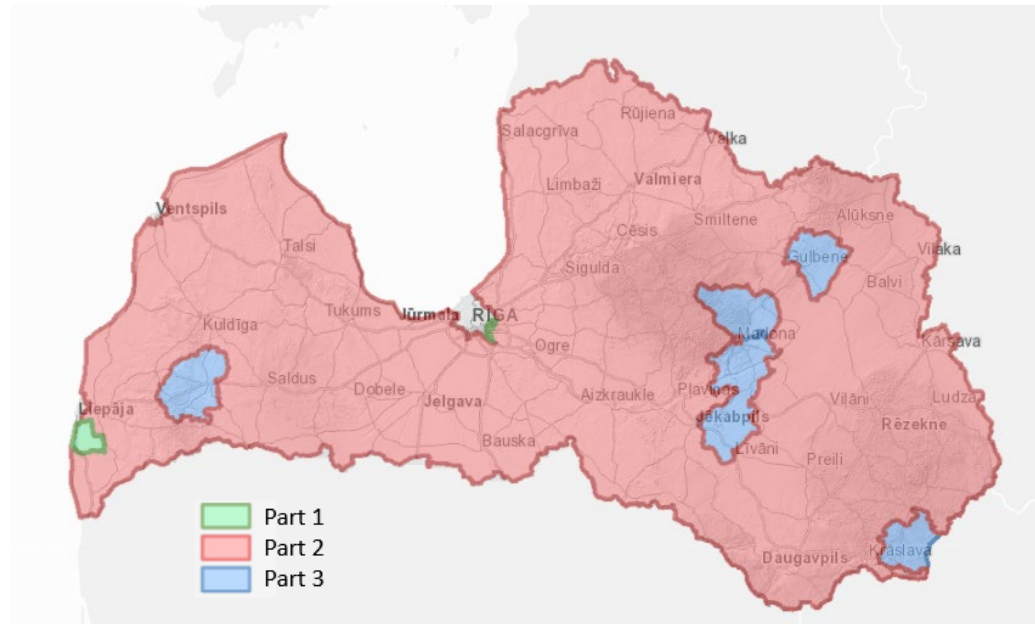

# Wild boar surveillance

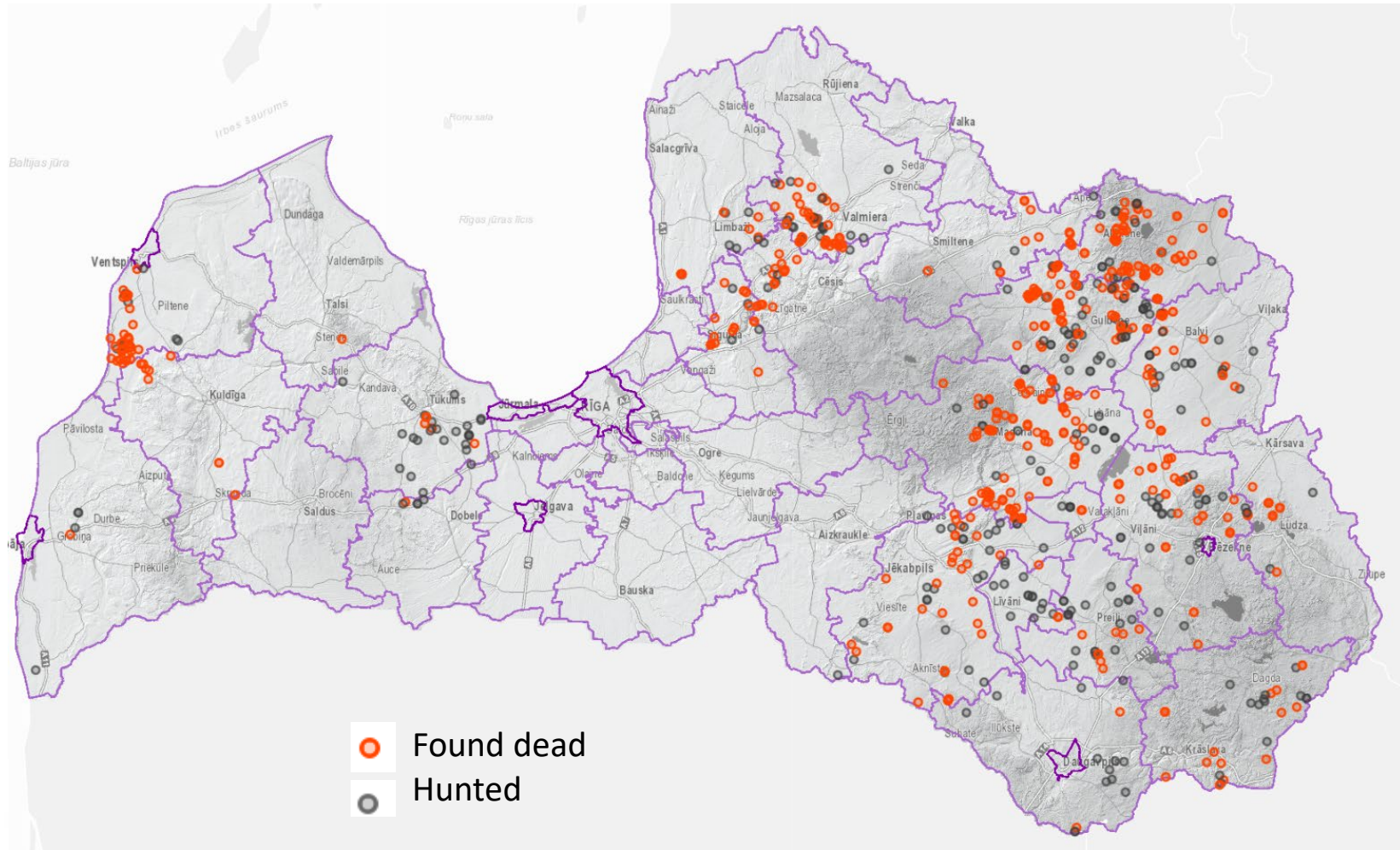
1st September 2022 – 29th August 2023

# Domestic pigs surveillance

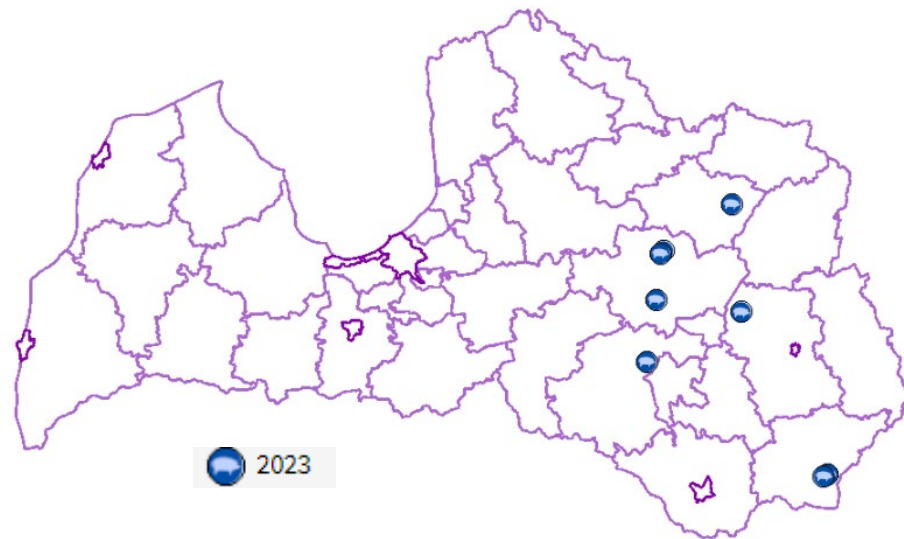

**Enhanced passive surveillance program in commercial pig farms** - every week samples from at least first two dead