed and destroyed
- Control of establishments in relation to biosecurity and clinical examinations at all pig establishments is ongoing
- All pigs from establishments that do not comply with prescribed biosecurity measures are either sent to slaughter or preventively euthanised and destroyed
- Enhanced passive surveillance all dead pigs to be tested
- Enhanced biosecurity
- On all establishments with low biosecurity where killing or slaughtering was carried due to ASF suspicion/case or due to low biosecurity - ban on keeping pigs for at least 12 months



## Control and additional measures outside restricted zones

- Veterinary visit and census of all pig establishments is ongoing in high-risk Counties: Sisak Moslavina, Lika Senj, Karlovac, Osijek Baranja and Brod Posavina county
- All pigs found at unregistered establishments to be immediately killed and destroyed
- Control of establishments in relation to biosecurity
- All pigs from establishments that do not comply with prescribed biosecurity measures are either sent to slaughter or slaughtered for own consumption
- Mandatory passive surveillance testing of dead pigs and abortions
- Suspicion preliminary control measures according to Del. Reg. (EU) 2020/687
- Pigs can be kept only on biosecurity compliant establishments deadline foreseen for 30 November 2023



## Control measures related to wild boar population

Hunting grounds located in protection and infected zones

- Only authorized persons allowed to enter
- Enhanced biosecurity measures and mandatory disinfection of footwear, vehicles and equipment
- Active search for dead wild boars
- Prohibited processing of wild boar carcasses and cutting of wild boar meat in approved and registered facilities
- ASF testing of all hunted and found dead wild boar
- Shot and dead wild boars or their parts safely disposed of after sampling as category 1 material in a category 1 animal by-product processing facility (in exceptional cases, burial on-site in line with biosecurity protocol)

### Hunting grounds in surveillance zone and hunting grounds at risk

- ASF testing of all hunted and found dead wild boar
- Wild boar carcasses handled in accordance with the provisions of Article 52, Paragraph 2 of Del. Reg. (EU) 2023/594 after negative ASF test results



Additional measures related to wild boar population – whole country

- Intensive hunting to reduce wild boar population to 10% of parent fond
- Mandatory biosecurity protocols and designation of responsible person in each hunting ground
- Active search for dead wild boars
- Mandatory passive surveillance



# Challenges

- Resources- veterinary and other services
- Non compliance with prescribed measures
- High number of small pig establishments in high risk zones
- ASF situation outside Croatian border with non EU countries
