

- Regular self-assessment & monitoring in support to the progression of the Roadmaps
- Data used for the WOAH Observatory (2022 Annual Report)

**Tuheljske Toplice, Croatia 4-6 July 2023** 

10/11 countries attended - Albania, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Greece, Kosovo\*, Montenegro North Macedonia, Serbia, Romania