from every epidemiological unit shall be sent to the NR laboratory testing to the presence of ASFV.

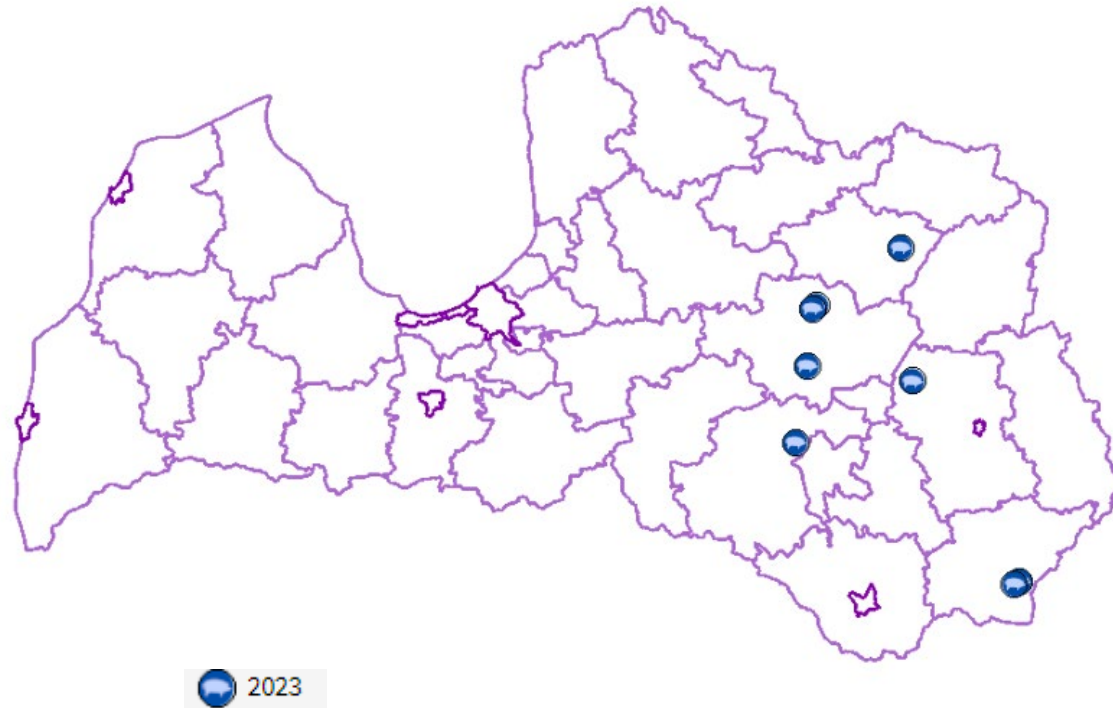
In total 8 ASF outbreaks were confirmed in areas where ASFV are confirmed in wild boar population.

- 4 outbreaks in small commercial farms (44-101 pigs).
- 4 outbreaks in backyard farms (1-6 pigs).
