



Workshop on Veterinary Workforce Development in Eastern Europe Republic of Moldova





Republic of Moldova, lies in the central part of Europe in the northeastern Balkans. Also, the country is bordered with Romania on the west and Ukraine on north, east and south (Figure.1). The total length of the border of the Republic of Moldova is 1.389 km - 450 km with Romania, which stretches almost entirely along the Prut River, up to its mouth in the Danube River, and 939 km with Ukraine.



Topography and agro-ecological zones



Most of Moldova's territory is a moderate hilly plateau cut deeply by many streams and rivers. Geologically, Moldova lies primarily on the deep sedimentary rock that gives way to harder crystalline outcroppings only in the north. Moldova's hills are part of the larger Moldavian Plateau. The average elevation of the country is about 200 to 300 m (with the highest point 429 m), are ridges interlaced by deep, flat valleys, ravines, and landslide-scoured depressions.

Republic of Moldova has a continental climate with hot summers and mild winters. Annual precipitations: North – 600 L/m2, Center – 500 L/m2 and South – 400 L/m2.



The Ministry of Agriculture and Food Industry (MAFI) is the central specialized body of the public administration, subordinated to the Government of the Republic of Moldova with the mission of ensuring the realization of the constitutional prerogatives of the Government in the elaboration and promotion of the state policy of sustainable development of the agro-industrial sector of the country, by increasing the competitiveness and productivity of the sector, as well as ensuring the harmlessness and food sufficiency of the country, in order to create the premises for the permanent increase in the well-being of the population. MAFI's main functions are:

- 1. Elaboration and promotion of policies in the field of the development of agro-food markets, including organic production, increasing food safety, including carrying out policy impact analyses.
- 2. Ensuring the country's food security in terms of food quality, quantity and accessibility.
- 3. Strategic planning, analysis, monitoring and evaluation of policies developed in order to ensure their correspondence with national strategies and programs and the adjustment of existing policies to the priorities and needs of European integration.
- 4. Regulation, in accordance with the law, of the way of organization and operation of the agri-food market and food safety.
- 5. Ensuring the implementation of policies in the fields of the agri-food market, ecological production, food safety, at the national and local level, collaborating in this regard with the representatives of the specialized authorities of the central and local public administration, of civil society, as well as with the mass media.
- 6. Management of international technical and financial assistance programs to support reform in the agri-food market sectors, food safety.
- 7. Elaboration and promotion of a technical policy aimed at ensuring the rational use of energy resources, including through the extensive use of renewable energy sources; developing and promoting the policy of rational use of the existing fleet of cars and tractors, in order to implement modern technologies in agriculture and increase the efficiency of agricultural production.₆



Information about veterinary school

In Republic of Moldova there is one university where veterinary doctors learn- Technical University.

The foundation stone of the medical-veterinary education in Moldova was laid in 1974 by founding, within the Agricultural Institute of Chisinau, a section of Veterinary Medicine, which then, in April 1976, was reorganized into the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine.

Following a reform realised in 2022 in the field of higher education in the Republic of Moldova, the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine found itself administratively within the Technical University of the Republic of Moldova. In almost half a century of existence, the faculty has instructed and trained more than 3000 veterinarians, including about 350 foreign students from other countries.

The faculty's mission is to train specialist veterinarians in the management of the health of farm, companion, sport and exotic animals, as well as in ensuring the traceability and safety of food of animal origin, able to integrate into the complex national and European veterinary sanitary activity. From the 2018/2019 academic year, the faculty has academic student formations with english teaching.



College of Veterinary Medicine and Agrarian Economy from Brătușeni

The College was created in 1992 as a professional technical education institution and after a series of changes in 2016 got the actual name the College of Veterinary Medicine and Agrarian Economy in Brătușeni.

The College of Veterinary Medicine and Agrarian Economy from Brătușeni is a technical professional education institution, which ensures the training of personnel for the applied activity in the fields of agriculture and the food industry.

Throughout its existence, the College has graduated 5456 specialists.





College of Veterinary Doctors from the Republic of Moldova



Starting from 2021 in Republic of Moldova has been established the College of veterinarians. Any veterinarian, in order to exercise the profession of veterinarian, must be an active member of the College of veterinarians. One of the College competences is to ensure the continuous professional education/development of veterinarians.

The activity of the College and of veterinarians in a professional aspect is regulated by Law no. 121/2020 regarding the organization and exercise of the veterinary profession.

The profession of veterinarian is among the few professions in the Republic of Moldova regulated by a separate law.

At the moment, the College has 575 members, veterinarians working in various professional fields





Current reform of National Food Safety Agency and new legal framework for veterinarians



<u>Government Decision No.611 from 21 August 2023 for the approval of the</u> <u>Regulation regarding the grant facilities for young specialists with higher</u> <u>education in veterinary medicine</u>

Benefits for the graduates that are employed as veterinarians

- a) **compensation of expenses for renting the home** or free housing granted by the local public administration authority;
- b) a single allowance in the amount of 15 average salaries per economy, which is paid in three equal installments, after the expiration of the first month of activity and, subsequently, at the end of each year of activity;
- c) monthly compensation of the cost of 30 kW/hour of electricity and annual compensation of the cost of one cubic meter of wood and one ton of coal, including in the case of gas heating.





From 2022, ANSA has created 32 veterinary constituencies, where a total of 150 veterinarians and paramedics are employed.

This veterinary staff is responsible for ensuring the program of veterinary sanitary measures financed from the state budget, as well as the free identification of animals from non-professional holdings, but also the involvement in the management of disease outbreaks.
