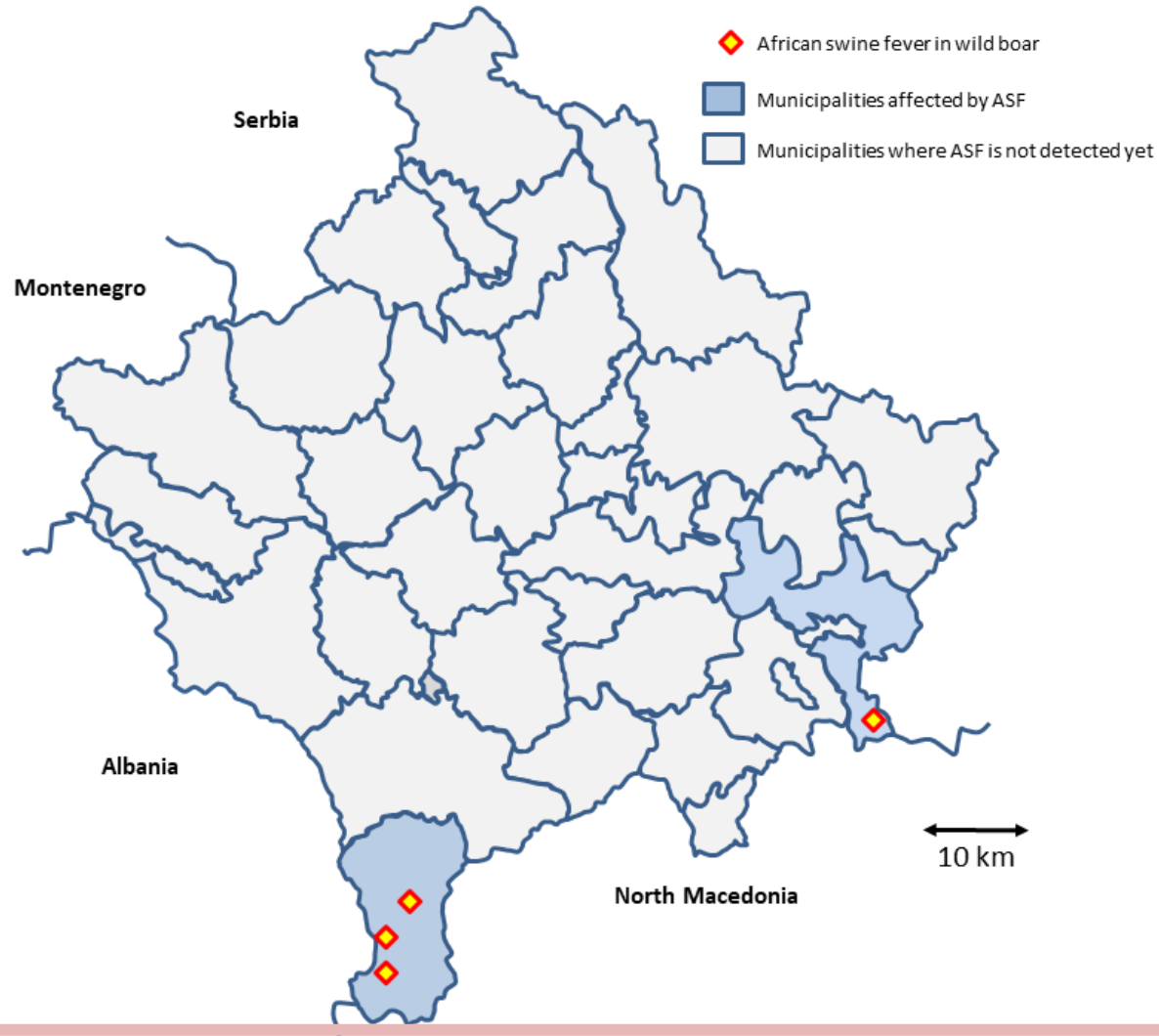

Carcass Detection and Disposal Technology

- ❑ National Information Campaign for ASF, coordinated with other relevant institutions such as Hunters and Forest Guard to report wild boar carcasses found in forestry.
- ❑ Positive domestic pigs are killed by two methods:
 - Standing with a captive bullet
 - Euthanasia method
- ❑ All domestic carcasses are buried in the predetermined places at the municipal level
- ❑ All wild boar carcasses are buried in the place where they are found
