


Landscape

Forest complexity


The forest structure is complex, including bamboo that is not found in EU.

- Guidebooks in manga format










Measures for Wild Boars

#### **ASF** surveillance

Nationwide CSF/ASF surveillance in domestic pigs and wild boars is in place.

7,113 CSF cases

110,564 wild boars tested

(\*from 13 Sep. 2018 to 13 Mar. 2024)

ASF has never been confirmed.


### Preparedness!!


MAFF has carried out the first epidemic prevention training for ASF in Sep 2020.



Subsequently, several prefectures conducted field training for control measures, assuming that ASF was detected in wild boars.









Enhanced Biosecurity on farms

- 1 Biosecurity on farm
  - Thorough cleaning and disinfection
  - Preparation and use of dedicated clothes and shoes
  - Record keeping of people and items entering and exiting the farm
  - When using recycled feed (potentially contain meat),
    heat treatment to ensure inactivation of virus (60 minutes at 90 °C with stirring)


Change into rubber boots for use only in the pig house

Enhanced Biosecurity on farms

- 2 Measures for wild animals
  - Preventing the incursion of wild animals into farms by guard fences
  - Preventing the contamination of feed and water
  - Weeding and tiding up inside and outside of pig house
  - Keep dead animals away from wild animals
