Main activities:


- Assessment missions (2021)

- Laboratory training (2023)
- Regional coordination (continuous)

Budget: 500,000 USD

Target countries: Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and

Uzbekistan

Duration: 2021- 2023 (closed)





Simulation exercises



Type: one-day long drill exercises

Modality: face-to-face

Participants: private veterinarians

Topics covered: detection of lumpy skin disease and

implementing vaccination in the field

6, 7, 8 June 2023, Bokonbaevo, Kyrgyzstan in Kyrgyz and Russian language



Laboratory training and support

One-week long trainings

- 10 to 14 April 2023 in Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan
- 24 to 28 April 2023 in Dushanbe, Tajikistan
- 1 to 5 May 2023 training in Tashkent, Uzbekistan

Topics covered:

- sample selection, sample packaging and transport;
- technical skills and knowledge on manual extraction of nucleic acids;
- performing and implementing validated Real-Time PCR (qPCR) assays;
- use of serology in LSD diagnosis;
- laboratory diagnostic workflows and interpretation of test results from different assays.


In addition, each country received a limited number of diagnostic consumables required to perform the different tests.






Virtual learning













- 4-week tutored course (15 hours of study time)
- Developed by HSA and FAO REU VLC in 2022
- Primary audience: veterinarians (public & private)
- Russian language course from May June 2023 with 150 participants from 14 countries
- Delivered through the FAO Virtual Learning Centers

Available in English, Chinese, Macedonian, Romanian, Serbian, Ukrainian


