



1. From the top navigation menu, click the **History** tab as indicated below.




Exploring ANIMUSE - History

Annual Report

Annual Report on Antimicrobial Agents Intended for Use in Animals

Every year, WOAH publishes a report to present the global and regional trends on antimicrobial intended for use in animals. This report follows the annual round of data collection, which takes place between September and May.

The latest report, published in May 2023, provides specific information on the global use of antimicrobial agents adjusted for animal biomass for the year 2019 and presents the overall findings of the seventh annual data collection on the use of antimicrobial agents in animals.


Contributions to our database have grown from reporting data from 130 Members for the first report in 2016 to 157 participants for the latest report.


